The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Facts** The above addressed Competitor requested the allocation of a new time on SS11 (Lota 2) where the crew was delayed by the crew of Car No. 20 (OLIVER SOLBERG / ELLIOTT EDMONDSSON), which had stopped at about 9km to change a tyre and then restarted proceeding immediately in front of Car No. 21 until the end of the stage. The stage was also affected by changeable adverse weather conditions.

**Decision** The time of Competitor No. 21 YOHAN ROSSEL / FLORIAN BARRAL on SS11 (Lota 2) is corrected to **17.02.5**.

**Reason** Having examined the report from the Clerk of the Course, the information provided by the Competitor, the tracking data available, the available split times set by Car No.21 YOHAN ROSSEL / FLORIAN BARRAL and Car 20, OLIVER SOLBERG / ELLIOTT EDMONDSON, on SS11 (Lota 2), and the in-car video from Car No. 21 for the stage, the Stewards conclude that the request for a correction of the time is justified.

The allocation of corrected or notional times is provided for in the WRC Sporting Regulations for certain cases which do, however, not specifically include a crew being delayed due to the above-mentioned circumstances.

With a view to sporting fairness in competitions and with reference to Art. 1.1.5 of the 2024 WRC Sporting Regulations, the Stewards exercise their authority under Art. 11.9.2.a and Art. 11.9.3.j of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code. Considering that the time loss was significant and cannot merely be considered as a "racing incident", the Stewards decide to correct the time of Competitor No. 21, YOHAN ROSSEL / FLORIAN BARRAL, on SS11 (Lota 2) as specified above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
