## 4. FIA AND OTHER TITLES ELIGIBILITY

### 4.1. 2024 FIA titles towards which the event counts

As per Article 15 of the FIA Sporting Regulations.

### 4.2. Other Title

In addition to the combined classification defined in article 12 of the FIA Sporting Regulations, the Organiser will establish a REGULARITY classification and the first 3 will receive prizes. This classification will not count for the Bridgestone ecoRally Cup.

## 5. VEHICLES ELIGIBLES TO PARTICIPATE

As per Articles 1.1 and 6.1 of the FIA Technical Regulations.

The eligible (admitted) cars are those listed in the FIA "Compatible Cars" List, in accordance with Article 2 of the Sporting Regulations.

## 6. GENERAL CONDITIONS

6.1. The event will be organised in conformity with:

- the FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices,
- the Sporting and Technical Regulations of the Bridgestone ecoRally Cup,
- the applicable prescriptions stated in the National Sporting Regulations; and
- the present Supplementary Regulations.

The Organising Committee will ensure that the event complies with all the rules and regulations stated above, and that the event has received all the required administrative authorizations.

6.2. **Insurance**

The organiser has contracted insurance covering the following risks: **10'000'000.- €**

**6.2.1 Liability insurance of the event organiser**

The liability insurance entitles the insured in case of insured event to have the insurer fulfilling claims of the harmed party related to property detriment (damage), or even another detriment to the extent and in the amount specified by law, insurance contracts and the respective insurance conditions, in case insured's obligation to pay reimbursement has arisen.

The insurance covers the legally stipulated responsibility of the organiser for the detriment caused to health or property in relation to the organization of the event or in relation to training for it. The insurance also covers damage caused by organiser on track event, its equipment and accessories or adjacent land, regardless of whether the property is owned or lease by the organiser or not. The insurance under this paragraph shall not apply to damage caused to health or property of participant if this damage was caused by a participant (e.g., driving mistake).

**6.2.2 Liability insurance of the event participant**

The liability insurance entitles the insured in case of insured event to have the insurer fulfilling claims of the harmed party related to property detriment (damage), or even another detriment to the extent and in the amount specified by law, insurance contracts and the respective insurance conditions, in case insured's obligation to pay reimbursement has arisen.

The insurance covers the statutory duty of the insured event participant to repay the harmed party (third party) detriment specified in DPPOP, in case insured's obligation to repay arose in connection with participation in the event or use of his/her vehicle.

As a third person is considered, among others, an official, officer and technical personal of the organiser at the event, including official officials of relevant international organizations, VIP guests and viewers. In case that this paragraph indicates a person in an employment relationship to the insured, he/she shall be considered as a third party in case he/she is delegated to the event or intended to perform certain functions during the event in accordance with international and national sporting regulations.

The insurance does not cover obligation of the insured to compensate the detriment caused to other participants of the event.

### 6.3. Motorway sticker

A motorway sticker is required part of the route will be on the motorway (40 CHF).

### 6.4. GPS tracker

The security GPS tracker require a 12 V auxiliary power.

**A deposit of 400 euros/CHF, cash only, will be requested from each competitor during the administrative checks.**

## 8. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

### 8.1. Nature of the event

**THE E-RALLYE DU CHABLAIS** is an ecoRally that has a combined final classification (regularity + energy performance index), as per Article 3 of the FIA Sporting Regulations.

## 8.2. Start, Finish, Results

8.2.1. The start signal for the event will be given Avenue du Théâtre 9, Monthey, June, 28 2024.

The first car will start at 15:00.

During the overnight stay and after the finish, the cars will remain in the Parc Fermé, which they will enter as soon as they finish a Leg.

The starting sequence will follow the participation number and the cars will start at one-minute intervals.

8.2.2. The first Leg will be made up of 4 Regularity Stages and 1 regrouping.  
The second Leg will be made up of 9 Regularity Stages and 2 regroupings.  
The third Leg will be made up of 5 Regularity Stages and 1 regrouping.

8.2.3. During the technical checks, after installing the FIA devices on the cars must be moved a few kilometers (4 km minimum, e.g., to the calibration zone) and carry out some procedures in order to verify that the FIA metering devices are working properly. The cars then return in Park Fermé as soon as the test course has been completed.

## 9. DRIVER'S BRIEFING

The Clerk of the Course will conduct a Drivers' Meeting Friday on 13:30 (one hour and thirty minutes) before the first car starting Leg 01.

The Drivers' Meeting should duly be posted in advance on the Official Notice Board.

The briefing should be also distributed in writing, in English and the language of the event, during the meeting, with the competitors signing an acknowledgement of receipt.

The presence of both competitors (Driver and Co-driver) is compulsory. Absence, except in cases of Force Majeure decided by the Stewards of the event, will be penalized by adding 50 Regularity points to the final Regularity Results of the Race of the relevant competitor(s). This penalty cannot be appealed.

## 10. CHARGING (BEV/FCEV)

The organising committee will supply for recharging electric power, or hydrogen, in the case of FCEV's:

**Recharging point:** Théâtre du Crochetan, av du Théâtre 9, Monthey, GPS coord. **46°15'14.7"N 6°56'56.7"E**

- Voltage / Amperage supplied: 400 V / 16 A / 11 kW per 1 hour
- Type of sockets: Type 2 (Mennekes)



It is strongly recommended to start the event with a full battery (BEV) and full hydrogen tank (FCEV).

The recharging stations will be available from Thursday 27 June at 18:00.

## 11. PERFORMANCE INDEX CALCULATION-CLASSIFICATION

As per Article 3 of the FIA Sporting Regulations and Article 6.2 of the FIA Technical Regulations.

## 12. ENTRY PROCEDURE AND FEES

The entry fee amount is fixed for each crew comprising two people (driver and co-driver, or driver and navigator):

- a) With the optional advertising proposed by the Organiser: 750.-EUR/700.-CHF
- b) Without the optional advertising proposed by the Organiser: 1'500.-EUR/1'400.-CHF.

### 12.1 Entry Fee Refund

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- If the entry is not accepted.
- If the event is cancelled.

The organiser may refund part of the entry fee if a competitor is unable to take part in the event due to a proven case of force majeure.

### 12.2 Crew documents

A crew comprises one driver and one co-driver, or one driver and one navigator.

Both must be a holder of the following documents:

- Driving licence according to the entered vehicles (not applicable for the navigators only)
- **An IT LSC licence as defined in Article 19 of Appendix L is required.** This licence may be obtained for the event, and valid for its duration, which has been issued by their ASN or by the organiser's ASN (with the written permission of the competitor's ASN) and handed over to the participants at the latest during the administrative checks. It will be subject to the payment of a fee of 100 CHF (for Auto Sport Suisse). Link to obtain the temporarily licence by ASS : [Licences/Règlements/... Motorsport Suisse | Auto Sport Suisse.](#)
- **A Competitor licence can be provided by the parent ASN of the entrant. This licence may be combined with the IT LSC licence defined above, but this must be clearly stated on it.**

- Vehicle document permitting its free circulation on public roads.
- Should it be applicable, a vehicle document required in the Technical Regulations of the FIA ecoRally Cup.
- Authorization of the car owner if he is not a member of the crew.
- Vehicle valid insurance certificate in accordance with the vehicle laws.
- Appendix 4: Driver' and Codriver's Declaration and Undertakings, it must individually be completed and signed and handed in at the administrative checks.

### 12.3. Entry Form

Any person, or legal entity, wishing to participate to the event must submit to the event secretariat, a properly filled-in and signed entry form (see Appendix 1), together with all other requested documents, photos, etc. before Monday, 17 June 2024, 24:00.

### 12.4. The field for participation is limited to a total of 24 entries.

All entry forms received after the above number of vehicles has been accepted will be entered on a reserve list.

### 12.5. The minimum number of entries is as per the FIA Sporting Regulations, Article 12 of the FIA Sporting Regulations.

## 13. ADVERTISING PROMOTION AND OPUBLICITY

### 13.1. Official Supporter

The organisation of the event is supported by enterprises and authorities, the logos of which must, as a matter of obligation, be displayed on the competition numbers and on any other promotional material intended to be placed on vehicles.

### 13.2. Doors Numbers

Competitors must reserve an area for door numbers (600mm x 200mm) and the organiser's advertising (600mm x 250mm).



### 13.3. The Organisers will provide the participants with various material and services as follows:

- Proposed optional advertising material.
- Friday Dinner.
- Saturday Midday Meal in Regr., Saturday Dinner and Sunday Midday Meal.
- Lunch in morning regroupings.
- Invitation to the Official Dinner and Prize-Giving Ceremony.
- Competitors transports between parc fermé and hotels.

## 14. PROTESTS / APPEALS

The amount of the protest fee is 1'000 EUR.

Protests against the preliminary official results of the event must be lodged, in writing, in accordance with the prescriptions set in the ISC with the Clerk of the Course within 30 minutes of the moment of their posting on the official notice board. Upon the expiration of this time period, the preliminary results become final.

Every protest is eligible to be examined by the Stewards of the event only if it is accompanied by the aforementioned protest fee defined in this article, which is not refundable should the protest fail to be upheld.





For the National Court of Appeal, the fees are 4'500 CHF.  
For the FIA International Court of Appeal, the fees are 3'000 EUR.  
The appeal deposit for an international appeal is 3'000 EUR.

All protests and/or appeals must be lodged in accordance with Articles 13 and 15 of the Code and, where applicable, with the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.

## 15. APPLICATION AND INTERPRETATION OF THE REGULATIONS

In case of a dispute over the interpretation of the regulations, the English text will prevail.

The tracking System requires a 12 V auxiliary power supply. It cannot be taken from the OBD sockets. This power supply must be protected by an appropriate fuse near the source. The Transponder for the regularity classification need no aux. power supply.

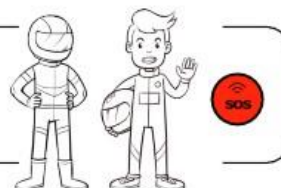

### 2 CONNECTION & START-UP



The Interactive Tracker will be handed over to you already at the administrative checks. It must be plugged in and must **REMAIN ON FOR THE ENTIRE RALLY.**

Connect the Interactive Tracker directly to your USB power supply with the supplied cable. A **WHITE LED** lights up when connected.

## USER GUIDE



### 1 CONNECTING / STARTING / STOPPING THE INTERACTIVE TRACKER



- ✓ 1/ Connect the USB cable to the USB port of your car and the angled part of the USB cable to the tracker  
**IMPORTANT :** The angled part of the cable must go to the left of the tracker
- ✓ 2/ Fix the interactive tracker on the arch with collars
- ✓ 3/ Starting the tracker: press and hold the On/Off button for more than 2 seconds  
The screen should then light up In Race Mode (see using Race Mode)
- ✓ 4/ Stopping the tracker : keep the On/Off button pressed for more than 2 seconds a stop confirmation is requested on the screen, click and confirm.

**IMPORTANT:** The On/Off button is the one located on the right side of the tracker, the bottom one (smaller compared to the second above)

### 2 RACE USE OF THE TRACKER RACE MODE

1/ After Initiating its startup process, the interactive tracker should automatically enter Race Mode. It should display the time and your race number.  
**IMPORTANT:** if the tracker does not display your race number, press the tracker screen, where the race number is.

2 **OK Bouton = Closed road or Clear road**

3 **SOS button = Medical or Fire**  
*These buttons automatically trigger a call to the PC Course*

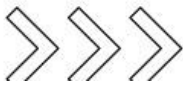
4 **The Chat Box can indicate text messages from the PC Course (neutralization, ES cancellation etc...), and confirms that your alert message has been sent**

**MESSAGE ENVOYE**

5 **Pick up a call from PC Course**  
*The Head Quarter can call you if there is no news from you when you are stationary in a special.*

6 **Remote control authorization**  
*In the event of a problem with the interactive tracker, we can take control remotely to help you, but you must accept by validating on the*

If "Message Sent" does not appear in the Chat Box after triggering an OK or SOS alert, the message will not be received by the PC Course.

## VHRS TIMEKEEPING DEVICE INSTALLATION

### **Stand-alone GPS unit - no need to plug it into the car.**

The box must be installed inside the passenger compartment: in the center of the dashboard or attached by Rislans to the roll bar.

- It must not be placed on the tunnel or between the seats.
- It must be accessible to the driver and co -driver.
- It must be attached using Rislans or adhesive Velcro.
- The 2 small LEDs must ALWAYS remain visible.
- A scrutineer will validate the location and correct operation of the box during the preliminary scrutineering.

### **Installing and securing the GPS unit in the race car**

**Installation of the GPS unit in the race car is the responsibility of the competitor, who must ensure that it is securely fixed in the passenger compartment. Under no circumstances can VDS Technology be held responsible for a competitor running off the road or for any other incident in the event of the GPS falling into the competition car.**



The unit switches on automatically when the car is in motion - there is no button to switch it on.

**ATTENTION, the device must be positioned at least 50 cm from a telephone or equipment used for regularity.**

### **ATTENTION**

The trackers and USB cable must be returned at the entrance to the Parc Fermé at the finish. In the event of abandonment, they must be returned to Race HQ so that the deposit can be refunded! Under no circumstances should you return them to a marshal! (except in exceptional circumstances, by requesting authorisation from us: tel. +33 7 68 88 25 57)

2. Prior to taking part or driving in a Competition or Event I undertake to obtain, and throughout my participation in the Cup will maintain, all Licences, permits and/or consents as may be required by, or in connection with:
  - 2.1 any relevant National Sporting Authority requirements, regulations or safety standards (“ASN Regulations”);
  - 2.2 any FIA requirements, regulations or safety standards (“FIA Regulations”); and
  - 2.3 any relevant transnational, national and/or local laws, regulations, directives and decrees passed by the government, a quasi-governmental entity or by any entity which has the same authority as the government in any applicable country or other territory, including all applicable local, state and federal laws relating to health and safety and insurance, and any industry practices, codes of practice and/or codes of conduct incorporated into any of the foregoing and all binding court orders, decrees, and any decisions and/or rulings of any competent authority that apply to a Competition (“Applicable Laws”).
3. I confirm that I have read and understood and undertake to observe and be bound by:
  - 3.1 All rules, regulations, conditions, requirements and obligations relating to any Licence, permit or consent referred to in clause 2; and
  - 3.2 Any applicable FIA Regulations as supplemented and amended from time to time including:
    - 3.2.1 The FIA Statutes;
    - 3.2.2 The FIA International Sporting Code and its Appendices;
    - 3.2.3 The FIA Code of Ethics;
    - 3.2.4 The FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules;
    - 3.2.5 Any applicable Sporting Regulations and Technical Regulations; and
  - 3.3 Any applicable ASN Regulations as supplemented and amended from time to time.
4. I understand that as a condition of my participation in the Cup and in any Event(s) forming part of or associated with the Cup, the FIA, Event Organiser, Event promoter, Cup promoter, National Sporting Authority or any other relevant organisation may require that I comply with requirements, including any requirements contained in the following documents and/or training:

- 4.1 Passholder documentation relating to Entry to an Event or provision of a pass;
- 4.2 Briefings, handouts, leaflets, guidance, directions (including from the race director and/or stewards) and training relating to security, medical or rescue procedures (including Covid-related matters), health and safety and e-Safety;
- 4.3 Bulletins and Supplementary Regulations;
- 4.4 Terms provided by any supplier to the Cup; and I agree to observe and be bound by all such requirements.

5. I undertake to make no use of the substances or methods prohibited by the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations and/or defined in the Prohibited List published by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

### **Acknowledgement of Risk**

6. I am fully aware of, appreciate, recognise and accept the risks inherent in my attendance and/or participation in any Cup event (including races/Competitions/Events, official racing tests, any track or pit lane activity, and any associated activities), including the possibility of contracting or spreading communicable diseases (including Covid-19 / SARS-CoV-2) and the possibility of incidents resulting in physical and/or mental injury or death which may arise from racing or any associated activities, including motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property, the acts (deliberate or otherwise) or omissions of other drivers or any other personnel present at Events, exposure to noise, interaction with or use of high voltage or other equipment at the event and/or in any other way arising from attendance at an event. I appreciate and agree that my attendance at any Cup event shall be at my own sole risk, hazard and responsibility.

### **Limitation of liability**

7. I understand and accept that the FIA, on its own behalf and on behalf of any directors, members, officers, employees, advisors, agents, consultants, representatives, successors or assigns (collectively the "Representatives") of the FIA and on behalf of the Organisers, the promoter, any National Sporting Authority(ies), Automobile clubs and any other organisations directly connected with an Event within the Cup (collectively the "Associated Bodies") together with the Representatives of the Associated Bodies:

7.1 Disclaim, exclude and limit any and all liability, costs, expenses, damages, losses (including any direct, indirect or consequential losses, property damage, loss of profit, loss of reputation or goodwill, loss of agreements or contracts, loss of sales or business and all interest, penalties and legal costs) any personal or mental injury (including nervous shock, disease, disablement and death), sustained by me, howsoever caused including in relation to any:

7.1.1 statements acts or omissions made by me, or the FIA or its Representatives or Associated Bodies or their Representatives;

7.1.2 regulations, policies or procedures set by the FIA or its Representatives or Associated Bodies or their Representatives;

7.1.3 breach of warranty or obligation under any agreement between me and the FIA or its Representatives or Associated Bodies or their Representatives; or

7.1.4 any other negligence or lack of reasonable care by the FIA or its Representatives or Associated Bodies or their Representatives or me, in each case arising in connection with my participation in the Cup or attendance at Cup events, including my attendance at circuits, Courses or any other facilities, involvement in a race, Competition, test or any other associated activities and use of or interaction with equipment including high voltage equipment; and

9. Neither the FIA nor its Representatives assume any responsibility in relation to such compliance.

10. For the avoidance of any doubt, FIA Regulations do not contain any advice or guidance in relation to Applicable Laws, and neither the FIA nor its Representatives make any representation or warranty that the information contained in FIA Regulations or ASN Regulations complies with Applicable Laws.

11. With reference to clause 6 above, I fully understand and accept that neither the FIA nor its Representatives make any representation or warranty, express or implied, in relation to the safety of participating in or attending Cup Events or Competitions or associated activities, to the maximum extent permissible under Applicable Laws.

12. I fully understand and accept that neither the FIA nor its Representatives make any representation or warranty, express or implied, as to the quality, suitability or fitness for purpose of:

12.1 any equipment, safety structures or facilities at any venue hosting Cup Events or at which I am required to attend in connection with my participation in the Cup; nor

12.2 any products that are supplied to me by any third party (aside from the FIA) in connection with my participation in the Cup or attendance at any Cup Events.

If I am injured during a Cup Event, I hereby expressly authorise all medical treatment, rescue operations, arrangement for my transport to hospital or other emergency measures which the personnel appointed by the FIA and /or the Event Organiser may in their absolute discretion consider necessary for my well-being and I undertake to pay all costs associated therewith.

### **Insurance**

15. I fully understand and accept that:

15.1 The FIA and Associated Bodies assume no responsibility in relation to providing suitable insurance cover in relation to all of the risks arising from my participation in the Cup, unless otherwise required by local laws applying in the location of a particular Competition; and

15.2 The risks arising and cover required will differ depending on my particular circumstances and requirements and accordingly it is my full responsibility to take out adequate insurance cover and any other protections as may be necessary in connection with my participation in the Cup, and as may be required by Applicable Laws, FIA Regulations and ASN Regulations including suitable insurance cover for:

15.2.1 damage to or loss of my property;



15.2.2 any personal injury or death that I may sustain to include financial losses (for example loss of earnings and medical expenses) resulting from any injury or death; and

15.2.3 third party liability cover for damage, loss or injury which may be sustained by a third party (including a fellow Driver) arising from my participation in the Cup.

16. I confirm that I have considered and taken out adequate insurance cover and any other protections as may be necessary as referred to in clause 15 or otherwise. I undertake to maintain this cover throughout my participation in the Cup and as may be necessary thereafter to cover losses and claims arising from my participation.

17.3 At all times use my best endeavors to promote and encourage support for the Cup and motor sports generally; and

17.4 Subject to my commitments to my team and so far as is reasonably practicable, I will make myself available to all branches of the media at all times during all FIA Cup Events.

### **Applicable law and jurisdiction**

18. I agree in relation to legal claims that:

18.1 This Driver Declaration and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of France; and

18.2 The courts of France shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with this Driver Declaration or its subject matter or formation.

19. I agree that any matters relating to investigation and enforcement of FIA Regulations are subject to the jurisdiction of the internal judicial and disciplinary bodies of the FIA.

## **APPENDIX 5 – Regularity classification of the E-Rallye du Chablais, classification not eligible for the Bridgestone FIA ecoRally Cup (as per article 11).**

Application: In a Regularity Test, a joker will erase the worst penalty of the secret regularity controls late, never an early penalty or a missed regularity control. 1 joker = 1 penalty erased.

Jokers will be applied:

1 Joker per Regularity Stage
