9. RECONNAISSANCE

9.4 Restrictions

9.4.1 Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, unless instructed by an official of the event or the police. Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish.

Notwithstanding the above, crews are allowed to use parts of special stages while driving back to stage start during reconnaissance:

- SS 4, RB 1, page 1-65, boxes 7 8 (opposite direction on tarmac road for 410 m, and for recce service crews also on SS direction)
- and anywhere when following the Road Book or Reconnaissance Road Book, such as:
 - SS 9 when going to start of SS 11 (RB and Recce RB)
 - O SS12/14, RB 2, page 2-58, box 13 (crossing the special stage as in Recce RB, page 36, box 8)
 - O SS18/20, RB 2, page 2-169, box 10 (through junction as in Recce RB, page 55, box 6)

In addition, the following parts of SS 8 can be used for general travel purposes:

- RB 1, page 1-114, box 10 11 (same direction)
- RB 1, pages 1-114 and 1-115, boxes 15 17 (both directions)

Crews are required to use caution when driving at these locations.
