Appendix Q - Media Instructions

Only designated media personnel, who signed on to this event will be allowed special access as per this appendix. This includes MOTORSPORT UK Registered media and other media accredited to local requirements. The full requirements can be found on the <u>Rally Future Web Page</u>.

The Media must operate in accordance with the Rally Future requirements, the Safety Plan for the event, Snetterton/MSV instructions and the relevant Health and Safety legislation

Media MUST be identifiable by wearing the correct MOTORSPORT UK issued tabard at all times during the event. This is shown on page 2 of this appendix.

Any movement outside the scope of the above may result in removal from the venue and/or a report to the MOTORSPORT UK.

Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (Drones) are not allowed at the venue.

Permissible photography/ video locations are:

Any person may photograph or video from the parts of the venue that are open to the Pubic, i.e. the Grandstands, and the areas around the circuit. Duly Authorised media personnel may enter the Stage Arrivals and Passage Check areas but must not unduly delay competitors in these areas. They MAY NOT enter the Stage Start and Stage Finish control areas, except where the photographer may set up a safe distance away from the competing cars.

Media Personnel may enter the stage area with permission to go to agreed locations. They must stay in a safe place not in a position that may distract competitors, i.e. follow MOTORSPORT UK Guidelines.

If Media Personnel wish to access any of the main circuit areas they must seek permission from the Media Officer in order to do so and may only go to positions that have been agreed with MSVR staff in Race Control.

The Media Officer must be approached for assistance and guidance where interviews of competitors, or set pieces, particularly at the finish, are requested.

The requirement for High Viz / Media Accredited tabards is relaxed when filmed interviews are being carried out.

Any film/photographs taken should be made available in the unfortunate event of an incident which requires further investigation.

The Media Officer is briefed in the event and MOTORSPORT UK requirements in the handling of a major incident and the need for brief accurate reporting that has been duly authorised.
