Extra practice ice

The extra practice schedule has been sent to the teams. The music can be played with a music reproduction device directly at the ice by the team (**device / mobile needs a 3.5mm jack socket**). There will be dressing rooms in a separate part of the building (**please stay informed with graphic *Extra Practice Ice***).

Draw

The starting order will be determined during the draw ceremony on Thursday, 22 February 2024 at 6 pm and will be available on the website / Sportity by 9 pm at the latest.

All teams will meet at Schlossplatz (in front of the Hofkirche) at 17:15 at the latest and walk to the city hall (Goldene Pforte) accompanied by the Dresden Fanfare Band via Schlosstraße / Neumarkt / Frauenkirche / Altmarkt. (please note the map in the attachment/ graphic *Draw Meeting Point*)

Opening Ceremony

The opening of the competition will take place on Thursday, 22.02.24 as part of the draw. The opening ceremony will take place on Friday, February 23rd at 15:00. Every team may nominate a maximum of 2 skaters to take part in the ceremony. They are required to arrive 20 minutes before the start of the Opening Ceremony at the Ice Entry (**please take a look at the graphic *Opening Ceremony***).

Official practice

Only competitive programs may be played. Teams have the option of playing their music once or twice. The Team Manager or coach must inform the music technician before entering the ice, if they wish to play the music once or twice. If there is no information, music will be played twice.

Short program (Junior and Senior) and Free Skating (Novice, Juvenile, Adult) official practice

10 minutes. Music can be played two times, once it has started it will be played through completely. Music cannot be restarted. Music will start first no later than two minutes after the start of the practice and for the second time, no later than six minutes after the start of the practice.

Free skating official practice for Junior, Senior and Mixed Age

Junior and Mixed Age 11 minutes, Senior 12 minutes. Music can be played two times, once it has started it will be played through completely. Music cannot be restarted. Music will start first no later than 2 minutes after the start of the practice and for the second time, no later than seven minutes after the start of the practice.

Warm-up areas

Six warm-up areas will be provided by the OC. All the warm-up areas are located in the sports hall (Ballspielhalle) 2nd floor. All areas are signposted. The warm-up spaces are marked as such and assigned in the detailed schedule. PLEASE DO NOT USE BIG BOOM BOXES in respect for the other teams! Or at least talk to your fellow coaches about the usage of loud music.

Bus parking for teams (see graphic *Car Parking*)

At the JOYNEXT Arena, only boarding and alighting is permitted.
Teams arriving in small coaches or cars should use car park P1.
Team buses are not allowed to drive into car park P1 please use car park P3 instead.
(please take a parking ticket on site)

How fans get there

The JoynextArena Dresden is located on Magdeburger Straße 10 in 01067 Dresden. You may take trams 4, 6 and 11 to the stop: "*Kongresszentrum / Haus der Presse*". From there, it is a 5 minute walk to the ice rink.

Medical service

Medical service for athletes competing at the DresdenCup 2024 includes rink-side emergency coverage during the event and practice sessions.

Each team manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater for use in case of an emergency or accident. Such information should include but is not limited to the following, and will greatly help local medical and emergency personnel: allergies, existing medical conditions (i.e. asthma), current medications, immunizations, blood type, use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances.
