Supplementary Regulations - Art. 10.4.2 Navigation System (NAV-GPS – Art. 12.2 FIA 2024 CCRSR) (update)

Competitors are obliged to be equipped with one or two Navigation System(s) (NAV-GPS) downloaded with the waypoints given by the Organiser. When a crew uses two NAV-GPS, it must indicate in writing, at scrutineering, which of the two will be considered as the official one.

With reference to Art. 12.2.1 of FIA CCRSR, when a crew uses two NAV-GPS, the primary device will be identified with "race number P" (i.e.: 900P) by ERTF.

8. Supplementary Regulations - Art. 11.1 Drivers' Briefing(s) (update)

See programme (SR Art. 3).

At the first briefing of the event, the participation of at least one crew member is compulsory. Any crew not attending the pre-event briefing will incur a penalty of 100,00 €.

Then, a briefing will be held each evening at the Bivouac.

Then, a daily briefing will be posted on Sportity at 17H00.

During these briefings, the W2RC "winner of the day" will be awarded. See Art. 3 Programme for the schedule for W2RC "winner of the day" award ceremonies.

The presence of the best classified crew of each category on the day's Stage among those eligible to score points for the FIA World Rally-Raid Championship is compulsory.







 Supplementary Regulations – Art. 11.3 Ceremonial Start procedures and order (to be added)

TBA Ceremonial Start will take place in Grândola, according to the schedule. See Art. 3 – Programme and Appendix 10.

To the Crew Members not attending Ceremonial Start at their due time a fine of 100 euros will be applied.

10. Supplementary Regulations – Art. 11.5 Prologue (to be added)

See Art. 3 (Programme)

The Start Interval between competitors of the same group is 1 minute, with an interval of 3 minutes between groups.

11. Supplementary Regulations Art. 11.9 Road books delivery (update)

Please see programme (SR Art. 3)

Competitors on the BP Ultimate Rally-Raid Portugal 24 will use Electronic Road Book UNIK 4 of ERTF. However, they will receive at the start of each leg a paper road book inside a sealed plastic pouch, which can only be opened in case of function failure of the electronic road book device. Some random checks will be done. In case of any non-justified opening of the sealed bag, a 30-minute penalty will be imposed. (...)

12. Supplementary Regulations - Art. 11.10 Servicing of vehicles (replace)

Art. 11.10.1 Service Areas / Bivouacs

From TCP0 onwards, service of a competing car may be carried out in Service Areas (Service Parks and Bivouacs) and road sections as permitted under the Art. 49 & 50 of FIA 2024 CCRSR.

The timed service A in Badajoz is organised as per CCRSR Art 49.2.4, but will apply to all competitors and not only Platinum / Gold drivers.

For each competing vehicle, access to the "Service A" area will be restricted to:

- one team personnel, duly identified with a wristband;
- three mechanics, duly identified with the "SERVICE" armbands provided by the organiser;
- one "SERVICE" vehicle.













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Only the crew and the personnel identified with armbands may work on the competing vehicle.

After the Service, the cars will be placed in Parc Fermé. Competing vehicles can be driven to this.

PF by a team personnel respecting all the formalities of timecard presentation and related penalties.

13. Supplementary Regulations - Art. 11.10.3 Fuel and Refuelling Zone (update)

See art 54 and 55 of the FIA 2024 CCRSR and Art. 252.9 Appendix J

The team is responsible for the refuelling. A Refuelling Zone (RZ) will be installed adjacent to the Bivouac, Grândola, and be installed adjacent to the Service Parc in Badajoz (See Appendix 7 and 8) which can be used by the teams, using their own fuel, and complying with the safety rules required by the articles above mentioned. The Road Book, Maps and Itinerary indicate the public filling stations where it is allowed to fill.








APPENDIX 5 - INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF THE TRACKING SYSTEM






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
INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE USE OF CAR-TO-CAR COMMUNICATION SYSTEM

MEMO GPS UNIK4 RALLYE RAID - VERSION 2024

CAR/TRUCK

Parameters

Default settings are adapted to Rally-Raid navigation. Do not touch it unless you are sure what you are changing.



Sentinel function

Overtaking

You want to overtake: press for a long time (more than 2s) on the yellow button or on the STN button of the remote control to send a signal to the yehicle ahead.

The distance to send the overtaking request is as below:

- 250 if speed difference is less than 20km/h
- 400m if speed difference is more than 20km/h
- Beyond 400m, no requests for overtaking will be considered.



Somebody wants to overtake you: you hear Beep beep beeep – Beep beeep Get ready to let the vehicle pass a.s.a.p.

To inform the vehicle which wants to overtake that you have heard is signal and that you are going to let him pass a.s.a.p. Press briefly the yellow button or the STN button of the remote control

(less than 2s - which cuts the sound in the cockpit)

If you don't acknowledge receipt of the signal, an acknowledgement of receipt is automatically sent at the end of 6s.

Accident

If you breakdown or if you have a crash in a dangerous place (after a turn or a dune): press the red Alarm button, you will send a signal to the competitors maximum 250m around regarding the ground.

To stop it, press again the red Alarm button



There is an accident near by: you hear Beeeep – beeeep – beeeep

Note:

The Overtaking function is inactive when the vehicle is stopped or at the bivouac.

The Alarm function is automatically deactivated as soon as the vehicle runs above 20km/h.
