8.3 Refuel during the Rally

8.3.1 Refuel before the Start (new article)

Refuelling from drums and cans inside the service park is absolutely forbidden. All pre-rally fuel activities (i.e. emptying tanks of non-WRC fuel, refuel of WRC fuel from drums etc.) must be done in an area

adjacent to the service park refuel zone marked in the SP lay-out (see Road Book, p. 50C). We recommend that all work is done during the RZ opening hours for the Shakedown. At all times, the competitor must have two 6 kg fire-extinguishers with operators ready with the car. Any such work may not be done within the actual RZ, nor may it disturb any refuel operations at the RZ.

8.3.2 Refuel as part of service under FIA WRC, Art. 58 (new article)

The prescriptions of FIA WRC, Art. 58 apply, with the addition that all competitors placed inside the exhibition halls must have two 6 kg fire-extinguishers with operators ready during any such service. The organiser must be informed before starting the service (Mr. Jarmo Harju, +358 44 548 5558).

12. OTHER PROCEDURES**12.2.1 Opening Ceremonies (replace with)**

The Opening Ceremony takes place on Wednesday 29 July 2026 and consists of a 75th Anniversary Rally Parade through the city centre of Jyväskylä, followed by an autograph session at teams' service bays. The ceremonies will commence at 18.00 with the start of the parade. The estimated attendance time required from each individual competitor and/or manufacturer representative is approximately one hour and a half.

a) Rally Parade

Participation in the Rally Parade is mandatory for all P1 cars and crews, as well as the following cars and crews: No. 20, 21, 28 and 40. All participating crews are required to wear driving overalls.

Selected cars and their crews shall report at the pre-parade holding area at 17.45. The running order of the cars in the parade and any further instructions will be given in a Clerk of the Course Communication. Rally Parade starts from the service park proceeding through Jyväskylä city centre and returns to the service park, where all cars will be driven to their service bays.

b) Autograph Session

Following the Rally Parade, all crews nominated in the Start List for the Opening Ceremonies, must be available for autographs at their service bays 18.30–18.55 (or immediately after having arrived to the service bay from the Rally Parade).

All competitors should bring their own promotional materials to be signed and given to the spectators.

c) Ceremonies on Service Park Stage

All P1 crews and other invited crews must take part in the opening ceremonies on the Service Park Stage according to the Start List published on Wednesday, 29 July 2026 at 15.00. Driving overalls must be worn (unless their time for pre-rally scrutineering collides with the ceremonies), no cars are involved in the ceremonies. P1 crews will be presented one manufacturer at the time, in reverse championship order.

12.3 Shakedown (FIA WRC, Art. 36)

Shakedown will take place on Thursday, 30 July as follows:

09.01–10.00	P1 and invited P2 drivers
