The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course, having checked the tracking data, and having considered the following matter, determine the following:

Fact: During SS 4 – Pößnitz - Panoramastraße at 17:42:08, a red flag was sent to the GPS Tracking System due to an incident on the special stage. Car No. 6 did not sufficiently reduce speed nor proceed with the required caution.

Offence: Alleged breach of Article 53.5.3 of AMF RSR 2026

Decision: No further action

Reason: The Stewards carefully examined the report submitted by the Clerk of the Course. Additional evidence, including GPS tracking information and video footage, was also considered.

After reviewing the available material, the Stewards determined that the information available does not allow the incident to be verified with sufficient certainty. During the review it was noted that the GPS device assigned to the driver showed an isolated technical malfunction of that unit only. During the hearing, the drivers also reported and demonstrated that this specific unit was not functioning correctly.

As the facts of the incidence cannot be established conclusively based on the available evidence, the Stewards decide that no further action will be taken. This determination applies solely to the circumstances of this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the National Sporting Code within the applicable time limits (document can be found at <https://www.austria-motorsport.at>).
