Supplementary Regulations

2 Description and Organization

- 2.1 This event will be held under the current American Rally Association (ARA) Rules. The Missouri Ozark Rally (MOR) will consist of one day of competition and is part of the ARA Central Regional Championship Series..
 - 2.1.1 This event will not offer any organizer pace notes. A tulip route book will be provided and competitors will be allowed to perform recce on the day of the event.
 - 2.1.2 Any additional changes or additions to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins. The Organizers and/or the Steward shall decide upon any conditions not foreseen in these regulations.
 - 2.1.3 The route will be approximately 150 miles in length with approximately 62 miles of competitive stages. All competitive stages will be held on roads that consist primarily of gravel, and will vary somewhat in width and tightness. Roads vary from sweeping, well groomed roads to tight and twisty.
- 2.2 The Official Notice Board is accessed with the Sportity App, which is available for both Apple and Android devices, or at <https://webapp.sportity.com/channel/MOR2026> The password for the event is MOR2026. All official documents, Bulletins, start orders, provisional results, inquiries, and responses will use the Sportity App.
- 2.3 The committee is prepared to conduct this event under any circumstances and will give the contestant competition regardless of weather conditions, with the exception of those that may pose significant risk to the safety of competitors or volunteers.

4 Entries

4.1 Entry Procedure:

Entry and payment must be made online at <https://enterrally.com/>. ARA will send an email blast to ARA license holders announcing the opening of entry. For assistance with online event registration, contact ara@ara-rally.com. No entry payments can be accepted at the event. Rally participants must be either ARA licensed (competitors, their crew members, media, officials) or registered as a volunteer.

Entries will be accepted for this rally beginning on June 24, 2026 until July 5, 2026.

Entry Fee of \$450 will include: Tulip route book, one Service Packet, use of a single service site, and entry to the event party.

4.2 A 15 car limit will be employed based on order of paid receipt. If more than 15 entries are received, a waitlist will be utilized with priority based on the receipt date and time of the entry and payment.

4.3 Withdrawal Policy:

Competitors may revise or withdraw their entry by completing an entry update/withdrawal form available in the Registrar Folder on the Sportity App.

Prior to 11:59 PM CDT on Sunday, July 5, 2026, a full refund will be issued.

After July 5, 2026 and before posting of the official start list, a full refund, less \$100, will be issued. No refunds will be made after the posting of the official start list.

4.4 Please remember all participants (competitors, service personnel and volunteers) must sign up for an ARA license at <http://rallylicense.com/>. It is free for volunteers. This applies to minors (under the age of 18 years) as well.

5 Insurance

5.1 Third party liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, effective during the competition, will be provided by a policy secured by USAC and displayed on the Official Notice Board.

5.2 Competitors must have documentation showing bodily injury and property damage liability in amounts equal to or exceeding limits as stated in the current ARA rules for both the rally car and any service vehicles.

- 5.3 Competitors, service crew members, and all event participants including officials, marshals, staff, stewards, and all other volunteers who have obtained an ARA license (if required), signed an ARA waiver, and have been issued and are in possession of an event wristband confirming the signature of the waiver will be covered by a secondary USAC participant accident insurance policy which covers excess medical expenses to their primary medical insurance provider.

6 Advertising and Identification

The event will not use the event sponsor advertising space allowed by the current ARA rules. All ARA series advertising must be properly displayed on all competition cars.

7 Fuel

- 7.1 Fuel with an octane rating of 93 (R+M) is available at the Mobil in Steelville.
- 7.2 Any competitor who does not wish to refuel in the fuel depot in service may choose to purchase fuel at commercial gas stations on the transit sections.

8 Reconnaissance

- 8.1 A reconnaissance session will be held on the day of the event starting at 0800 in accordance with Section 1.2.1 of the RCR. This reconnaissance session will be open to all competitors. The session is open and you are permitted to drive the stages more than once. Note that other competitors may be performing recce in the opposite direction, so all due caution should be exercised. All teams must clear the stage roads by 1300.
- 8.2 Both driver and co-driver need to check-in together in their recce vehicle at recce check-in.
- 8.3 An itinerary for this reconnaissance will be provided at recce registration, along with any additional bulletins governing the session. You don't have to follow the prescribed route but it will expedite your way to each stage. All competitors taking part in the reconnaissance session must attend check-in.
- 8.4 The vehicles used shall have no lettering or advertising which would call undue attention to it and must have quiet exhausts, i.e. nothing that could be mistaken for a rally car by locals.
- 8.5 The speed limit on stages during recce may be monitored by event officials. Speeding penalties will be assessed per ARA RCR 1.2.1.h.
- 8.5.1 As a point of general information, the un-posted speed limit in the state of Missouri is 55 miles per hour for paved roads.
- 8.5.2 35 mph is the speed limit for all unpaved roads during recce.

8.5.3 All speed limits are noted in the route book and take precedence.

- 8.6 All recce roads will be open to the public. Inconsiderate or irresponsible driving will be referred to the steward, who may apply any penalty, including exclusion from the event

9 On-Site Check-in

- 9.1 Competitor and Crew Check-In will be per schedule in section 3. All entry information, including Crew Members, must be complete and final two days prior to the event. Forms for this purpose are available in the Registrar folder on Sportity. Onsite registration will not be available.
- 9.2 Recce Check-In will take place at the Meramec Music Theatre.
- 9.3 All competitors and service personnel must have signed up for a license at <https://rallylicense.com>.
- 9.4 A single email address will be specified by each team to be used for all event communications.
- 9.5 Volunteer check-in will be at the Meramec Music Theatre. All volunteers must sign up in advance. Information will be emailed in advance.

10 Scrutineering

- 10.1 Scrutineering will be held at the bus shed at the Steelville Elementary and Middle School campus. There is direct access from the Service Area. All inspections will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis. Space is available for truck and trailer parking at the rear of the Meramec Music Theatre.
- 10.2 Scrutineering will be held at the following times:
Saturday, July 11, 0730 – 1030

Log Books will not be issued at the event without prior arrangement. If you need a Log Book, contact doug@ara-rally.com before the event.

11 Service Area

- 11.1 There will be one service location for the event: Meramec Music Theatre, 26 MO-8, Steelville, MO 65565. The service area will be a parking area to the east of the building. See map in Appendix 2. Service spots will be on pavement. Food and soft drinks will be available on site.

The schedules for the service area are included in Appendix 1 – Itinerary, and the service area location is shown in Appendix 2 – Maps.

- 11.2 All service crew are required to have an ARA license and register for the event at <https://rallylicense.com>. Each service vehicle and personnel must be registered. Each vehicle must be licensed and have proof of insurance.
- 11.3 Service spots will be approximately 18'x32'. Teams with special service needs or problems should contact the event Chair or Service Coordinator before July 6, 2025.
- 11.4 TRAILERS: Trailers are allowed into the service area and to be parked as directed.
- 11.5 It is recommended that competitors use a plywood or metal support plate underneath their jack stands while using them in service areas.
- 11.6 Service crew must notify the service area coordinator when they leave to retrieve a car.
- 11.7 Please leave the service area cleaner than you found it. Use spill kits and other measures as appropriate.

12 Testing/Shakedown

This event does not provide for any testing or shakedown.

13 Features of the Rally

- 13.1 Parc Exposé: There will not be a formal Parc Exposé. Cars will leave from the Service Area.
- 13.2 Timing and scoring will be performed with time cards and logsheets, using rally clocks, per current ARA rules. RallySafe is not used for this event.
- 13.3 An advance packet will be emailed to each team approximately 7 days before the event.
- 13.4 Official Finish:
 - 13.4.1 The Official Finish for competition will be at the MTC IN at the Meramec Music Theatre in Steelville.
- 13.5 Speed Limits:
 - 13.5.1 As a point of general information, the un-posted speed limit in the state of Missouri is 55 miles per hour for paved roads.
 - 13.5.2 Due to the variety of county ordinances, we have set 35 mph as a maximum transit speed limit in the route book for all unpaved roads, except when they are being used for special stages as part of the rally.
 - 13.5.3 All speed limits are noted in the route book.

14 Prizes/Trophies

- 14.1 The awards banquet will be held at the Steelville Elementary/Middle School multi-purpose room, adjacent to Rally HQ and the Service Area. Dinner and drinks will be provided, with trophies presented to the top entrants. See map in Appendix 2.

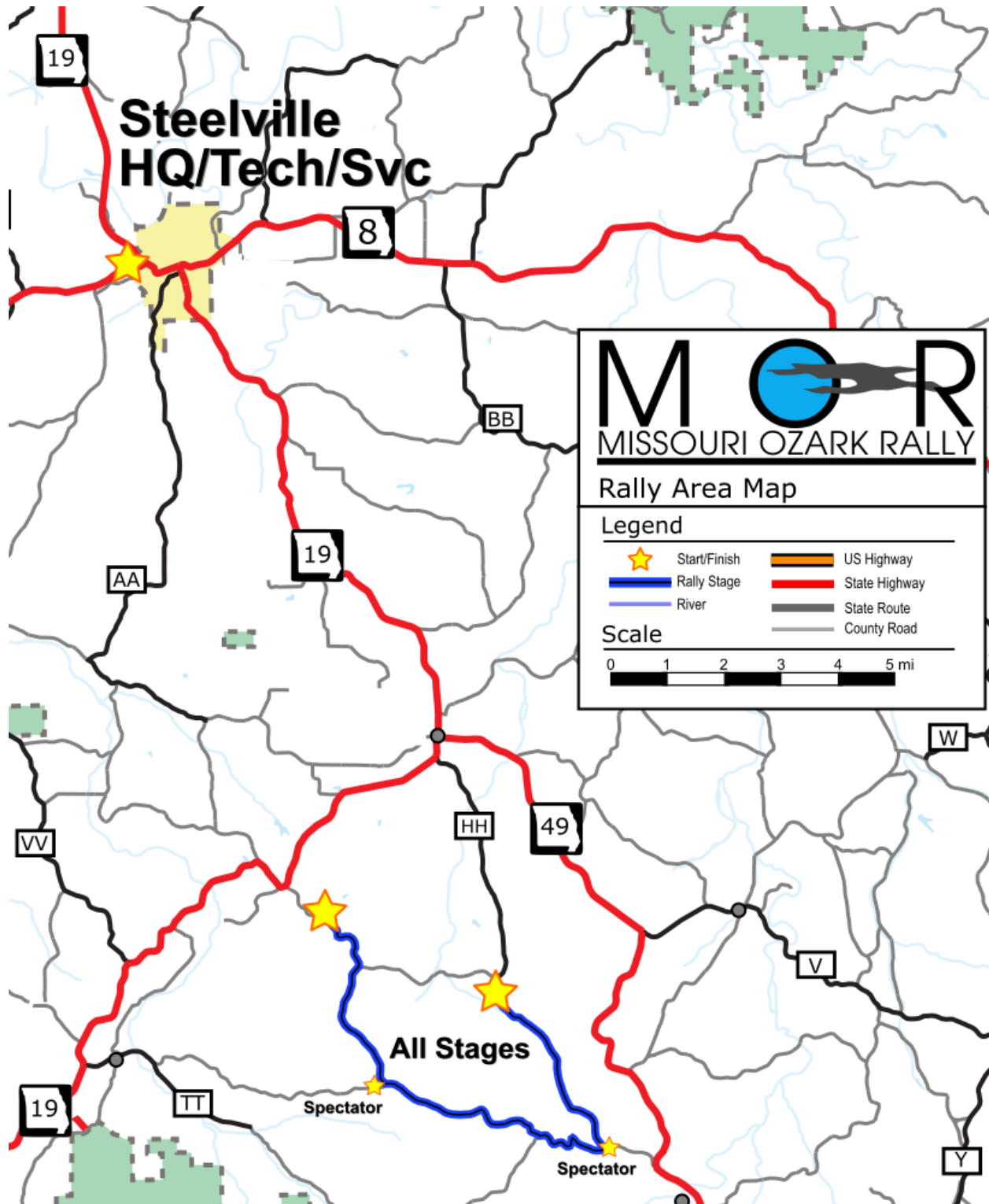
