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Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations of the Rally

7. TYRES

7.2 Tyre quantities for use during the rally (replace with)

The maximum total number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 40 for Rally1 cars, 30 for Rally2 cars and 26 for all other cars.

Rally1 cars:

- First choice: Maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 28.
- Alternative choice: Maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 20.

Other 4WD cars:

- First choice: Maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 26.
- Alternative choice: Maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 16.

2WD cars:

- Maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 26.

7.5 Additional tyre exchange opportunities (new article)

The FIA Road Sport Department has granted a waiver for the following procedure:

Teams are allowed to provide a maximum of

- two tyres (fitted on rims) to the crews and receive equal number of used tyres on the road section in Alà dei Sardi at a dedicated area before Refuel Zones 2, 5, 7 and 10.
- four tyres (fitted on rims) to the crews and receive equal number of used tyres on the road section in La Corte at a dedicated area after Refuel Zone 13.

Exact locations will be published in a COC Communication or in a subsequent Bulletin.

The following conditions apply:

- The number of personnel permitted is limited to four per Rally1 Manufacturer and two for all other competitors.
- Team vehicles may enter the area no earlier than 15 minutes before the expected arrival time of the rally car they are supporting. Access with Service or Auxiliary stickers only.
- Team members may only supply tyres to the crew. Providing any assistance, tools, or spare parts is strictly prohibited.
- The crews are not permitted to do any other service in this area. Only work directly related to removing/exchanging used tyres and loading or installing new tyres is allowed. They must vacate the area immediately upon completion of the tyre exchange.
- Scrutineers will be in attendance to monitor compliance with these procedures and to scan all exchanged tyres.
- Team vehicles must vacate the area immediately upon completion of the tyre exchange.
