## **Amendment to the Supplementary Regulations of the Rally**

## 8 FUEL

## 8.5 Non-Priority drivers (amend)

For non-priority drivers not using fuel from the FIA-appointed supplier, the organiser will establish Refuel Points (RPs) near the designated Refuelling Zones. These Refuel Points will comply with all safety requirements applicable to Refuelling Zones, as outlined in Articles 61 and 62 of the FIA WRC Sporting Regulations and in Article 8.4 of these Supplementary Regulations.

## Non-priority drivers may use either:

- FIA fuel following the same conditions and rules as the priority drivers,
- Commercially available pump fuel, dispensed as mentioned below
- and due to unforeseen circumstances of force majeure, any fuel complying with Appendix J / Article 252-9.1, dispensed as mentioned below

Teams' service personnel are permitted to use their own fuel drums and pumps at these Refuel Points. However, <u>in all cases and</u> due to customs regulations, it is strictly prohibited to cross the borders into Austria, the Czech Republic, or Germany with full fuel drums. The organiser will provide a list of nearby fuel stations where teams may refill their drums with locally sourced fuel.

All personnel involved in refuelling operations at the RP must wear fire-resistant clothing that offers adequate protection. This includes, at a minimum: long trousers, a long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves, and a balaclava.

Service personnel are also responsible for protecting the ground by using an Environmental Mat. This mat must consist of an absorbent upper layer and an impermeable lower layer. No fuelling permitted without such a ground mat.
