Miniemen (U9)	°2019-2018

4. **Ranking:**

- Arrival position at the finish line determines the number of points.
First skater => 1 point, second skater => 2 points, ...
- Winner is the skater with the lowest total of points over all the races
- In case of equality of points, first the number of victories is decisive and subsequently the result of the last race.
- If different categories ride together, there will be a separate ranking.
Exception: If there are less than 4 participants in a Miniemen group, then for them the ranking will be boys/girls together.

5. **Rewards:**

Miniemen, pupils en scholieren: reward for each skater in the final rankings.

From cadets: reward for the first five skaters in the final rankings.

6. Rules:

- For skaters in categories **miniemen till scholieren**, the maximum wheel diameter is **90mm**, for **cadetten** the maximum is **100mm** and for the **other categories** the maximum wheel diameter is **110mm**.
- If there are too many participants in a category, the organizer may decide to divide the riders into several groups. The division for the first race is done by lot draw.

The first race counts for the final classification.

From the second race onwards, the riders are classified according to the results of the first race. The number of riders advancing to a higher group, per race, will be determined on the day of the race.

- **100m time trial:** The races take place in 2 lanes.
The start will take place according to this procedure: a call for 'on your marks' followed by a call for 'ready' and finally a beep signal
 - **Keirin**
 - The starting order is determined by a random draw.
 - The start is done with a "pacer".
 - There is one lap during which the "pacer" sets the pace. Overtaking is not allowed.
 - After this lap, the race starts at the finish line on the signal of the race judge.
 - Then, the skaters stay behind the pacer. They may overtake each other, but must always remain behind the pacer.
 - Minimes: 2 laps behind the pacer.
 - Pupils: 4 laps behind the pacer.
 - The final lap is completed without a pacer.
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
