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ACCESS

The **Saarland-Pfalz Rallye** takes place across two German federal states: Saarland and Rhineland-Palatinate (Germany).

The Special Stages are located around Illingen and the surrounding areas of Freisen, St. Wendel, Heusweiler and Kusel.

The Service Park, Rally Headquarters and Secretariat are all located in Illingen.

PARKING

A large P+R (Park & Ride) car park is located next to the Rally Office & Press Centre (Saarlandring). :

Public parking near the special stages is very limited. In most cases, spectators and team members will need to park along the roads surrounding the stages.

TYRES

In accordance with the Porsche Rally Trophy Benelux Sporting Regulations, all competitors must use **Michelin competition tyres** throughout the event.

In accordance with the 2026 DMSB Rally Regulations, competitors may use a maximum of **14 slick tyres** during the Saarland-Pfalz Rallye, as the event includes more than 150 km of Special Stages. Wet-weather tyres are not included in this allocation, and tyres used during the Official Shakedown are not counted towards the maximum number permitted.

Tyre identification and checks will be carried out by the organiser using the official Michelin barcode identification system.

As Kronos Tyres will not be present at the event, competitors are requested to order their tyres in advance directly from Kronos Tyres (sales@kronostyres.com). Tyres may either be collected from the Kronos Tyres workshop or shipped free of charge before the event. Any tyres ordered but not fitted or used during the rally may be returned to Kronos Tyres within one week after the event and will be deducted from the final invoice.

Tyre fitting and on-event tyre service will be provided by the official local Michelin Motorsport dealer appointed for the Saarland-Pfalz Rallye.

SHAKEDOWN

An official Rally Shakedown will be organised on Thursday, 13 August 2026, in Urexweiler, from 14:00 to 18:30. Participation in the Shakedown is optional and must be requested via the rally entry form by selecting the "Shakedown" option. An additional fee of €180 applies.

Competitors participating in the Shakedown **must complete both Administrative Checks (11:00–13:30) and Technical Scrutineering (12:00–14:00) before taking part.**

Shakedown reconnaissance passes are permitted between 12:00 and 13:45.

Please inform Julien Frère (julien.frere@prospeed.be) if you plan to participate, as this will allow us to organise the practical arrangements accordingly.

Service is permitted only in the Service Park in Illingen. Service is prohibited along the entire liaison section and within the town of urexweiler.

CAR IDENTIFICATION AND MANDATORY ADVERTISING

According to Article 8.1 (Car identification) of the Sporting Regulations, the Trophy Organiser shall provide the mandatory advertising stickers.

Their distribution will be handled on a case-by-case basis with each team, who may contact the Sporting Coordinator directly (julien.frere@prospeed.be – +32 479 97 28 71).

If needed, spare stickers will also be available in the spare parts truck located in the Service Park during the entire rally.

The organiser's mandatory advertising and competition numbers will be distributed to each team at the Service Welcome Center (see "Service Park" section below).

MANDATORY BRANDING

Please note that the Porsche Rally Trophy Benelux beach flags must be displayed in each team's service area. Failure to do so may result in the crew being deemed ineligible for the corresponding prize money and bonuses.

Michelin caps must be worn during the podium ceremonies for Leg 1 and Leg 2, at least by the crews occupying the top three positions in the overall Porsche Rally Trophy Benelux classification.

SERVICE PARK

The service area is located on and around the "Burgplatz" in Illingen, directly adjacent to a residential area. Access to the Service Park is strictly restricted to vehicles displaying a valid Service Pass. Each competitor will receive the number of Service Passes included in the entry package. Any additional Service Passes or extra service area must be ordered directly from the organiser in accordance with Article 4.4 of the Supplementary Regulations.

All competitors must complete the online Service Area Registration Form, specifying their service area requirements, via the following [link](#).

Service packages can be collected from the **Welcome Centre at Saarlandring**, Illingen-Uchtelfangen, from 07:30 on Thursday, 13 August 2026. Competitors must present their entry confirmation when collecting their service package.

To facilitate access to the Service Park, teams using service vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) exceeding 7.5 tonnes must arrive on Thursday, 13 August 2026, between 08:00 and 13:00.

The speed limit for competition and service vehicles in the service park is 10 km/h. (DMSB RyR Art. 57.4)

All trailers must remain parked in the Trailer Park (Saarlandring) throughout the event.

The allocated service area must be left clean and free of any waste.

REFUELING

All Porsche Rally Trophy Benelux cars comply with the FIA requirements regarding FT safety fuel tanks and FIA Stäubli refuelling couplings.

As the Stäubli system is not compatible with commercial fuel stations, each team must provide its own fuel and its own refuelling equipment.

Refuelling is permitted exclusively in the official Refuelling Zones (RZ/RRZ) in accordance with the DMSB regulations. Refuelling in the Service Park is prohibited.

TRACKING SYSTEMS

For this rally, two different tracking systems are mandatory: one for reconnaissance and one for the rally itself.

During Reconnaissance

During reconnaissance, the RSLite reconnaissance app must be installed in the reconnaissance vehicle and remain activated at all times (see the Organiser's Supplementanry regulations and Sportity channel for detailed instructions).

During the Rally

During the rally, the official RallySafe tracking system will be used. The RallySafe installation and user manual is available via the Sportity app.

The RallySafe unit will be distributed during Scrutineering at Saarlandring, Illingen-Uchtelfangen, and may be collected by a member of the crew's service team.

If your rally car is not equipped with a RallySafe mounting kit, one can be rented directly from RallySafe. The rental fee (30 euros) must be paid when collecting the RallySafe unit.

IMPORTANT: Before attending Scrutineering, every rally car fitted with the RallySafe tracking system must be presented to the RallySafe staff in the Service Park (near TC Service Out) for inspection and system verification.

PODIUM CEREMONY

Within the framework of the PRTB, each leg of a rally event included in the calendar is considered as a separate round for the Drivers' classification. As such, a podium ceremony will be held twice during the rally:

- Friday 14h August at the end of leg 1

Approx hour: 22:30
- Saturday 15th August at the end of leg 2
Localisation : Rally Podium – Hauptstraße – 66557 Illingen
Approx hour: 18:25

FREE RALLY ENTRY DRAW

In accordance with Article 14.2.2 of the [PRTB Sporting Regulations](#), for each rally, the Trophy Organiser will offer the reimbursement of the rally entry fee to one crew, selected by a random draw.

This draw will take place after the final podium ceremony of the rally, just after the Par Fermé IN, and is therefore scheduled as follows:

To claim the prize, the crew must be present at the time of the draw.

POWER STAGES

In accordance with Article 13.3 of the [PRTB Sporting Regulations](#), each rally leg includes a Power Stage with points awarded (5 – 4 – 3 – 2 – 1). The two Power Stages of the Ypres Rally are as follows:

- Friday - Leg 1 : **SS 1 Windpark I** (10,39 km) – ("First pass of the longest special stage of the leg 1")
- Saturday – Leg 2 : **SS 14 Breitsester Wald 2** (12,10 km) - ("Official Power Stage of the Rally")

HEAVY GOODS VEHICLE (HGV) TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS (> 7.5 T)

Please note that Germany applies **traffic restrictions** to heavy goods vehicles (HGVs) with a Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) exceeding 7.5 tonnes, as well as to all trucks towing trailers.

Although 15 August (Assumption Day) is a public holiday in Saarland, this local public holiday does not give rise to a nationwide HGV driving ban. Consequently, no additional driving restrictions apply on Saturday, 15 August 2026 for teams leaving the rally.

The regular Sunday HGV driving ban remains in force on **16 August 2026, from 00:00 to 22:00.**

Competitors are strongly advised to take these restrictions into account when planning their return journey.
