12 OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 Driver's safety briefing

All drivers and co-drivers who have not yet participated in a WRC event in 2024 must complete the FIA eLearning course and pass the assessment for FIA Safety Tracking Device by Tuesday 13 February 21:00, and are also required to attend the safety briefing on Wednesday 14 February at 18:45 19:00 the Rally HQ.

Instructions for the eLearning course will be sent to the competitors by email once the Entry List is published.

12.6 Organisers promotional activities

PR activities, crew requirements and related schedule for the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of the rally week Sunday 11, Monday 12 and Tuesday 13 February will be aligned with the P1, P2, P3 and P4 teams ahead of the event in January.

All Priority 1 cars with both crew members, as well as selected P2 cars and both crew members are required for the prestart show and autograph signing at the Red Barn arena on Thursday 15 February. All the abovementioned cars must be present at the line-up at latest by 17:20.

The procedure is as follows:

- After cars are parked in line-up order, all crews go for autograph signing which starts at 17:30. Crews required for autograph session: all P1 crews & the crews of cars No. 21 and 51.
- Directly after autograph signing, cars are driven onto the ramp crews selected by the FIA Media Delegate are directed on the stage for Meet the Crews sessions. Cars are driven onto the ramp as directed by the marshals.
- Crews participate in interviews on stage and then drive off the ramp and are escorted through the crowd, back to the holding area before TC 0.

Any further information will be coordinated with the PR representatives by the Event Media Coordinator.

12.6.1 Wednesday 14 February (new)

The following cars and crews are required to take part to the PR activity taking place on the Umeå City Hall Square as per the below schedule:

- 18:00 Caravan incl. one Rally1 car per P1 manufacturer as well as cars No. 21 (Solberg) and 51 (Johansson) starts from Service Park (cars can be driven by a mechanic)
- 18:10 Above listed cars on display + all P1 crews (drivers and co-drivers) to attend of the autograph signing and live interviews at the Fan Zone at Rex (City Hall Square), 63°49'31.3"N 20°15'45.9"E
- 18:30 Family photo for P1 crews (P1 crews can leave after the photo)
- 19:00 Displayed cars are driven back to Service Park

12.12 Power Stage

With reference to Art. 50 in the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations special stage 18, Umeå 2, will be run as the "Wolf Power Stage". Notwithstanding Art. 50.2 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 56.2.2 a) applies at the regroup TC17A/B and while the crews are waiting before TC17A.

All P1 drivers (and if timing allows, also all other priority drivers) are required to be available for 10 minutes to sign autographs for the spectators after having parked their car at the Regroup area (after TC17A) in the Red Barn Arena.

12.20 Pre-service area (new)

The area preceding the yellow TC board of Regroup andTechnical Zone IN before the Service Park is strictly restricted to crews and team PR officers only, access given upon the discretion of the FIA Media Delegate.
