The Stewards, having received a report number 3.16 from Clerk of the Course, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Date 29 June 2024

Session Leg 2, RS5

Facts Not following the itinerary and missing 2 secret time controls in RS5

Offence: Breach of Articles 3.1 and 5 of the Bridgestone FIA ecoRally Cup Sporting Regulations

Decision **1200 penalty points for each missed secret time control** in accordance with Article 6 of the Bridgestone FIA ecoRally Cup Sporting Regulations
2400 penalty points in total

Reason During the development of RS5 Competitor nr 12 left the itinerary described in the roadbook at box 39, rejoined the itinerary described in the roadbook at box 43 and missed 2 secret time controls:

RS5 Secret time controls nr 8, 9

The Stewards determined that the Competitor must always follow the itinerary described in the roadbook and must check in all secret time controls. In this occasion, the reason for missing the above-mentioned secret time controls will be considered as a Competitor's fault but not deliberate since it is a consequence of not following the itinerary described in the roadbook in a complicated junction. Since the Competitor took a shortcut there was a significant advantage. Consequently, the Stewards decide that a penalty of 1200 points for each missed secret time control is sufficient since it is not a deliberate fault of the Competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
