#### 7. Administrative Checks

#### 7.1 Documents to be presented

Documentation and Signing-On will be completed on line any time from now until 21.30 on Tuesday 10th October 2023.

Competitors should use the link in their rallies.info entry acknowledgement email to access their entry home page. In here you will find two sections: **Electronic Documentation** and **Signing-On**. Use this system to upload pictures of your Competition Licence and Club Membership cards. Competitors should also complete their signing-on declaration. Competitors under 18 can also get their parent/guardian/guarantor to countersign the declaration.

There is no need to complete any pre-event scrutineering information in here.

Any team entries can be emailed to <a href="mailto:entries@mullrally.org">entries@mullrally.org</a> and the team entry fee of £20 sent by bank transfer with the team name as reference, and/or advised at Material Collection.

If you haven't already arranged Third Party Insurance for road sections you can also register for Reis by contacting <a href="mailto:entries@mullrally.org">entries@mullrally.org</a> and paying the £29.00 fee.

If you have any problems completing this process then you should contact entries@mullrally.org

Rally packs will not be issued to any competitors who have not fully completed the online documentation process.



#### 8.4 Running Order, Starting Intervals and Timing

Time cards for all three legs will be issued at each briefing session, upon successful completion of administrative checks, sound test, scrutineering and competitors' briefing.

Timing will be by "traditional" / "contact" methods, with competitors presenting timecards to the marshals. Passage Controls will be established for the collection of time cards.

#### 9. Servicing

#### 9.1 Permitted Areas

**Emergency, Management or Auxiliary service is prohibited on the event** and organised assistance anywhere other than these permitted areas is forbidden and could lead to disqualification from the event. **This will be stringently monitored and policed.** 

Specifically, the forecourt of MacDonald's Filling Station, Salen, PA72 6JF, ///forensic.await.meanders is out of bounds for management service outside of refuelling operations – specific request of the landowner.

Driving Standards Observers and Interim Cars will be on patrol, and monitoring for compliance.

#### 9.5 Refuelling

The event will operate two official Refuel Zones, with a specific site having been for Tobermory service during Leg 2 to reduce service traffic movements.

Refuel Zone for Legs 1/3 is located at Isle of Mull Rugby Club, Garmony, PA65 6BA, NM/ 6738 4049, ///trapdoor.results.whirlpool

Refuel Zone for Leg 2 is located at Baliscate, Tobermory, PA75 6QA, NM/ 5031 5456, ///punctuate.deflation.recapture

Harbour Garage Tobermory, have confirmed that they will have a supply of Super Unleaded (98 RON) fuel available during event week, for competitors to obtain fuel for self-refuel, or to use as a filling station on the rally route.

Gulf Race Fuel will be in attendance with a refuel rig at the Refuel Zone.

Last we were advised, Vital Equipment / Carless Fuels will not have a refuel rig, but will have a fuel can delivery service in operation from MacDonald's Filling Station, Salen, PA72 6JF, ///forensic.await.meanders, from which competitors may then take their self-refuel cans to the RZ.

Further details of Refuel Zone operation, including Opening Times, will follow subsequent to a site visit by the Environmental Scrutineer / Refuel Zone Officer, Peter Clingan (<a href="refuel@mullrally.org">refuel@mullrally.org</a>), on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September.

#### 11.2 Prizes

Due to insufficient entries in some of the historic classes, H1, H2 & H5 will be amalgamated into one class "H1/H2/H5", as will H3 and H4 into "H3/H4" (SR3.3).

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each of these new classes.



#### 2. Ledaig Car Park & Glengorm Road

No service vehicles or trailers are allowed in Ledaig Car Park Tobermory or Glengorm Road west of MR 4975 5515, from 12.00 Wednesday 11th October until 10.30 Saturday 14th October. **This is of particular importance this year with the start of Leg 2 being in Ledaig.** 

The penalty for non-compliance is:

- First offence Fine of £100 to be paid before start
- Second Offence 5 minute time penalty added to time the crew or crews of the vehicle
- Third offence Start not permitted or disqualification

#### 3. Red Flags & OK/SOS Procedures

On any special stage where in extreme circumstances is it necessary to authorise the movement of non-competing or rescue vehicles before the stage is cleared of competing cars, a system of red flags will be in place. These flags will be at every radio location marked in the road book on the special stages.

Information given to Marshals or Officials regarding the display of an OK/SOS Board, must **ALWAYS** be **FACTUAL** and **ACCURATE. NO INFORMATION** is better than **FALSE OR INACCURATE INFORMATION** – please only report what you have actually seen, if you did not see anything, say so. If you are not sure of the OK/SOS Board procedure, please refer to section R25.4 of the Motorsport UK Yearbook.

Competitors are urged to familiarise themselves with **SR 8.11 Safety Tracking** and associated non-compliance penalties.

A reminder on Red Flags & OK/SOS Procedures will be provided in the Competitors' Briefing, which will not be in-person this year – this will be posted to Sportity DNB by .

#### 4. Medical Facts

Any competitor with medical facts which may be pertinent to their treatment in event of an incident, are requested to provide such details, in confidence, to the Chief Medical Officer.

This can be done by contacting <a href="medical@mullrally.org">medical@mullrally.org</a>, or by way of submitting a sealed envelope to the Event Secretary at Material Collection.

#### 6. Competitor Liaison Officers (CLOs)

Bryan Hull, Eifion Jones & Amanda Morrison will be in attendance at the first and last control of each leg for any issues that are easier dealt with face to face.

Please note, that in the case of being stopped on stage or reporting retirement from the event, competitors are requested to contact the **HQ Emergency Line – 07594 216246**, displayed at the bottom of each page of, and NOT the CLOs.



#### 7. Tyre Warming Zones (TWZs)

In line with FIA latest practice, and as deployed recently on Down Rally and Rali Ceredigion, the event will be trialling Tyre Warming Zones (TWZs), between the Arrival Time Control and stage start of certain special stages. These have been provided for your benefit, to keep both inconvenient parking and component warming activity OFF of the public roads, and to ensure the continued goodwill of the people of Mull.

As such, please utilise these accordingly, and ensure that component warming is NOT conducted along the likes of Eas Brae prior to SS4/7, Glen More prior to SS10/14, etc., and that the practice of parking large distances short of arrival time controls, is not adopted. Driving Standards Observers and Interim Cars will be on patrol, and monitoring for compliance.

The area will be approximately 500m in length. The Tyre Warming Zone starts with a 'TWZ' board just after the Time Control and finishes at the 'TWZ ends' board, which will be a minimum of 100m before the stage start line. Before entering the Tyre Warming Zone the competing crews must have all their personal safety equipment in place, as if they were going to start the stage. Scrutineers may be present to monitor for compliance, and to assist.

Is it forbidden to stop in the Tyre Warming Zone, or to travel against the direction of rally traffic. Once the competing crew reaches the 'TWZ End' board, they must reduce their speed to walking speed as they approach the special stage start to position the car for starting the stage.

#### 8. Readiness to Start Special Stages

In addition to the above, considering recent events, please ensure that you arrive at the start of each Special Stage, in a state fit to start that stage. The event's scrutineers will be checking that helmets, belts, balaclavas and FHR devices are fitted correctly, throughout the course of the event.

#### 9. Service Areas A & C - Craignure

The ferry terminal is to be kept clear to allow passengers and cars to disembark and embark during the evening of Friday 13th October.

Ferry arriving at 16.45 and departing at 17.05 / arr. 18.05, dep. 1825 / arr. 19.05, dep. 19.25 - No competitor's service team is to set up on any CalMac ground in Service Area A on Friday 13th October. Additional service capacity is available up to and including Salen, to accommodate this.

No competitor's service team is to set up in Service Area C before 21.30 on Saturday 14th October.

The penalty for non-compliance with any of the above will be a five-minute penalty to the corresponding competing car or cars

#### 10. Recovery on Legs 2 & 3

Competitors are advised that while efforts may be made to recover stranded vehicles in between the first and second running of stages during Legs 2 & 3 – i.e. SS4-7 vs SS6-9, and SS10-13 vs SS14-17 – in many cases recovery between runs may not be possible, and as such you may be in a remote autumnal location for periods of time. As such, for your own welfare, you advised to take with you in the rally car, suitable protection from the elements, as well as hydration and sustenance.
