Please find in this email, some extra information about the races at Silverstone for this weekend.

- 1. ETA** - Please don't forget to register (mobile app) for your trip for England. All people who want to enter England need to register before they enter the country. <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/apply-for-an-electronic-travel-authorisation-eta>
- 2. Licenses** - Please don't forget your race license - probably you need to show it when you register for the Free Practices
- 3. Waiver** - Please find below the link to the waiver that you need to fill in and sign digitally - IMPORTANT: you need to upload a picture of your license. Please fill in this page before you go on track or come to the circuit. <https://brscc.co.uk/support-series-signing-on-brscc-silverstone-24hour-2nd-4th-may-2025/>
- 4. Fuel order**: **Before 12:00 hour Wednesday!** Anglo American Oil fuel are our recommended supplier from Britcar. Please contact them directly to place your order - [mel@aaoil.co.uk](mailto:mel@aaoil.co.uk). +44-01929551557. It could be possible to get fuel at the station on the circuit. But at this moment they are not sure if this is possible.
- 5. 20litre bottles with Ripper Neck** - Did you order your bottle for refuelling during the race?
- 6. Refuelling**: Refuelling MUST follow Motorsport UK NCR [https://motorsportuk.s3.eu-west-2.amazonaws.com/wp-content/uploads/2025/01/Motorsport-UK\\_NCR-2025\\_v9\\_Ch12\\_260325.pdf](https://motorsportuk.s3.eu-west-2.amazonaws.com/wp-content/uploads/2025/01/Motorsport-UK_NCR-2025_v9_Ch12_260325.pdf) with the exception that sufficient fuel to complete the race may be stored in the doorway of the garage adjacent to the apron you have been allocated. Alternatively, fuel may be stored in your awning in the paddock and you may access this at any time to refill dump churns. For Supercar Challenge competitors it is via the gate by the podium (or via the garage adjacent to your allocated apron area but ONLY with the agreement of the C1 teams occupying that garage).
- 7. Speed in pitlane** - Silverstone runs a 50kph speed limit in the pitlane with speed guns.
- 8. Paddock** - Please find in the attachment the paddock planning. Information about the location of Supercar Challenge regarding the pitlane: The teams will be taking their equipment from the paddock approx. 5-10 min walk to the gate between garage 6 – and your teams will need to turn left up the pit lane when instructed. No private cars and mobile homes on the paddock. Mobile homes can park on bottom right in map.
- 9. Information about pitlane** - Britcar competitors will be allocated an area of the pitlane to use outside garages 20 - 37 Supercar Challenge competitors will be allocated apron space outside garages 5 - 19. Access to the pitlane for team personnel and equipment will be the gap between 19 - 20 prior to qualifying, as there is a session finishing before us, and from the same gap for the race, where access is available during the lunch break
- 10. Crew catering** - Would you like to eat with us please let us know before you arrive on the track
- 11. Noise level**: Friday: Noise Level is 105 db drive by. Saturday: 105 Db Static

**12. Update Time Schedule** - V2 - Briefing times etc are added. Paddock is open on Thursday from 12:00 hour for Supercar Challenge.

**13. Free Practices on Friday** - It looks like you all got an email about the Free Practices on Friday and Supercar Challenge is in Group 2. Please find in the attachment the timing for Friday. If you didn't get an email about the Free Practice on Friday please send me an email and I check with the organiser.

**14. Extra Testing on Thursday** - We are looking for possibilities for extra testing on Thursday (15:15 - 17:00 hour)- if we know more we will let you know.

**15. Entry Tickets** - The Entry Tickets will be from Silverstone to Team Managers or to the name entered on the Vehicle Registration Form. 12 Tickets for this round have been requested.

**16. Travel Plug adaptor** - Don't forget you travel Plug adaptor if you want to charge your phone or other electric devices.
