The Stewards, having received a report from FIA Race Director, regarding an incident in the Final in the 2024 FIA World Rallycross Championship, having reviewed video evidence and hearing the drivers and team managers #21 Timmy HANSEN, #68 Niclas GRÖNHOLM, determine the following:

**Driver and car No:** #21 Timmy HANSEN, #68 Niclas GRÖNHOLM

**Competitor:** HANSEN WORLD RX TEAM, CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT DEALER TEAM

**Time (fact):** 16:45

**Fact:** Incident involving cars #68 and #21 in the Final

**Offence:** alleged breach of Appendix L, Chapter V 2.b and FIA International Sporting Code 12.2.1 (j).

**Decision:** **No further action**

**Reason:** After an extensive review of the MVRCA evidence and hearing the drivers and team managers #21 Timmy HANSEN, #68 Niclas GRÖNHOLM, the Stewards determined that none of the cars involved in the incident were in breach of the regulations. This incident was a direct consequence of prior actions. Upon thorough analysis, the Stewards concluded that no driver was wholly or predominantly at fault for the incident. Therefore, no further action will be taken.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
