Items:-

IMPORTANT REMINDERS TO ALL COMPETITORS

- 1. Drivers must ensure that they wear the their safety equipment properly on special stages all the way until the stop control (helmets and seat belts fastened, balaclava inside the overall, overall zipper closed, driver's gloves worn etc.).
- 2. Any crew which has the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered an accident and the OK sign is not shown, shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. Any crew stopping on a special stage and who does not require immediate medical assistance, must activate the OK display in the Rallysafe unit within one minute and show the OK sign to all other cars.
- 3. All crews that are shown the Red Flag must immediately slow down and continue that lowered speed until the finish of the stage. The Red Flag can be a physical one shown at radio points or an electronic one sent to the Rallysafe unit. The electronic Red Flag must be acknowledged by the crew.
- 4. Refuel Zones
 All crews are reminded to comply with the Supplementary Regulations Art. 8 Fuel. Particular reminder regarding the requirement that the driver and co-driver remain outside the car during refuelling.

 Competitors are also reminded that the use of mobile phones is not allowed in Refuel Zones.
- 5. Speed limit after SS 4/7 Te Akau North
 All competitors are reminded to obey the 80 kph speed limit from box 17 to box 21. This applies both for the reconnaissance and for the rally.
