## **ISU CHALLENGER SERIES**

As part of the ISU Challenger Series, the Nebelhorn Trophy 2025 is proud to be an opportunity for competitors to gain important points for the ISU World Standing and also to be the place to host the ISU Judges Examination in the categories Singles and Pairs as well as Ice Dance.



## **EISSPORTZENTRUM OBERSTDORF**

The Eissportzentrum has 3 rinks and covers an area of 26.400qm.  
The competition will take place in rink 1. Rink 2 will hold the warmup area, skaters lounge, media area etc.

## **ISU CENTER OF EXCELLENCE**

The ISU Center of Excellence is a figure skating facility that focuses on the education of coaches, officials and talented figure skaters, as well as hosting various seminars and workshops.

Here, skaters, coaches and officials have access to experts, services and sufficient on and off ice facilities.

Since 2019 the Eissportzentrum Oberstdorf is one of the ISU Centers of Excellence and provides opportunities for single and pair skaters as well as ice dancers.

## TRANSPORTATION

The easiest, cheapest and most environmental friendly way to get to Oberstdorf is by train with the regional day ticket for Bavaria ([Bayern Ticket](#)). It is valid from 9am for the whole day and you can use it as a group up to 5 people. All train connections can be checked on the [Deutsche Bahn Website](#).

For flight bookings, please be aware:

- no arrival time at Munich Airport should be planned later than 6pm
- no departure time from Munich Airport should be planned before 10.30am



## ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be provided at the OC office upon arrival. Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Competitor, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President) and the team medical staff.

Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member. Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests. Chaperons will not receive accreditation, event tickets must be purchased for the entry.

The Fritz-Geiger-Memorial-Trophy 2025 will be awarded to the best-placed team with the highest number of points in the 57th Nebelhorn Trophy. The ceremony will take place at 7.30pm on Saturday September 27th right before the gala. Every skater of the winning nations is welcome to join their team mates on the podium for celebration. This year, a special trophy will be awarded to the winning nation.

# OBERSTDORF - HEART OF ALLGÄU -

Oberstdorf is located in the south-west of Bavaria, Germany. It is the centre of tourism within the region called „Oberallgäu“.

About 10.000 inhabitants live in Oberstdorf, but more than 20.000 beds are available for guests during the year.

The pedestrian area in the village might be the biggest in the World (227.500 square meters) – only a few streets are available for traffic. Oberstdorf was the first community in Germany, which kept the cars outside the village.

The altitude of the village itself is 813m; the highest mountain next door to the Eissportzentrum, the Nebelhorn, is over 2.200m.

All kind of sport activities are possible in Oberstdorf.

Magnificent ski areas, more than 200km of well equipped hiking paths into the 7 valleys, used also for cross-country skiing in the wintertime, mountain climbing, golf, rafting and many other indoor and outdoor sports are offered, but one of the main attractions in Oberstdorf is the National Training Centre for Figure Skating, where we are happy to host the 57th Nebelhorn Trophy.
