

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 General information

Tet Rally Latvia will be run in compliance with the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the National Sporting Regulations which comply with the FIA regulations and these Supplementary Regulations. Modifications, amendments and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated Bulletins (issued by the organiser or the Stewards).

Additional information will be published in Rally Guide 2, issued on 20 June. Rally Guide 2 has no regulatory value, except as stipulated in Art. 12.22 in these Supplementary Regulations.

2.10 Communication and the Official Notice Board

During the event, individual and general communication between all Rally Officials (Rally Control/COC, Rally Secretariat, CRO, Stewards, Technical Staff etc.) and the competitors/crew members will primarily and as far as possible be conducted via Sportity App.

For this purpose, each competitor is required to nominate ONE official representative authorized for the purpose of receiving any official notifications. As some of these notifications can be issued while rally cars are on stages, this person can neither be the driver nor the co-driver. This person should be a team representative who is based in the Service Park during the event.

This contact (name, title, cell phone, email) must be nominated before 18.00 July 12, 2024 and sent by email to rally@raevents.lv and will be used both for general and individual communications.

As provided for in 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, Art. 11.9.4, the Official Notice Board will be the Digital Notice Board (DNB), available in the Sportity App and published also on the rally website at www.lvrally.com. There will be no physical official notice board. All competitors will be informed only by Sportity notifications about the publication of any documents on the Digital Notice Board.

Sportity app is downloadable for iOS devices on Appstore and for Android devices on Google Play. Channel password is **WRCLAT24**.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Closing date for entries

The closing date for entries is Monday, 17 June 2024 at 23:59 (CET).

4.2 Entry procedure

Manufacturers, P2 and P3 competitors who wish to score points in FIA Championships, must make their entries by using the electronic standard rally entry form for their championships available in the FIA application at https://registrations.fia.com/rally.

Any non-priority competitor wishing to take part in Tet Rally Latvia rally must register and fill in the electronic entry form published at https://registrations.fia.com/wrclat duly completed before the closing date for entries.

In addition to submitting the online entry form to the FIA, the competitors are also required to send the following documents to rally@raevents.lv before the closing of entries. The entry application will only be accepted if accompanied by:

- Proof of payment of the total amount of entry fees
- Copy of the International Competitor licence
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver international competition licences
- ASN authorisation for all foreign drivers and co-drivers (Art. 3.9.4 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code)
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver passports or identity cards
- Copies of the Driver and Co-driver driving licences
- One passport photo for driver and co-driver
- Copy of the first page of the car homologation certificate (<u>not for Rally1 cars</u>)
- Copies of the car's registration papers
- Copies of the insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car
- Copy of the entry form duly signed

By entering the rally, the competitor and the crew submit themselves to the sporting jurisdictions specified in the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations (2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 22.5).

4.3 Number of competitors accepted and classes

The maximum number of crews will be 60. If more than 60 entries are received the organiser reserves the right to decide which entries among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

Cars will be divided in classes (and groups) as indicated in Article 12.4 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.





4.4 Entry fees

Entry fees for Manufacturers, WRC Teams and competitors in all WRC Support Championships (i.e. WRC2, WRC3) are as stipulated in as defined in Appendix VI of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations +VAT21%.

Any bank charges incurred must be paid by the competitors in addition to the entry fees. Please ensure that the competitor's name and account holder are included as reference on all bank transfers.

4.7 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full only:

- to candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- in the case of the rally not taking place





5. INSURANCE

5.1 Traffic insurance

All cars participating in the rally must have a valid obligatory traffic insurance towards third parties. In Latvia, the "Green Card" (International Motor Insurance Card) system is applied. For cars coming from countries outside the Green Card system and EEA-countries, an insurance must be taken at the border. Traffic insurance guarantees competitor's cover for civil responsibility towards third parties on road sections. All competitors must be able to show their Green Cards at the Pre-rally Scrutineering. The burden of proof for a valid insurance rests solely on the competitor.

5.2 Organiser's liability insurance

The Organiser provides a public and products liability insurance with the cover of € 25 000 000 per any one occurrence for the duration of the rally. Policy number LV23P-L4-10002213-2 issued by BTA AAS.

5.2.1 Damage caused to the third party

Competitors are reminded that only damage caused to third parties by the Organisers and the entered drivers is covered by the insurance policy taken by the Organisation. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars is not covered by this insurance. By submitting their entries, the competitors, drivers and car owners waive any claims or rights to pursue action for damages in connection with the event against the Organiser.

In case of an accident, the competitor or their representative must notify the Secretary of the Rally (phone: +37120470373) as quickly as possible and within 24 hours. They must explain the circumstances under which the accident occurred, eventual causes and consequences. Likewise, they must mention the names and addresses of any witnesses. They must also mention the names and addresses of any injured people.

5.2.2 Damage reporting

In case of an accident, the competitor or their representative must notify Rally Control phone (+371 20470373) as quickly as possible. The circumstances under which the accident occurred, eventual causes and consequences must be explained. Likewise, the names and addresses of any witnesses and any eventual injured people must be given.

5.2.3 Limitation of indemnity

The Organiser declines any liability concerning the consequences caused by any fraudulent action taken by the competitor, may this be against the rules and regulations of the rally or against the laws of the country. Any service vehicles or reconnaissance cars, even those bearing the official identification of the **Tet Rally Latvia** organizer, may under no circumstances be considered as official participants of the rally, hence their insurance policies remain the sole responsibility of the owner.

5.2.4 Duration of the insurance coverage

The insurance, for all competitors, will become effective at the start of procedure for car scrutineering. The insurance ceases at the end of the event (TC 20C - Technical Zone / Parc Fermé - In) or at the end of post-event scrutineering (for the selected cars), in the case of withdrawal, disqualification or exclusion from the rally.

In the case of final withdrawal, the time considered will be the closing time of the following TC.

Cars having retired and restarting the next day (Art. 54 of 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations) shall not be considered to have permanently retired.





6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Restrictions

All political, religious, or abusive advertising is forbidden. Advertising of alcohol, tobacco or tobacco products is forbidden.

6.2 The organiser's advertising

The organiser's advertising on the doors, roof and rear window plates are as stipulated in Appendix 4 of these Supplementary Regulations.

The organiser's optional advertising under the front door panels (67 x 10 cm) will be announced in a Bulletin.

6.3 Identification

Competition numbers and rally plates according to the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 27, will be provided by the organiser. See also Appendix 4.

Numbers and rally plates must be affixed on the rally car before the car is brought to scrutineering and must be visible throughout the duration of the rally.

7. TYRES

7.1 Tyres specified for use during the rally.

In addition to complying with Articles 13, 14 & 15 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the following types of tyres are confirmed for use:

All 4WD cars must use tyres from the FIA nominated tyre company PIRELLI.

For all 2WD cars the make and type of tyre is free. However, competitors are reminded to comply with:

- 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 13.1.4; Each tyre must have barcode numbers supplied by the 2024 FIA-approved barcode supplier.
- 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 13.3.1.
 - At pre-rally scrutineering, the tyre manufacturer will be recorded by the FIA.
 - O During the whole rally, all tyres must come from the same tyre supplier.

7.2 Quantity of tyres

The maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is $\underline{28}$ for Rally1 cars and $\underline{26}$ for all other cars. In accordance with Art. 13.2.5 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations the maximum number of tyres of the alternative choice for all 4WD cars is either 8 or 12.

The FIA must be notified at wrc-technical@fia.com before the start of the Shakedown of the number of tyres of the alternative choice that the competitor wishes to use (P1 competitors must notify the FIA of their choice by Tuesday, 16 July, 18:00 hrs). Alternative compound tyres are not required to be used in the Shakedown.

This choice neither increases nor decreases the maximum number of tyres for the rally. If the competitor wishes to have 12 alternative compound tyres for use in the rally instead of 8, the number of tyres of the first choice will automatically be reduced by 4 tyres.





7.3 Tyre orders

Tyre orders must be placed no later than on Thursday 20 June 2024 using the Pirelli Order Form (available at the rally website www.lvrally.com), indicating the number of the second choice (per driver); maximum of 8 tyres, or, if the Shakedown is driven, maximum of 12 tyres. See Articles 13.2.5 and 15.1 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

7.4 Tyre marking

Tyres will be marked

- at the Shakedown, after the time control
- at the entrance to holding area after TC 0A
- at the Service Park exit after TC 1D, 4C, 8D, 12C, 16D.

8. FUEL

Use of FIA Fuel is mandatory for all drivers. The supplier appointed by the FIA for 2024 is P1, which will carry out fuel ordering, supply and refuel services.

For environmental and safety reasons, all competitors must refuel in the designated refuel zones. Refuelling is not allowed in the Service Park (no refuel from cans, drums or similar).

8.1 Ordering procedure and price per litre

The system for ordering fuel is completely online and requires a prior registration: https://order.p1fuels.com/. Detailed instructions are available at the forementioned website before registration / logging-in.

The cost of the FIA fuel is € 6,57 + VAT21% per litre. Only pre-payment by bank transfer is accepted. A copy of the transfer must be sent to P1 before the deadline of the orders. In case of questions related to fuel ordering procedures, please contact directly motorsports@p1fuels.com.

8.2 Closing date for ordering FIA fuel

Thursday 20 June 2024.

8.3 Refuelling operations

Crews are required to remain outside their cars during refuelling. A member of the crew will open the vehicle to allow the operative to attach the pipework. The crew will be responsible for indicating to the refueller the amount of fuel required. The crew only shall close the vehicle and secure the opening once they are happy that they have the right amount of fuel added. Use of a mobile phone is forbidden at the Refuelling Zones.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

See also Art. 35 in the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

9.1 Procedure for reconnaissance registration

The competitor must send the organiser in advance an information form (see Website / Rally Guide 2) to rally@raevents.lv including details of the reconnaissance car, mobile phone number and place where the competitor is accommodated. The form must be signed and submitted by Monday, 8 July 2024 at 23.59 CET at the latest.

All reconnaissance and rally materials may be collected from the rally HQ by the nominated competitor representative, holding a written proxy, at the administrative checks on Monday, 15 July. Individual times will be published in a Bulletin.

Identification numbers, given at the registration, shall be affixed on the reconnaissance car (windscreen at the top corner, co-drivers side) and kept visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

9.2 Participation in reconnaissance only.

Any driver holding an appropriate international licence but not entered in the rally may apply to take part in the reconnaissance. The regulations on reconnaissance must be respected in their entirety. A registration form for this purpose will be sent on request. The final permission for taking part in recce is left to the discretion of the organiser. An administrative fee will be charged (see Art. 4.4.1).





9.3 Tracking system for reconnaissance

With reference to Art. 35.4.4 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, all competitors must make one iOS or Android smartphone available and equip their reconnaissance cars with a smartphone-based application RS Lite developed by the FIA official supplier STATUS AWARENESS SYSTEM (SAS). SAS will distribute individual event access codes during the reconnaissance registration.

Rental of smartphones is also available from SAS, to be requested when completing the access code purchase on the SAS website and collected during the reconnaissance registration.

Access code costs:

- all competitors: € 40 + optional smartphone device rental € 100
- payment must be done online and in advance on the SAS website: https://wrc.statusas.com/shop/recce/

9.4 Restrictions

See article 35 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

- **9.4.1** Competitors are permitted a maximum of two passages over each special stage during reconnaissance. For reconnaissance purposes, all stages run more than once in the rally are considered to be one special stage. All passages through the special stages will be recorded by the marshals. Timecards will not be used.
- **9.4.2** Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, unless instructed by an official of the event or the police. Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish
- 9.4.3 Unless a lower limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instructions in the Road Book or in a bulletin, the maximum speed on all special stages during reconnaissance is 80 km/h except on SSS 1 and SSS 16 the limit is 50 km/h.
- **9.4.4** Excessive speed during reconnaissance will incur a fine to be applied by the Clerk of the Course (2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 34.2).
- **9.4.5** The fitting or carrying of radar detection equipment is not permitted.

9.4.6 Reconnaissance of SSS 1 and SSS 16

SSS 1 and SSS 16 consist of two laps. Reconnaissance is allowed for two passages of full distance. At the point where both laps meet, the crews who are already on the stage have the priority, the starting crews must yield.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

Document checks will be done online, before the event, but original documents along with the duly signed entry form must be brought to the administrative checks. All required documents as per Art. 4.2 must be scanned and sent to the organizer by email to rally@raevents.lv latest on Tuesday, 18 June at 23.59 CET.

Notwithstanding the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 30.1, drivers and co-drivers are not required to report personally to the administrative checks.

Each Competitor shall nominate in advance to the Organiser one authorised representative to complete the administrative checks.

- Driver and Co-driver passports or identity cards

- · Insurance cover (third parties) for the rally car
- Entry form duly signed





10.2 Timetable

The collection of documents and materials will take place on Monday 15 July at the Rally Office in Riga Motor museum, S. Eizenšteina str. 8, Riga. Individual times will be allocated and published in a Bulletin.

11. SCRUTINEERING

11.1 Venue and Timetable

Sealing and Marking of Rally1 cars:

Venue: Individual service bays, Service Park
 Date and time: Wednesday 17 July from 08:00 to 11:30

Scrutineering / Component Sealing of all other cars:

Venue: Service park, Northern Breakwater, Liepaja
 Date and time: Wednesday 17 July from 13:00 onwards

Detailed timetables will be published in a Bulletin.

11.2 General requirements

- **11.2.1** Competition numbers and rally plates (as well as the organiser's optional advertisement, if required) must be affixed to cars in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. See Art. 6 and Appendix 4.
- **11.2.2** All cars must have a complete certified homologation form available at scrutineering (2024 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix J, Art. 251.2.1.8). In addition, homologation forms for the catalytic converter and roll cage (if homologated), and any certificate for the safety fuel cell must be with the car at scrutineering.
- **11.2.3** Sealing of the cars will be carried out according to 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Articles 16 & 17. Therefore, all underbody protection must be removed for scrutineering, but must be kept with the car for weight checks. Car's chassis and cylinder block will also be marked (2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 31.1.6). Sealing wires must be installed as instructed by the car manufacturer.
- **11.2.4** After scrutineering, if a car is found not to comply with technical and/or safety regulations, the Stewards may set a deadline to comply with the requirements otherwise start in the event may be refused.

11.3 Mud flaps

Fitting of transversal mud flaps (all wheels) is mandatory in conformity with Appendix J, Art. 252.7.7.

11.4 Windows / Nets

The use of transparent and colourless anti-shatter films (maximum thickness: 100 microns) is compulsory on side and sunroof windows, unless they are in polycarbonate (see Art. 253.11 of 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix J). Window nets are not allowed.

The use of silvered or tinted films is authorised, on the rear side windows, on the rear window and on the sunroof, on the following conditions:

• Silvered or tinted films fitted on rear side windows must have an opening equivalent to the surface of a circle of 70 mm in diameter so that the driver as well as the contents of the car may be seen from the outside.

11.5 Drivers' safety equipment

At scrutineering competitors must produce all items of clothing including helmets and head restraints intended to be used. Condition of the equipment and compliance with 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix L, Chapter III will be checked. Also, see Appendix 5 of these Supplementary Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that two belt cutters must be carried on board at all times. They must be easily accessible to driver and co-driver when seated with their safety belts fastened (Art. 253-6.1.2, Appendix J, 2024 FIA International Sporting Code).





Each competing car must carry a red "SOS" sign and on the reverse a green "OK" sign measuring at least 42 cm x 29.7 cm (A3), in conformity with the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 53.2.2.

11.6 Noise level

At any time on the road sections, the noise level must be in conformity with Appendix J. See also 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 18.4.

11.7 FIA Safety tracking device (2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 18.2 and 53.2.1)

All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering.

For installation and operating instructions see Appendix 6. Systems may be collected either by the crew or a representative.

No deposit will be collected for the rally safety tracking equipment, but all the damage caused will be invoiced afterwards.

The FIA Safety Emergency Console System device may be removed in the final parc fermé by a team member under the supervision of a scrutineer. In any case, the device must be returned to STATUS AWARENESS SYSTEM (SAS) truck in Service Park no later than one hour after the Stewards have authorised the opening of the parc fermé.

11.8 On-board Cameras

Competitors wishing to use an on-board camera must apply via the WRC Accreditation Portal by Monday 8 July 2024 at the latest.

Those registering for an OBC for the first time in the 2024 WRC Season should first use this link: https://bit.ly/OBC2024Registration.

Those who have already applied for an OBC in 2024 should register via this link: https://bit.ly/WRCOBCForm.

An authorisation sticker, which must be affixed to the car in the vicinity of the authorised camera prior to Scrutineering, must be obtained from at the Administrative checks.

The fixings of the camera and camera recorder must comply with 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, Appendix J, Art.253.2.

For safety reasons, on road sections charging / re-generation of the Hybrid Device (HPS) is only allowed while the car is in motion (GPS speed of the vehicle > 0 km/h).





12. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 FIA eLearning course and Drivers' Safety Briefing

All drivers and co-drivers who have not yet participated in any WRC event in 2024 must complete the FIA eLearning course and pass the assessment for FIA Safety Tracking Device by Friday, 12 July 2024, 21:00 hrs and are required to attend the Drivers' Safety Briefing on Wednesday, 17 July 2024 at 19:00 at Roses Hall, LOC, Brīvības iela 39, Liepāja.

Instructions for the eLearning course will be sent to the competitors by email once the Entry List is published.

12.2 Shakedown

See Article 36 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

All P1 and other requested drivers will be required to complete their first passage of Shakedown in the order of Championship classification, and at an interval defined by the Clerk of the Course in consultation with FIA and WRC Promoter.

- FIA P1 drivers shall complete a minimum of 2 passages in total of the Shakedown.
- FIA P2 and P3 drivers must complete at least one passage, and they are permitted a maximum of 3 passages in total of the Shakedown.
- Participation is optional for non-priority drivers, and they are permitted a maximum of 3 passages in total of the Shakedown stage. Non-priority drivers wishing to drive in Shakedown must register before Monday 8 July 2024 using the form available at rally@raevents.lv.

12.3 Official time used during the rally

Official time throughout the entire rally will be that of GPS (UTC time + offset to local time).

12.4 Start of the Rally

- 12.4.1 Date and time: Thursday, 18 July 2024, 18:15 (Podium at Riga City council)
- **12.4.2** The suggested itinerary from the Service Park (Liepaja) to the unloading and Holding area in Riga, will be given in Rally Guide 2.
- **12.4.3** Rally cars must enter the Holding area between 16:00 and 19:00 hrs on Thursday, 18 May 2024. A representative of the team may deliver the car.
- **12.4.4** Entering the Holding area outside the indicated window will incur a fine of € 250, notified to the competitor by the Clerk of the Course.
- **12.4.5** The holding area will be under vigilance. Access to the Holding area is limited to team members and media representatives with appropriate identification. Team's vehicles are not allowed inside the Holding area.

12.5 Control Procedures and Timecard Handling

The complete set of Time Cards for the whole rally (including the Shakedown) will be delivered with the rally materials at the administrative checks. It is imperative for all crews to carry at least all the Time Card sets for a whole day inside the car (cf. for example procedures at regrouping controls).

Time control procedures will be as described in 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Arts. 43, 44, 46, 48, 49 and 55. Any writing on the time cards can only be done by the rally officials, except filling in the car number and markings on the boxes reserved for competitor's use.

12.6 Start order for the rally and starting intervals

The start order for all Sections will be in accordance with Article 41.2 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The starting intervals will be 3 minutes for all P1 crews, 2 minutes for all P2 crews and 1 minute for all other crews (changes are possible as per Art. 41.1 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations).

Starting interval for P1 drivers in SSS1 will be 2 minutes, for all others 1 minute.





Starting interval for all drivers on SSS16 will be 3 minutes. If it will be necessary marshals can increase it by extra 30 seconds.

For SS 20 Mazilmāja - Wolf Power Stage the starting intervals will be decided by the FIA and the WRC Promoter in discussion with the Clerk of the Course.

12.7 Starting system of special stages

The standard light sequence mentioned in Article 48.2 and Appendix VII, of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will be used.

Should this start system fail the start will be given as specified in Article 48.3 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

12.8 SSS 1 - procedures and running order

SSS 1 "Bikernieki track" will be run on tarmac surface with gravel tires only and will consist of 2 laps of a circuit combination track with a crossover of approximately 5.20 km (total length of 10.80 km).

The maximum time allowed to complete SSS 1 will be 12 minutes. Any crew who fails to complete SSS 1 within this maximum time or does not start SSS 1 will occur in the penalties laid down in Article 54.2 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations. If the running of SSS 1 is interrupted, this will be signalled to the drivers by showing red flags. When given this signal, the driver must immediately reduce speed and follow instructions of any marshals or other officials. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards. If the super special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, Art. 52 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will be applied.

12.9 SSS 16- procedures and running order

SSS 16 "Liepaja city stage" will be run on tarmac surface and it consists of 2 laps of a circuit combination track with a crossover of approximately 1.30 km (total length of 2.54 km). The organisers reserve the right to "match" competing vehicles for the super special stage on grounds of public interest.

The maximum time allowed to complete SSS 16 will be 4 minutes. Any crew who fails to complete SSS 16 within this maximum time or does not start SSS 16 will occur in the penalties laid down in Article 54.2 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations. If the running of SSS 16 is interrupted, this will be signalled to the drivers by showing red flags. When given this signal, the driver must immediately reduce speed and follow instructions of any marshals or other officials. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards. If the super special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, Art. 52 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations will be applied.

12.10 Re-Start after retirement

With reference to Art. 54 in the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, any crew which fails to complete a Section will be assumed to re-start the rally from the start of the next Section following the overnight regroup. Any crew re-starting the rally must present their cars at the overnight parc fermé at the latest four hours before the start of the next Section following the overnight regroup.

<u>If not re-starting</u>, the competitor must complete the form located in the road book and lodge it with the organiser as soon as possible before the publication of the Start List.

For cars driven by priority drivers, a special time card will be used for the maximum of 3-hour service (4 hours for P1).

12.11 Flexi Service

The 45-minute services at the end of Sections 3 and 7 are preceded by a Technical Zone. The procedure described in 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Art. 59 will apply for all competitors.

12.12 Power Stage (SS 20 Mazilmāja - Wolf Power Stage)

With reference to Article 50.1 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, SS 20 Mazilmāja will be run as the Power Stage.

12.13 Permitted early check-in

Early check-in is allowed at the following time controls: TC 0A, 1A, 8C, 16C, 20A, 20B, 20C. Early check-in is also allowed at TC 8A and 16A after the drivers have fulfilled their media obligations.





12.14 Car wash facilities

A car wash facility will be available on the route into service. Washing cars within the service park is prohibited at any time unless specifically authorised by the organiser. Wheels and other parts may be washed in the designated wash bays set up within the service park. All competitors must put in place a suitable size plastic ground sheet to cover the whole area where service work is being carried out. This ground sheet must be impervious to all fluids. Cleaning of the ground sheets must be done so that no materials are allowed to come into contact with the ground surface. All waste material must be disposed of in the facilities provided.

12.15 HEV Zones for Rally1 Cars

Rally1 cars must drive in electric mode inside the Service Park (starting from Thursday morning when leaving for the Shakedown) and elsewhere as indicated in the Road Books and/or in Bulletins.

12.16 Overnight Parc Fermé

Crews are allowed to bring drinks and install 'camel bags' in their cars in the Parc fermé using only tools carried in the rally car on Friday 19 July before TC 1B, Saturday 20 July before TC 8D and on Sunday 21 July before TC 16D.

Notwithstanding Art. 63.2 and in accordance with Art. 2.13 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the following applies at the Start of Sections 2, 4 and 8:

Under the supervision of scrutineers, one representative of each Manufacturer together with the hybrid system provider's representative are allowed to enter the overnight parc fermé 20 minutes before the competitor's car due start time to ensure that the car's high voltage system starts-up normally when the main power is switched on. If necessary, the hybrid system provider's representative is allowed to connect a laptop to the car and perform a system reset. No other work is allowed on the car.

When the car is parked in the overnight parc fermé the MSD has to be turned into OFF-position.

12.17 Media Zones

All priority drivers (and co-drivers upon request) must be available for media interviews for a minimum of 15 minutes or until they are given permission to leave by the FIA Media Delegate.

The Media Zone will be operational as follows: TC 4A, 8A, 10A, 12A, 16A, 18A and at the holding area after TC 20A.

Access to the Media Zone is restricted to the following:

- Accredited media or team media personnel holding a green pass.
- Team principals or team representatives, who are, in view of the FIA Media Delegate, performing media duties. Those representatives must request to the FIA Media Delegate the delivery and activation of the NFC sticker on their pass for this event.
- Holders of a red All Access pass.

No other personnel will be allowed in the Media Zone unless authorised by the FIA Media Delegate and holding the correct pass with approved access.

Requests for the delivery and activation of the NFC sticker (excluding red all-access and green media passes) should be sent by email to: FIA Media Delegate Vera Dussausaye, vdussausaye@fia.com no later than 15:00 on Tuesday 16 July.

12.18 Media Pen

An FIA WRC Media Pen will be organised on Thursday, 18 July at 10:30 - 12:00 at the Service Park. The FIA WRC Media Pen is mandatory for all P1 drivers and P2 drivers, as well as for Manufacturers' Team Principals, and upon request by the media to the FIA Media Delegate or National Press Officer for all other priority drivers or co-drivers. Attending competitors are required to be present for a duration of 30 min minimum, or until dismissed by the FIA Media Delegate. P2 drivers are recommended to come from 11:15 onwards.

12.19 Promotional Activities with Drivers

The exact promotional activities with drivers will be published in Rally Guide 2.

Promotional activities with P1 drivers will be separately liased with WRC Manufacturer team representatives.





12.20 Finish Procedure

The exact location of the finish ceremony and prize giving will be shown in Rally Guide 2 and in the road book. Crews which are not awarded prizes may proceed directly to final Parc Fermé if they do not wish to drive over the finish ramp for a photo opportunity.

12.21 Exhibition driving

Exhibition driving ("doughnuts") is strictly forbidden everywhere due to lack of suitable space. All infringements will be penalised with a minimum of a 5-minute time penalty, applied by the Stewards.

12.22 Environmental prescriptions

All competitors are obliged to follow the directions and objectives in the Organiser's Environmental Policy which will be published in detail in Rally Guide 2. It is considered as an integral part of these Supplementary Regulations.

For any violations of the recycling instructions given for the service park area, the following penalties apply:

1st infringement a fine of € 1000 notified by the Clerk of the Course
 2nd infringement a fine of € 2000 notified by the Clerk of the Course

3rd infringement will be reported to the Stewards

12.23 Final Parc Fermé

All cars must be removed from the final parc fermé at the latest two hours after the Stewards have authorised the parc fermé to be opened.

12.24 Tyre Fitting Zones

Tyre fitting zone "A" and "B" will be held in Tukums, in the parking of "Tukums ice hall".

15. FINAL CHECKS AND PROTESTS

15.1 Final checks

Post-rally scrutineering will take place on Sunday, 21 July at Service Park immediately after the final TC.

Cars subject to final checks (COC Communication notified to the competitor concerned at the finish TC) must have one representative of the competitor as well as mechanics and proper equipment (in case of dismantling) present at the final checks.

15.2 Protest deposit

The protest deposit is € 1,000.

If a protest requires the dismantling and reassembly of a clearly defined part of the car (engine, transmission, steering, braking system, electrical installation, bodywork, etc.), an additional deposit may be specified by the Stewards in accordance with Art. 13.4.3 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code.

The expenses incurred in the work and in the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.

If the protest is unfounded, and if the expenses incurred by the protest (scrutineering, transport, etc.) are higher than the amount of the (additional) deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely, if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned.

15.3 Right of review deposit

The right of review deposit is 1.000 €.

15.4 Appeal deposit

The International Appeal Deposit is € 6,000.



APPENDIX 5 – DRIVERS' SAFETY EQUIPMENT

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III – Drivers' Equipment. These regulations apply to Shakedown as well.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

Priority 1 drivers and their co-drivers must wear helmets according to the FIA standard 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP. This also applies to all Priority 2 crews competing with a World Rally Car.

All other crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

8859-2015 (Technical List Nº 49),
 8860-2010 (Technical List Nº 33) or
 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List Nº 69)

see also Technical List Nº 25

Drivers and co-drivers who wear full-face helmets must contact the FIA Medical Delegate (wrc.medicaldelegate@fia.com) or the Chief Medical Officer in order to carry out a test before the start of the event. This test is described in the Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1.3.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List Nº 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List Nº 74).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) <u>as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1.</u>

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868- 2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

- i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,
- ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and
- iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.
