INTRODUCTION

1.1 „ Rally Visaginas 2023 ” IS ORGANISED FOLLOWING:

FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices;
Lithuanian Automobile Sporting Code and its appendices;
2023 Regulations for organizing and running Lithuanian automobile sports events;
2023 Lithuanian rally sporting regulations (further – T-2023);
2023 Lithuanian Automobile Rally Championship (further – LARC) Regulations and appendixes;
These Supplementary Regulations.

Changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced to all crews only by numbered and dated Bulletins issued by Organiser or Stewards. The Supplementary Regulations are published in Lithuanian and English. In case of disagreement about interpretation of these regulations only Lithuanian text will be binding.

IV. ENTRIES

4.1 CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Closing date for entries: 2023-04-24 (Monday) 18:00.

Closing date for entries with increased fee: 2023-04-27 (Thursday) 18:00.

4.2 ENTRY PROCEDURE

Competitors must complete electronic entry form on www.autorally.lt. Entry form must reach the Organiser until terms specified in Art. 4.1. of these Regulations. Entry form is considered accepted only when it is fully completed and when the entry fee is paid in full. Fully filled and signed entry form must be provided to the Organiser during Administrative Checks. Co-driver details may be specified during Administrative Checking.

IMPORTANT: In order to avoid crowding at Administrative checking and to speed up the checking procedure entrants must send scanned or photographed documents, needed at Administrative checking – licenses, drivers licenses, medical certificates (not required for PZM license holders) – via e-mail: info@rallyvisaginas.lt.

4.3 NUMBER OF COMPETITORS ACCEPTED AND CLASSES

4.3.1. Maximum number. Total maximum number of entries - 50.

4.3.2. Cars eligible to enter the event:

In „Rally Visaginas 2023“ are allowed to participate: „WRC“, „N“, „A“, „R“, “Super 2000”, national „L“ (LT), „L“ (LV), „E“ (EE), 4WD „proto“/ PROTO-R, PROTO LT,PROTO-L, N5, „BMW“, „SG“, „Historic“ group cars.

4.3.3. The cars of all participants must have:

Sports car technical passport issued by LASF or another ASN.

4.3.4. FIA homologated equipment is mandatory for all participants:

(clothes, shoes, helmets). The equipment is allowed to be used for 5 (five) years after the expiration of the homologation. The FHR (Frontal Head Restraint) system is mandatory for all participants.

4.3.5. Starting numbers of cars:

The names of the drivers, the advertisement of the competition organizer must comply with the appendix no. 2 (Scheme of start numbers and advertising layout) and must be affixed to the cars as specified in the above scheme.

It is possible to pay entry fee during the Administrative Check with separate Organisers’ permit only.

4.6 REFUNDS

Entry fee will be refunded:

- In case rally does not take place due to fault of the Organiser - 100%;
- To candidates whose entry has not been accept– 100%;
- In case of the rally does not take place due to force majeure – 50 %;
- If the crew is unable to take part for serious reasons recognized by the Organizer – 50%.

V.INSURANCE

5.1 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE ORGANISER

5.1.1. Organiser’s Liability Insurance

The Organizer concluded an insurance contract, which covers the Organizer's civil liability to third parties during the competition up to EUR 58,000. The insurance contract is valid from 10:00 a.m. to 29/04/2023 until 23:00 p.m. on 29/04/2023.

5.1.2. Damage Caused to the Third Party

A part of insurance contract is coverage for damages caused to the third party. However, damages caused by drivers among themselves are not covered by contract.

5.1.3. International Green Card

All crews at Administrative Check have to hand in a valid motor third party liability insurance policy or International Green card for their car. Without these cards, the crew will not be permitted to start.

5.2 INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR COMPETITORS AND CREWS

All drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. By the fact of signing entry form, competitors and/or drivers relinquish any claims to compensation of any kind which might result due to incidents. The relinquishment is applied to FIA, ASN and Organiser, officials and other competitors and/or drivers.

Drivers and co-drivers from non-EU countries have to have valid travel insurance contracts with active recreational risks included.

5.3 DAMAGE REPORTING

Crews are obliged to notify Organiser about any damage caused on track by their car by the end of event the latest. Failure to do so may inflict 100 EUR penalty.

5.4 INSURANCE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

Auxiliary vehicles, reconnaissance cars and vehicles with special stickers issued by the organiser are not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured Organiser’s cars)

and those are always going on their own responsibility.

5.5 DAMAGE COVERAGE EXCLUSIONS

The Organiser refuses any liability for damage that has been caused by a participant due to unfair action – either regarding rally regulations or these Supplementary Regulations or the State Law. In case of a road traffic accident neither a service car, reconnaissance car nor official's car with rally markings are considered as crew of the competition. In these cases only a car owner third-person liability insurance policies are valid.

VI. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Prior to the pre-start scrutineering starting numbers, rally plates and Organiser's advertising should be affixed on the rally car according to Appendix 4.

6.2 LOSS OR REMOVAL OF COMPETITION NUMERS AND ADVERTISING

Failure to comply with any rules relating to start numbers and advertising will be penalized as follows:

- One unattached rally emblem or starting number: monetary fine of 100 EUR;
- Missing all numbers or rally emblems at the same time: inform the stewards;
- Rally emblems are not visible or partially cover the number plate: monetary fine of 100 EUR.

VII. TYRES

7.1 NUMBER OF TYRES AND ELIGIBLE TYRES

7.1.1. Eligible tyres.

Only gravel sports tires may be used during the rally. For LARC competitors tyres must comply with Appendix 13 of LARC Regulations.

VIII. FUEL

8.1 REFUELING

8.2.1. All participants are allowed to refuel only in refueling zones (KU). The fuel filling area marked in the road book will be installed when leaving the service area LK Visaginas.

8.2.2. Refueling when leaving the service park. Crew cars can be filled with fuel from barrels, canisters and two team members with team permits can enter the KU and help with the procedure.

8.2.3. Filling procedure. Crew cars can be filled with fuel from drums/canisters sold at commercial gas stations. Only two team members with permits can enter KU and perform the procedure. Crew members and their support staff are responsible for following fire safety regulations during refueling. A liquid-proof mat must be used. Failure to comply with the rules is punishable by a fine of EUR 50.

IX. RECONNAISSANCE

9.1 PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION

Reconnaissance registration will take place at the same time with administrative checks as follows:

2023-04-29 (Saturday) 07:00 – 09:30

Reconnaissance cars will be checked during reconnaissance. Reconnaissance cars must comply with Art.35.1 of T-2023.

9.5.1. Number of people in the car

During reconnaissance maximum 2 persons are permitted in the car. 3rd person may be in the car during reconnaissance only with the permit from the Clerk of the Course and has to have a valid annual license issued by LASF or other ASN.

9.5.2. Number of passages

Maximum 2 passages over each Special stage is permitted during reconnaissance. Special stages, which run twice, are considered as one Special stage.

9.5.3. Speeding

Exceeding speed during reconnaissance will be penalized in accordance with T-2023 Art. 34.2.2.

Exceeding speed during the race will be penalized in accordance with T-2023 Art. 34.3.

If sports and/or service cars exceed the speed limit in the Service zone, a fine of Eur 25 will be imposed for each exceeded kilometer per hour (T-2023 Art.57.4).

X. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

During Administrative Checks the following documents will be checked and entry form details verified:

- Competitors licence;
- Driver and Co-driver competition licences;
- Driver and Co-driver valid driving licences;
- ASN authorisation, when it's applicable;
- Fully completed entry form;

Note: For crews who submit the required documents in electronic form, the documents will not be checked, but the crew must submit the original signed and fully completed entry form.

10.2 LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

Administrative checks will take place at the same time with Reconnaissance registration as follows:

2023-04-29 (Saturday) 7:00–9:30

The exact schedule will be published on www.autorally.lt. Delays to administrative checking will be penalized with a fine of 30 EUR for every 10 minutes delay. At least one crew member must attend an administrative check.

XI. ŽYMĖJIMAS SCRUTINEERING, MARKING AND SEALING

11.1 LOCATION AND SCHEDULE

Attendance at the technical inspection will be scheduled during the administrative inspection. The

following documents must be submitted during the technical inspection:

- Valid vehicle insurance policy (“Green card”);
- Vehicle registration documents;
- Vehicle FIA technical passport, when it’s applicable;
- Vehicle ASN technical passport, when it’s applicable;

XII. OTHER PROCEDURES

12.1 RALLY OPENING PROCEDURE AND ORDER

All cars must be parked in the pre-start area between 11:30 and 12:00. The sports part of the rally starts from TC0. The crews starts from the service area and drives through the Start arch (TC0). Starting interval - 1 min.

12.2 FINISH PROCEDURE

The finish of the rally will be LK10A.

12.3 PERMITTED EARLY CHECK-IN

Early check-out without time penalties is possible in LK10A.

12.4 START PROCEDURE FOR SPECIAL STAGES

Start procedure for special Stages will be as follows:

- On the start position crew stops when instructed by marshals;
- When the start marshal confirms that the car is on the right start position – 50 cm before electronically controlled start line the car must stay immovable till start moment and the crew must visually follow the time and lights on the monitor.
- 30 seconds before start marshal hands the Time Card to the Co-driver;
- The last five seconds are marked by 5 red lights and a green light. The first red light lights up on 55th second, second – on 56th second and so on. On the time of exact minute red light go out and green light lights up.
- If the car crosses the beam before the green light lights up “FALSE” will be shown automatically on the monitor. False-start will be penalized according T-2022 Art.48.6.
- The start marshal makes the final decision about false-start and notes this in the start report.
- In case of start system malfunction the start will be given by marshals according to T-2022 Art.48.3.

Upon retiring, the crews must hand in its time card either at the nearest control post or to the sweeping car.

12.6 OFFICIAL TIME USED DURING THE RALLY

During the rally official time is considered the Eastern European summer time (CET +2, UTC+3)

12.7 REGROUPING

There will be two regroupings according to results on SS 1-4 (new start time at TC4B) and according to results on SS 1-8 (new start time at TC8B).

12.8.1. Under the sports car, at the service point, in the service area, there must be a real waterproof floor (min. 3 x 5 m) and fire extinguishers must be provided. Drilling or otherwise damaging the surface of the service park is prohibited. Teams must provide weights to attach the tents. Each applicant is responsible for the damage caused to their assigned service location. After the rally service, the park must be left tidy. Crews are responsible for removing debris and liquids.

12.8.2. Participants who do not comply with the rules of the service park may be fined from EUR 50 to expulsion from the competition.

12.9 CHICANES

Chicanes will be set on Special stages for safety reasons, in order to reduce maximum speed. Where it is possible chicanes will be set before reconnaissance and will stay unhindered during whole rally. In places, where such action is impossible, the place of the chicane will be marked on the road surface. Judges of the fact will observe the correct passage through the chicane. Incorrect passage through the chicane or pushing retarder's out of the perimeter will result 20 seconds penalty.
