SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

8. SERVICE

Service cars must have a 6 kg hand fire extinguisher for each crew and ready-to-use oil spill mat. Under the rallycar and under the service car there must be liquid impermeable Environmental Mat which is at least the size of car's floor area. Under the rally car there must be liquid impermeable Environmental Mat which is at least the size of car's floor area. In addition to the requirements in the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations, all service vehicles must have a liquid impermeable Environmental Mat which is the size of car's engine compartment's floor area under the car for the duration of its stay in the service area. Impermeable Environmental Mat must also be placed under any external electricity generators, heaters and other fuel containing containers.

ADDITION TO REGULATIONS

Finnish Rally Championship Regulations article 13.3 Re-start after retirement

If a competitor retires a two-day race on the first day or the right to start is denied as a result of scrutineering, the competitor has the opportunity to repair a technical problem in the car or the subject of a repair order issued by scrutineers during the night break, and to join the race the next day.

We assume you want to continue the race for part 2. If you are sure that you will not continue the race, please notify the Clerk of the Course by Friday 3.3.2023 at 23:00.

14. COMPETITION MATERIALS

Driver's licenses of both drivers will be checked when the material is distributed.

15. START

Competitors in classes 1-7 and 13-15 will receive their time card on Friday 3.3.2023 at 18:58 at TC 1. The start happens starting from 19:01 and every three minutes after. Time cards for part 1 will be collected from the competitors at TC Parc Fermé starting from 19:38. Competitors will receive time card for part 2 at TC Parc Fermé on 4.3.2023 at 9:20.

Competitors in classes 8-27 will receive their time card on 4.3.2023 from 10:01 at TC start B. The start happens on Saturday 4.3.2023 starting from 10:01 and every 1 minute after at Killeri ravirata (Vesangantie 24 40630).

Time Card A

Competitors in classes 1-7 and 13-15 will receive time card A on Friday 3.3.2023 at 18:58 at TC 1. The start happens at 19:01 and every 2 minutes after. Time cards for part 1 will be collected from competitors at Start B. Note! Changed from the supplementary regulations.

Time card B

All competitors will receive time card B on 4.3.2023 starting from 10:01 at TC Start B. Note! Changed from the supplementary regulations.

















PARC FERMÉ

Regulation about Parc Fermé: (Exception to Rally Regulations article 28 Parc Fermé)

Race car crew and an additional two (2) service team members are allowed to enter Parc Fermé 10 minutes before their own start time.

In addition, the service team members are allowed to carry with them the equipment necessary for heating and a battery booster. Actions other than those required to start the car are prohibited.

ADDITION:

Early check in is permitted at TC 1A Parc Fermé (shown in the time card).

ADDITION: TIME CARDS

Flex Service

The competitor can start service at the time of their choice, when they mark the start time of the service in the time card and place the time card on the windshield to be visible.

No markings can be made to the time card after this until the service has ended and that time is marked on the time card. The organizer is going around the service are to monitor the service times. The inspectors need to have free access to the service areas and the race car under service needs to be clearly visible from outside of the service tent.

Regulation about managing time cards: (Exception to Rally Regulations article 14.5 Time card)

Time card is a separate document. The time cards are intended for competitors own use and competitor is allowed and needs to do the markings to the time card.

The time card is not handed out to the official. The competitor shows their wish to present the time card by placing the card on the side window or by making a movement which imitates handing over the time card. The officials nod as a sign that they have noticed it and they record the time in the big time card they have and present the marking to the competitor. The competitor marks the corresponding time(s) into their time card and confirm receipt of the information with thumb up sign.
