

Clerk of the Course decision 4

I have received a report from the Deputy Service Area Commander concerning the driver of Car 89 – Nathan Burrell – who at the conclusion of the event left the venue in his personal car in an inconsiderate manor, leaving the venue and failing to stop when directed by a number of officials of the Rally. I have also been supplied a photograph of the tyre tracks he left behind.



I asked the driver of car 89 – Nathan Burrell – was asked via the official Notice Board to contact the Clerk of the Course. He called me at 18:20. He stated he was an hour away from the venue. I explained that I need to hold a hearing to consider the report received from the rally Official. I explained the contents of the report and the driver of Car 89 apologised but claimed he did not drive in anyway inconsiderately and that he did not leave any marks on the ground.

He declined to return for a hearing. In accordance with NCR Chapter 6 Appendix 1 Article 15 I conducted a hearing in the absence of car 89 – Nathan Burrell and having considered the evidence, I consider I am looking at a breach of Chapter 13 Appendix 14 (q) Failure to follow the instructions of an Official. The penalty for this is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Any Offence against the Volunteer Officials an event and members of the public needs to be considered robustly and show the value of our volunteers that make the sport happen.

I have considered the evidence before me, and I will impose the penalty of disqualification from the results and impose a fine of £1000 payable to the ASN.
