WASHING OF VEHICLES

Due to the new situation prevailing in the Service Park, all teams must be aware that washing trucks and auxiliary vehicles is not permitted at any time within the area.

TRANSPORTATION OF RALLY CARS TO ATHENS

Teams are requested to proceed with the preparation of their rally cars immediately after the finish or the shakedown to be uploaded the soonest possible on the transporting trucks.

Rally cars will be uploaded on the trucks outside the north part of the Service Park, in the area where the Podium Ceremony will take place.

To reach the loading area rally cars will exit from "Rally Cars Gate" and follow the side road to the right, take the first exit at the roundabout and from the side road of the Service Park will reach the loading area. All cars using the organiser's transportation, must be loaded on the trucks no later than 13:00 hrs.

Teams will reach the Holding area before the Ceremonial Start following the QR below and park as instructed by the marshals.



TOLL POSTS

Competitors are informed that throughout the competitive part of the EKO Acropolis Rally, from Thursday, June 26th to Sunday, June 29th, they must approach all toll stations along the route at reduced speed, keeping to the outer right side of the station, where the barrier will be opened for them by the designated attendant.

ENTERING THE SERVICE PARK AFTER RETIREMENT

Teams are informed that in the event of retirement, their rally car shall enter the Service Park through the Auxiliary gate "GATE B" (see SP Layout)

DISMANTLING SERVICE AREAS

With reference to Art. 12.7.1 of the Supplementary Regulations of the rally, it is clarified that teams may dismantle their service areas within the boundaries of their allocated service area at any time, however no dismantling operations that involve activities outside their boundary (use or movement of vehicles or intrusion into any areas allocated for spectator access) may take place until the end of the prize giving on Sunday, 29 June.
