

Supplementary Regulations



6-7 February 2026

The competition is part of the Swedish Rally Championship (SM) and the Swedish Junior Rally Championship (JSM).

The competition is organized in accordance with the Swedish Automobile Sports Federation's (Svenska Bilsportförbundet's) competition regulations, the SM regulations, as well as this invitation and supplementary bulletins.

Anyone participating in the competition does so on their own responsibility and at their own risk. The Swedish Automobile Sports Federation (SBF), Special Sports District Federation (SDF), organizer, or official can therefore not be held liable, without fault, for personal injury or property damage suffered by the participant during the competition.

By registering to participate in the competition, the competitor has consented to the registration of their personal data in the competition organizer's data register and to the organizer publishing the name details, within the framework of their operations and regardless of media format.

Insurance Information for Foreign Registered Cars Used in Sweden

A participant in a competition/exhibition on a road in Sweden with a foreign-registered vehicle must have third-party insurance with a value of SEK 300 million. If such insurance is missing, or if it is insufficient compared to Swedish law, the group insurance held by the Swedish Automobile Sports Federation will apply. The deductible for the person deemed liable for the accident for this insurance is 20% of the current year's price base amount (prisbasbelopp). The value of the insurance is SEK 300 million.

National Rally with a total length of 332 km, of which 102 km are Special Stages (SS), divided into 6 SS. The competition is run in one stage.

All Special Stages are run once. The competition is run in three sections. Shakedown will be run on Friday, February 6th. Recce (Reconnaissance) according to the Championship regulations SM Rally (Swedish Championship Rally). Organizer's notes are produced by Patrik Barth, Noteriet AB.

The following is included in the entry fee: One set of program, roadbook and map, Rally Safety Tracking, competition number and plates for the rally, organizer's advertising, service package, and service plate.

12.1 Refund

The entry fee will be refunded in the following cases:

- 1/ If the competition is not held due to *force majeure*, 50% of the paid entry fee will be refunded.
- 2/ For competitors whose application is not accepted, 100% of the paid entry fee will be refunded.
- 3/ Regarding Withdrawal

If the withdrawal of registration is made in writing (email) before 2026-01-25 at 18:00, 100% of the paid entry fee will be refunded.

The organizer reserves the right to charge an administrative fee of 1,000 SEK for cancellations made between 2026-01-25 at 18:00 and 2026-01-30 at 18:00. Thereafter, no refund of the entry fee will be given. Fees for reconnaissance fees and organizer notes are non-refundable regardless of the time of cancellation.

14. Cancellation, reasons for calling off the competition or Force Majeure

The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to cancel the competition in consultation with the SBF (Swedish Automobile Sports Federation), (see Championship Regulations SM Rally) and the stewards in case of prohibition from authorities, landowners, unsuitable weather conditions or other instances of force majeure, and if fewer than 60 competitors in SM/JSM/ have entered by the closing date for entries.

15. Special Regulations

15.1 Tyres

Tyres according to Championship Regulations SM Rally. Maximum number of allowed tyres: 8 pcs. All tyres must be registered at the same time. Tyre lists must be submitted before the start, no later than 1 hour before one's own start time. According to Rally SM rules 2026, point 2.2.1

Road section tyres (Transportdäck) may be used from TC 0 to Jädraås (35 km). Svensson tyres" (standard road tyres) must be used during Pre-Scrutineering.

15.2 SafetyTracking

Rally Safety Tracking (RST) will be used during reconnaissance and the competition. The RST unit is powered via a USB connector. In the competition car, the RST unit must be mounted so that both the driver and co-driver can see information and reach the unit.

15.3 Environment

Environmental regulations according to SBF's national regulations RY3.1 and G6.0. Open fires are prohibited in the service areas. The service area does not have a designated refuelling zone. All refuelling must take place within the respective service spot.

15.4 Start Method

Counting down clock, photocell for indicating a jump start on the start line.

15.5 Extra Service

One extra service for refuelling and tyre change before SS 1.

15.6 Reconnaissance

Start numbers must be affixed in the upper right corner of the windscreen on the reconnaissance car; they are provided in the envelope received at administrative check-in. The Rally SafetyTracking System/speed control unit will be used during reconnaissance and must be powered and active throughout the reconnaissance and all the way to the final finish. Tracking equipment will be handed out at administrative check-in upon entry and must be returned at the final finish. Reconnaissance must be carried out with a standard car equipped with standard road tyres.

Reconnaissance maximum 2 times/SS. Only the driver and co-driver may be in the car. Reconnaissance may be carried out with substituted crew personnel, provided they have the required license. The organiser must be notified before the change takes place. Competitors may never drive against the direction of the competition on the SS during reconnaissance. The maximum speed on the SS during reconnaissance is 70 km/h, with the exception of some shorter sections with reduced speed. Speed will be monitored via the Tracking system.

Crews who violate the reconnaissance rules will be penalized according to Championship Regulations SM Rally 7.10.3. The first warning will follow the crew throughout the SM season, and a time penalty will be issued on the second occasion that the reconnaissance rules are violated.

Penalty scale:

1. Warning (Issued warning will follow the crew during the season until a possible time penalty is issued).
2. 30 sec time penalty.
3. 180 sec time penalty
4. Exclusion from the competition

15.7 Mechanic Registration, and Power of Attorney for Protest

15.8 Parc Fermé

No Parc Fermé after the finish; the procedure in case of protest follows the Championship Regulations SM Rally.

16. Utilization of space for federation/organiser advertising and the possibility of buying out

The organiser reserves the right, according to SBF's regulations including Championship Regulations SM Rally, to affix advertising and start numbers to the competitors' vehicles. Buying out the mandatory championship advertising on the front and rear windows, as well as the start number on the doors, is not possible. Buying out other advertising can be done against an increased entry fee according to point 12 Fees.

17. Prizes, Points Calculation, Tie-breaking, Prize-giving Ceremony

Prizes and points calculation according to Championship Regulations SM Rally. Prize-giving for winners in each class will take place in connection with the finish, based on the latest published, preliminary results list.

22. Gasoline and oil

Refueling takes place at the service areas. During refueling, all teams must have at least one 6kg fire extinguisher and a tarpaulin available. Environmental regulations according to SBF's national regulations RY3.1 and G6.0.

23. Scheduled break

After SS 2. Service 20 min. After SS 4. Service 30 min.

24. Allowed lateness and maximum times.

Allowed lateness (Respittid) is a maximum of 15 min between two consecutive time controls and a maximum of 30 min during the entire competition.

25. Location for posting of permits, bulletins, and other announcements.
