






























Tire cleaning with wheel spins before the race is allowed only once BEFORE THE GRID,

particular area marked between the lines (see below). It is strongly prohibited to do wheel spins outside the circuit, paddock, pre-grid (except area see below), and grid going to the start position.

























- It is allowed to unfasten the seat belts and remove the glasses
- speed limit 20 km/h
- · external assistance is not permitted

RED FLAG AREA - the PADDOCK



SERVICE AREA AFTER THE RED FLAG WILL BE THE PADDOCK

THE RESTART WILL BE GIVEN AFTER NEXT ONE OR TWO RACE

- 1. After the Red Flag, the drivers will be invited to leave the circuit (using the normal exit) and enter the paddock, where necessary repairs and refuelling can occur. Except for false start and qualifying practice, drivers will be invited to the grid immediately for the restart.
- 2. The maximum time will be given 10 (7 + 3 extra) minutes, and time counting will start from the moment when the last car (also the last evacuated car) from that particular start will cross the circuit exit line (see Appendix 3, picture 6) and till the time published on the Official Messaging System (doubled on Sportity) must be back in the Pre-Grid.
- 3. The judge of fact nominated in the Supplementary Regulations will control the time when the Drivers cross the Pre-Grid line and will control entering the Pre-Grid (crossing the Pre-Grid line), which must be done using the driver's car engine power without stopping for the tyre check. The driver must remain in the Pre-Grid red line until further marshal instructions are given.
- 4. The number of mechanics in the Pre-Grid is limited to 2 persons (the driver is not counted), and they can do repairs. All entered cars will undergo repeated tyre checks after the tyre changes are prohibited.
- 5. The restart will be denied for those who have not entered the Pre-Grid by the end of the nominated minute (last-minute counts).

(REMINDER):

- 1. The paddock's speed limit is 20 km/h.
- 2. Aggressive driving, speeding, wheel spins and any contact (or incident) with persons in the paddock are strictly prohibited. Any violation will be reported to the Stewards for investigation and penalty application (up to exclusion from the competition).

If the instructions mentioned above are breached, the Race Director will refuse the restart, according to Art 11.3.2 of SportReg.






















RED FLAG AREA – ON-TIME IN PRE-GRID

DRAWING No. 3 -SIGNS USING TOGETHER WITH FLAGS


SIDE 1 - USING TOGETHER WITH RED FLAG




SIDE 2 - USING TOGETHER WITH RED FLAG

 For the 2024 FIA European Cross Car Championship event; Round 3 – Vilkyciai – 8/9th June 2024 in consideration of the additional tyre wear experienced at this event and in modification of Article 10.3.1, the tyres nomination for this event will be as follows;

Class	Model	Size	Compound
Super Buggy	R800 / R900	205/65-15	K71
Buggy 1600	R800	175/70-15	K33
Junior Buggy	R800	175/65-14	K33

In line with Art. 10.3.3 any "newly registered" tyres for Round 3 – Vilkyciai should be R900 tread pattern and any previously registered should be R800.

2) For the following event; Round 3 – Vilkyciai – Art 10.3.3 of the Sporting Regulations will be modified to allow two four additional previously registered tyres to be used to account for high tyre wear rate expected at this event without adding to the total number of tyres used in the series. The change will be expressed as follows;

So to clarify – for Round 3 – Vilkyciai – Super Buggy drivers will be able to get 6 x newly registered R900 and use 8 x previously registered R800 tyres.

Tyre wear will be very carefully monitored at this event and a decision made for the future races.





MARSHAL SIGNALS / REMINDER



RED FLAG

IMMEDIATELY REDUCE SPEED OR STOP AND FOLLOW MARSHAL'S SIGNALS, BE PREPARED TO PROCEED SLOWLY BACK TO START THE GRID

- Warm-up and free practice no re-run
- Qualifying practice re-run over the total number of laps minus the number of laps completed by the first car
- Qualifying Heats always re-run all laps
- Semi-Final no re-run when the leading car completed four (4) laps
- Final, when no re-run when the leading car completed five (5) laps



MARSHAL SIGNALS / REMINDER



ONE YELLOW

FLAG:

Reduce your speed, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction

- There is a hazard beside or partly on the track
- Overtaking is not permitted between the yellow flag and the incident ...





DOUBLE YELLOW / REMINDER



REDUCE YOUR SPEED SIGNIFICANTLY, DO NOT OVERTAKE, AND BE PREPARED TO CHANGE DIRECTION OR STOP

- There is a hazard wholly or partly blocking the track and/or "racing line"
- Overtaking is not permitted between the first yellow flag and the incident...

... and has not entirely passed the LAST OBSTACLE



WHITE FLAG / REMINDER







BLUE FLAG / REMINDER





During practice:

A faster car is close behind and is about to overtake.


During the race:

The flag should normally be shown to a car about to be lapped, if the driver does not seem to be making full use of his rear-view mirrors. When shown, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.



3 STOPS / REMINDER







CODE OF DRIVING CONDUCT



THE LAW BOOK:

- 1 UNSAFE RETURN TO THE RACING LINE (Art. 14.2.9 of the SportReg)
- 2 CAUSING A COLLISION HARD SIDE BY SIDE OR BACK
- NOT RESPECTING OTHER'S RACING LINES AND CAUSING A COLLISION OR FORCING OFF RACING LINE AND /OR OFF-TRACK
- 4 OPPOSITE DIRECTION STRICTLY FORBIDDEN
 (Art. 12.1.5 of the SportReg)
- ABNORMAL CHANGE OF DIRECTION, CONTACT RESULTING IN A LASTING ADVANTAGE (Art. 2b of the App L of the ISC)
- 6 SERIOUS MISTAKES OR THE APPEARANCE OF A LACK OF CONTROL OVER THE CAR (Art. 2d of the App L of the ISC)
- 7 UNNECESSARILY SLOWLY OR IN A MANNER DEEMED POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS TO OTHER DRIVERS (Art. 2e of the App L of the ISC)
