GENERAL RULES

Britannia Cup 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating as well as relevant ISU Communications for Season 2024/2025.

All teams and competitors must belong to an ISU Member and qualify regarding eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rules and they must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in the ISU Rules & Communications in effect.

This event will be conducted in accordance with the current 2024/2025 ISU and BIS Generic Criteria, BIS Policies, and where relevant the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024.

By entering this Competition, you confirm you are an eligible skater, and you agree to abide by the Competition Regulations, BIS Policies and this announcement.

Entries will open 30th October 2024 at noon.

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PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

The preliminary entry form must be submitted no later than **22nd of November 2024** at noon. If the OC has to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those teams that have submitted the preliminary entries.

Entries will be allocated a place in the competition on a 'first come, first served' basis upon the receipt of your completed form and payment.

Music files are requested to be uploaded no later than 13th of December 2024.

Additionally, each team will need to bring their competition music on a clearly labelled USB drive as a backup. One USB drive for each program.

All music must be clearly identified with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time).

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be entered by the ISU Member or by the teams on the dedicated ISU Portal.

The Planned Program Content must be entered by the ISU Member or the teams on the dedicated ISU Portal. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. The Planned Program Content must be entered with the final entry date.

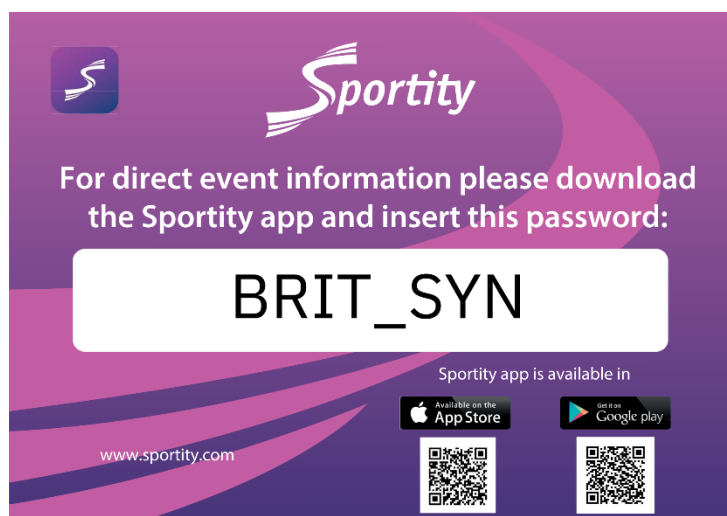

Synchronized Skating Events Synchronized Skating Competitions can be held by affiliated clubs, rinks and BIS for skaters who are members. British Ice Skating is responsible for hosting the British Championships and the BIS cup of which the categories are outlined below. There are no qualification on requirements for the 24/25 season. Skills levels will be reviewed to increase annually over the next 4 years in some categories.

*80/20 Rule will apply to these categories. This number includes **ALL** the skaters listed on the entry form:

Crossover Rule

A maximum of 50% of the skaters **ACTUALLY PERFORMING** the program are permitted to crossover into another team. This includes all categories, whether it is an ISU or a non-ISU category. For example, if a team has 15 skaters with 13 performing the program, then a maximum of 6 are permitted to crossover into another team. If a team has 20 skaters with 16 performing the program, then a maximum of 8 are permitted to crossover into another team.

Skills Test Requirements

For the 2024-2025 season, the minimum skills test requirements must be met by the entire team. The recommended level of skills test will become the required level for the 2026-2027 season with the minimum level increasing each season until then. The TAC committee will be continuing to review these levels each season.

Illegal Elements/Features/Additional Features and Movements

All categories (SP and/or FS)

- Illegal lifts as defined in **Rule TBC**
- Back spirals through the Axis of Intersection
- Unassisted/solo back flips
- Split jump through the Axis of intersection.

Junior, Senior and Senior Elite Short Program

- Lifts of any variety unless required.

Advanced Novice, Basic Novice, Mixed Age, Beginner, Juvenile, Pre-juvenile, Pre-Mixed Age, Adult Free Program

- Lifts of any variety
- Vaults.

All Categories – UK Rule

- No Somersaults movements where the head comes in contact with the ground
- No Cartwheels

Advanced Adult & Adult Categories

The Adult Category age requirement is based on 50% of the skaters ACTUALLY performing the program. For example a team of 11 skaters, with 10 performing, then 5 of these skaters must be over 25.
