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## 1 Online Documentation

Signing on and document checking is being done online before you arrive at the rally. Follow the link in your entry system email to complete online signing on for driver & co-driver. You should also take a picture of your competition licence and club membership card and attach them to your entry form. This will allow us to check and sort any issues before you arrive.

## 2 Trailer Unloading & Parking

The Trailer Park is located within the service area towards the exit. Please park all trailers sensibly within the area provided. Trailers must not be parked in the service area. The Police have advised that trailer locks should be used and vans secured at all times.

## 3 Decals & Rally Plates

On arrival at the service park please collect your pack, which will include your competition car decals and service vehicle decal, which must be affixed on entering, roadbook, A3 route maps and timecards. Teams servicing more than one crew should make prior arrangement with Assistant Clerk of the Course, Dave Robson [daverobson61@outlook.com](mailto:daverobson61@outlook.com) 07792 267216 for the issue of service plates due to the limited space.

## 4 Service Area

Service Park is at Auction Mart, Old Station Court, Newtown St Boswells. TD6 0PP.

The service park will open at 12.00pm on Friday 5th May and 06.30am on Saturday 6th May. Only ONE service vehicle per competing car will be allowed into the Service Park. This will be strictly enforced. All Servicing must be carried out on liquid proof tarpaulins. There will be a one-way system in operation. Space in the service area is limited and teams are not expected to occupy an area larger than 7m x 7m.

There will be toilets and catering is available. Please make use of these facilities.

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If following the event, the organisers receive complaints from anyone concerning the conduct of any competitor or service personnel, these will be forwarded to the Motorsport UK for further action. The Speed Limit within the Service Area is 5 MPH.

### 5 Noise Check & Scrutineering

The noise test will be located towards the exit of the service area per the map below. Decals must be affixed before attending noise test.

Tracker cradles will be supplied by SportTraxx at noise test should any competitor require one. There is a cost of £5.00 each payable to SportTraxx. Do not leave noise test without a tracker cradle, you will be turned away from scrutineering.

Once you have completed noise test proceed to scrutineering, which is located at Euroroute Recovery, Charlesfield Ind Est. Melrose TD6 0HH

### 6 Competitor Briefing

There will be a competitor briefing document issued on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May, which will be available on the Sportity App.

### 7 Trackers

Tracker issue will be in Abbey Place, Jedburgh prior to TC0. They will be collected at TC7A. If you retire you must ensure the tracker is given to the Sweeper Car or returned to Rally HQ in Jedburgh Town Hall.

### 8 Tyre Vans

Tyre Vans from Andrew Wood Motorsport, MRF Tyres and Tyres South Shore will be present in the service park on Friday and Service on Saturday.

### 9 Re-Fuel Zone

The refuel zone is located in Waverly Place Car Park as shown on the map below. It will open at 5.00pm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May. Vital Equipment will be available in the refuel zone for the duration of the event. Manual refuelling will be located at the refuel zone and fuel must be pumped into vehicles. Service Crews may deposit suitably labelled fuel containers at the refuel zone on Saturday morning prior to 09.30am.

Environmental Scrutineer, Peter Clingan will oversee manual refuelling. All refuelling must take place in the refuel zone other than bona fide use of filling stations identified in the roadbook.

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## 10 Measured Mile

A marked measured mile will be set up on the A68 following RS0 from post 4 to post 5.

## 11 Start/Finish

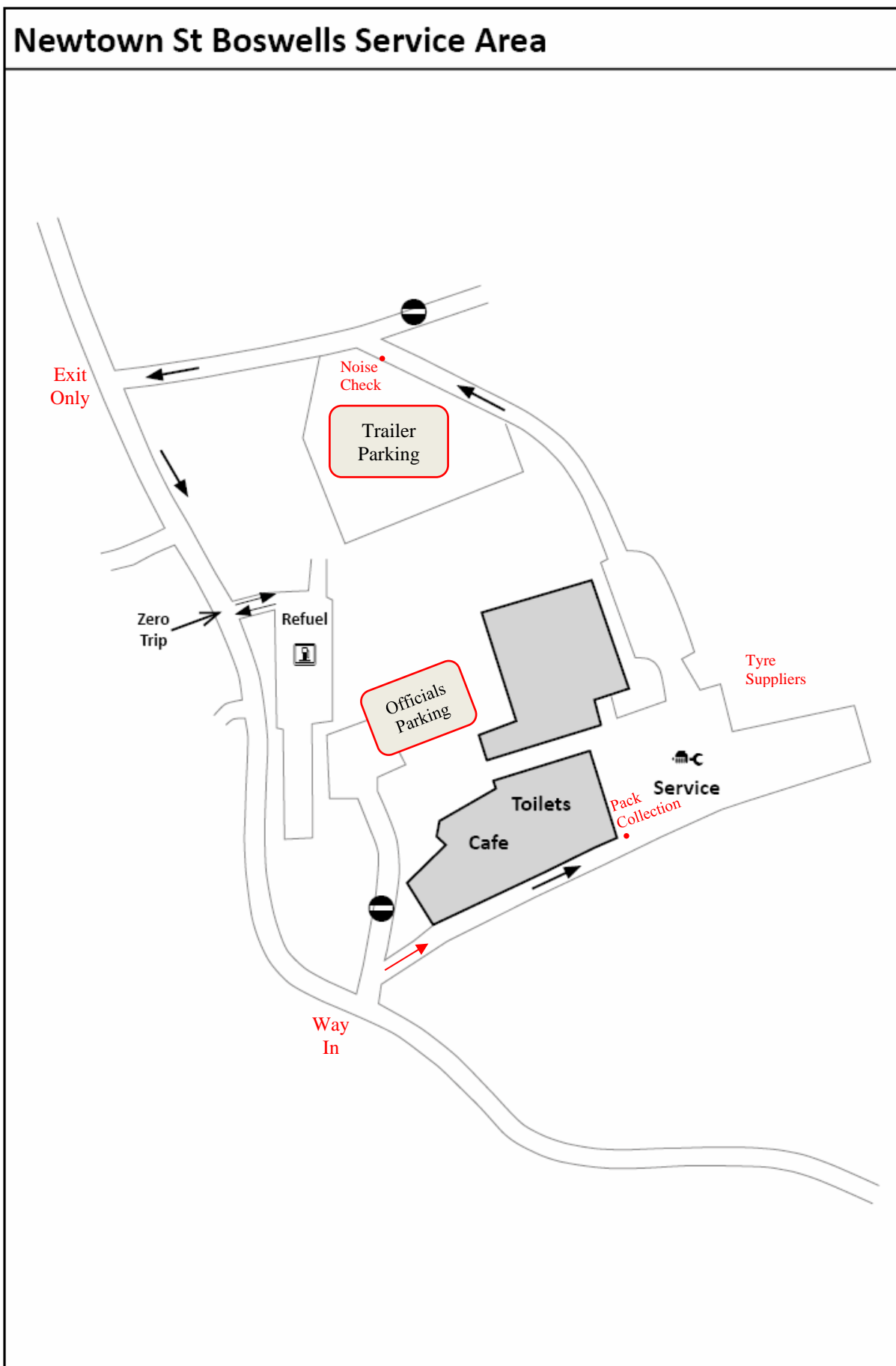
The Start (TC0) is located in Abbey Place, Jedburgh. The route from Service to TC0 is the same as RS5C (page 50) turning right at post 13. If you arrive too early parking is available in the Abbey Car Park.

Finish Control (TC7A), champagne ceremony and prizegiving will all take place in Abbey Place, Jedburgh. The return route to service is the same as RS3B (page 25).

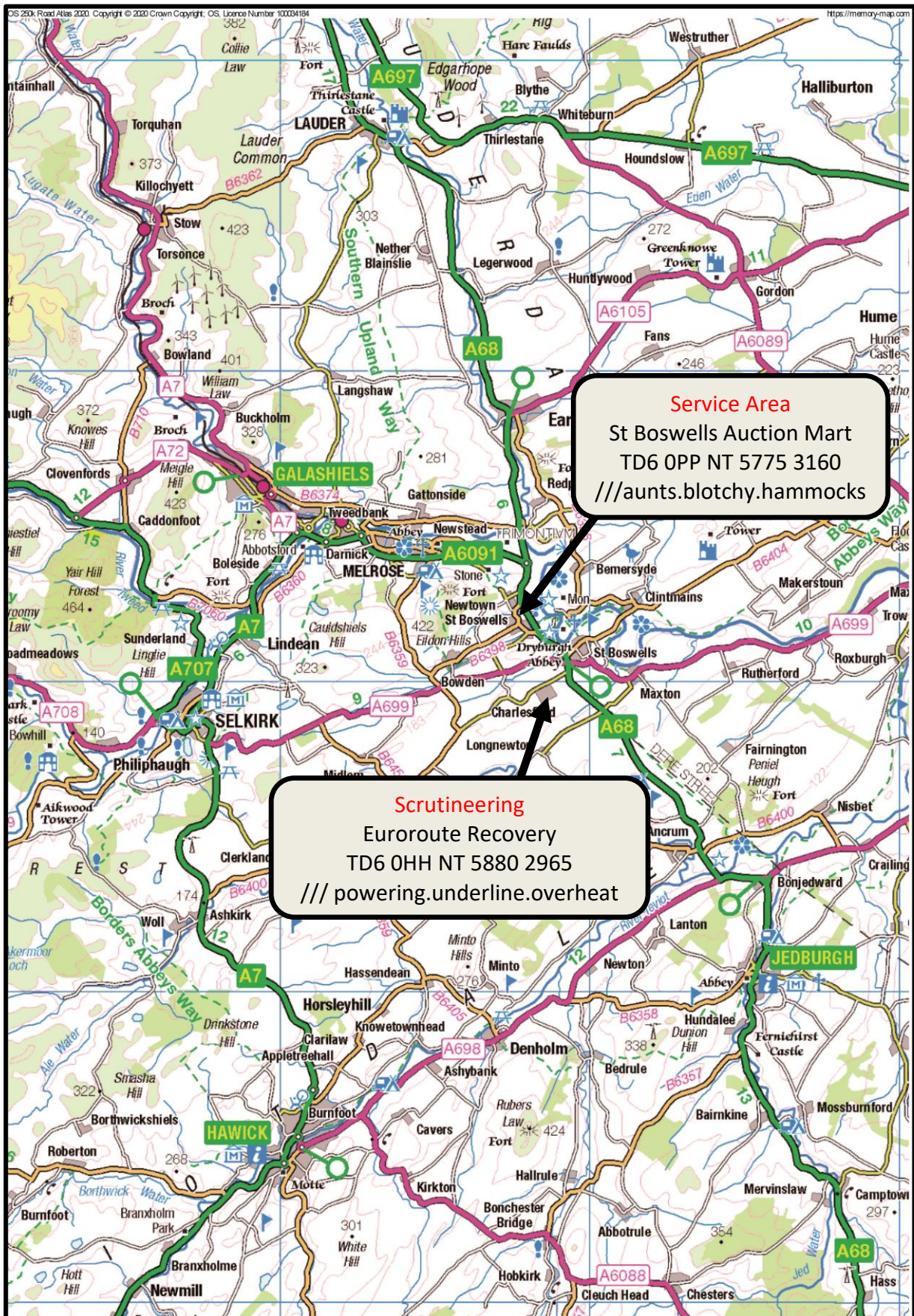
Appendix 1 – Service Area
