The Stewards, having received a report from the Race director, summoned by CLO, studied the video footage and heard the competitor/driver Bart Jan BLAAUW and competitor/driver John VERBERK, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

**Driver and car No:** Bart Jan BLAAUW, No. 30

**Competitor:** Bart Jan BLAAUW

**Time (fact):** 15:54, 21.7.2024

**Session:** SemiFinal 2

**Facts:** Driver #30 did not respect the yellow flag and overtook car #52.

**Offence:** Breach of 2.5.5.b of the Appendix H of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art 12.2. of the FIA Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Autocross & Cross Car Championship

**Decision:** Reprimand

**Reason:** When the yellow flag is waived the driver is obliged to reduce the speed, not overtake and to be prepared to change direction. There is a hazard beside or partly on the track. It must be evident that a driver has reduced speed; this means a driver is expected to have braked earlier and/or noticeably reduced speed in that sector. During the hearing driver #52 stated that he was giving back the previous position to driver #30. This is the reason that driver #30 overtook driver #52. Taking this into consideration, the Stewards decided to give a reprimand to driver #30.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
