

PROCEDURE FOR INSTALLING GPS UNIT COMPONENT



- 1) In the enclosed package you will find the following components: power cable and antenna with two cables.
- 2) The power cable connects to the vehicle battery. It must be connected after the disconnecter
- 3) The antenna is placed on the roof of the vehicle, ideally at the rear of the roof on the passenger side. This is because the wires connected to the antenna will lead towards the passenger side. (Figure 1)
- 4) It is ideal to run the cables along the safety frame of the vehicle and anchor them with e.g. electrician's tape.
- 5) The power cable and the cables from the antenna must be fed into the area in front of the passenger (dashboard area), so that so that the ends of the cables can be manipulated during installation of the GPS unit.
- 6) You must have the antenna and power cable installed before scrutineering, where they will install the rest of the GPS unit.

IMPORTANT!

For power cable: **blue** = minus (negative), **brown** = plus (positive)
