1.1 Titles for Which The Rally Counts Atlantic Rally Cup

1.2 Road Surfaces

Transits are mostly paved roads. Stages roads vary from hard packed dirt/gravel to hard packed dirt with loose gravel on top. Rutting of the roads is not expected although there are a few sections of SS5/SS6 that may deteriorate.

1.3 Water Crossings & Alternate Routes

On SS5/SS6 there is a significant chance of multiple water crossings that have concrete cribbing (low water bridges or LWB) that can damage your car or bike. Slow down.

There is one crossing of a river, where the roadbed crosses on a radius making the entry point hard to see. Do not stop in the river or at the entrance to the river.

If water levels are impassable, there will be an alternative routing of the rally to provide similar stage mileage.

Legacy Entry is a commitment made by the organizers that recognizes the competitors that entered the inaugural McCreary Gravel Rally in 2022. The correct entry amount should show automatically in your account when entering payment. Names are listed on our website in the section explaining the Legacy Entry.

McDouble Discount is only available to eligible competitors (Alexander Larsen, Chris NoNack, Jordon Haberer, and Kevin Schmidt) who entered and started both **MGR-II** and the 2023 ARA Regional Rally of May 6th, 2023. It was intended to be used at Lawrence Super Stages but due to the postponement of LSS it is being offered for **MGR-III**. The eligible competitors will receive the discount will be in the form of electronic reimbursement after the event provided the eligible competitor starts the rally.

2.3 Entry Procedure and Paperwork

The regular entry pricing is available only to competitors who have entered and paid in full by the deadline above. Submitting an entry without payment is not sufficient to obtain regular entry prices.

All entry details and payment are handled within your account at my.nasarallysport.com. Also available within your account is immediate credit card payment of the entry fee. Your entry will only be secured with payment in full.

Check through the entry details within your account and ensure that they are filled out. Please note that items are manually verified by a person and will not immediately change status from red to green as you enter information. Check back in a few days for status. All items must be green before race day except for social media handles.

Your account never goes away, if you have previously raced or volunteered with us please take the time to use your existing account for your entry and find your codriver's and crew chief's correct account to associate with your entry.

Note that all competitors (Driver, Navigator, Rider, etc.) will also need a NASA Membership, NASA Rally License, and an approved NASA Rally Medical. These things are also obtained through your account on the NASA Rally Sport website. New medical forms are due no later than 1700 on April 17, 2024 to allow time for processing and review. Questions regarding many rally topics including the medical form are answered in the rally university at https://www.nasarallysport.com/main/Rally-University.

2.4 Novice Competitor Orientation (NCO)

Competitors who have not completed three NCO will need to attend the MGR-III NCO. Your status may be checked within your entry online if you are unsure, this status will be up to date 2 weeks before the event. Novice Competitors are encouraged to enter early to ensure attendance.

The NCO will be held online via a zoom call on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 7:30 to 9:45 PM EST. It is your responsibility to ensure that you attend the NCO before the event. No competitors who are deemed to attend by NRS are allowed to race without attending NCO.

2.5 Event Cancellation

The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event if insufficient entries are received before late entry begins.

2.6 Number of Entrants Accepted

McCreary Gravel Rally is limited to 50 vehicles. Regardless of class, or vehicle type. Entries paid in full will be prioritized. Entries above 50 will be waitlisted. Entries must be paid in full to be accepted.

2.7 Eligible Classes

Classes below will be scored per the NASA Rally Sport GRRs

^{*}NOTE: Competitors must receive approval from the NASA Rallysport Championship Director to enter RallyMoto™ Adventure Class.

2.8 Refunds

Entry fees shall be refunded in full if the event is canceled.

Entry fees shall be refunded in full if the organizer refuses the entry.

Entry fees shall be refunded minus \$100 if the competitor withdraws their entry prior to closing of online entries.

There are no refunds after opening of onsite registration.

Entry fees will not be refunded for any competitor/team who fails to attend a mandated NCO.

In all cases, processing fees will not be refunded.

In all cases, entry fees will be refunded electronically via transfer or other means convenient to the organizer in a timely fashion. Refunds may be subject to electronic processing fees not controlled by the organizer.

Advertising

3.1 Restrictions

Any advertising must comply with United States federal law, Kentucky state law and applicable local ordinances. It is the duty of competitors to read those laws.

3.2 Organizer Supplied Advertising

The organizers may supply an event specific ID Package, If supplied it must be displayed from presentation at scrutineering until the awards closing. If required, organizers will provide the ID package at registration.

3.3 Identification numbers

The size and location of the space for vehicle numbers is governed by the NASA GRR'S. All stickers, vinyl, paint, patches, or graphics containing text, logos, or numbers of alternate sanctioning bodies must be removed or completely and neatly covered.

Tires

This event places no additional restrictions on tires beyond the NASA GRR'S.

5. Fuel, Fueling, & Washing

Please adhere to state and federal guidelines for the transport of fuel to, from, and within The Commonwealth of Kentucky.

5.1 Fueling Zone

Fueling is permitted in your service area if the vehicle is on the ground, no one is in the vehicle, it is not running, a waivered crew member or volunteer is actively manning a fire extinguisher. All of these provisions are per NASA Rally Sport GRRs. A tarp must be placed under the vehicle to refuel in service.

Since there are several gas stations on the transit routes; use of a gas station for fueling during the event while on transit will not be considered off route or illegal service. Competitors are reminded they are responsible to check in on time at all controls and obey all traffic laws.

5.2 Washing

There will be no washing area or washing permitted in service due to runoff containment issues. There is a local self-serve car wash as indicated on the event map.

Since the carwash is on a transit route the use of the carwash while on transit will not be considered off route or illegal service. The hood and trunk must remain closed in the car wash. Competitors are reminded they are responsible to check in on time at all controls and obey all traffic laws.

6. Testing

No testing is allowed in accordance with <u>NRS GRRs</u>. Violation of this regulation will result in exclusion from the event.

7. Reconnaissance (Recce)

The organizer will NOT PROVIDE stage notes. During the reconnaissance, each team should make their own notes. It is strongly recommended teams participate in recce.

7.1 Registration Schedule

Thursday April 25th 5:30-7:30PM & Friday April 26th, 8:00AM -2:00PM, All competitors must check in before recce to avoid penalties under NASA GRR 2.15

7.2 Reconnaissance Vehicle Insurance

It is important to note that the vehicle used for reconnaissance must be covered by insurance in accordance with NASA GRR section 2.3.2.

7.3 Reconnaissance Vehicle Identification

Recce vehicles must display the provided identification decal in the top right corner of the windshield. Use of white rental cars for recce is discouraged as they generally have "issues".

7.4 Reconnaissance Schedule

Reconnaissance will be permitted per the event schedule on the NASA Rally Sport website.

Reconnaissance Speed Limit and Advisory Notes

Speed limit during recce is 30 mph unless traffic signs indicate a lower limit.

During both Recce and the Rally any interaction with any regulatory agency resulting in a traffic ticket or citation that would reflect poorly on the Rally, may be subject to DISQUALIFICATION with no refund. Judgment of fact is solely at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. A decision made to disqualify a competitor is final and there is no process for appeal.

Competitors are reminded that stage roads will be open to normal traffic during reconnaissance and that they must drive in a manner that does not endanger or inconvenience other traffic. Law enforcement and event officials using any observational method will check speed compliance.

Competitors are reminded that some stages are turn around stages. **YOU WILL ENCOUNTER TWO WAY TRAFFIC**. Emergency services are not in place during recce. Do not ignore the published schedule.

7.5 Reconnaissance Vehicle

No competition vehicles may be used for reconnaissance. No reconnaissance vehicle may have decals or numbers.

7.6 Reconnaissance Prize

There is no prize for Reconnaissance.

8. Registration & Administrative Checks

8.1 Location

Stearns Heritage Hall 27 Bridge St, Stearns, KY 42647.

8.2 Times

Thursday April 25th 5:30-7:30PM & Friday April 26th, 7:00-11AM

8.3 Documents to be presented.

The following items will be checked at registration:

Online entry (driver info, co-driver info, vehicle info, license, etc.) with all required information MUST be completed before the event. The only exception is for rental or replacement vehicles being used for recce or service but have the required proof of insurance in accordance with NASA GRR section 2.3.2.

8.4 Competitor & Service Packet

Competitors may download to their device (smart phone, tablet, laptop etc.) the most current supplementary regulations and bulletins. A printed road book will be available during administrative checks and registration.

The NASA Rally Sport Vinyl package was revised in 2023. If you require a new or updated set please indicate your needs in advance. If needed, replacement windshield banners are available at registration for \$15.

There is no Service Packet but all service crew that enter the service areas must be waivered and wear the event wristband for the duration of the event.

9. Scrutineering, Sealing, and Marking

Scrutineering time and location is found on the rally schedule. Scrutineering will check the safety and eligibility of the vehicles to compete. Vehicles may also be checked for general roadworthiness, homologation papers, verification of VIN, or other aspects of vehicle legality. All safety gear to be worn by competitors (fire suit, helmet, head restraint) must also be presented with the vehicle for examination.

Logbooks **will not be issued** at this event unless approved by the Chief Scrutineer at least 2 weeks before the event. Please reach out to scrutineer@nasarallysport.com immediately if you need a logbook issued for this event.

9.1 Logbooks

Logbooks may be retained by the Chief Scrutineer. If they are, they must be picked up at the end of the event. The Chief Scrutineer will be made aware of any DNFs and those vehicles will be inspected before the log books are returned. Following the event, any remaining log books may be mailed to you at your expense by contacting the Chief Scrutineer. Please ensure you get your lo book before you leave the event, we are not responsible for your logbook if you do not retrieve it the day of the event.

9.2 Shakedown

Shakedown will be at The Strunk Flea Market Grounds 5807 US Rt. 27 Strunk KY as per the event schedule. This is **the only** opportunity for spectating by the community participation is mandatory to start the rally unless the COC, Co-Organizer or Scrutineer allows otherwise. Multiple passes are encouraged if time permits. Shakedown is not a testing session. nor necessarily representative of the road conditions. Shakedown is to confirm operational safety and basic performance. Shakedown will not be timed. Some competitors may be asked to provide courtesy rides for local press and dignitaries.

9.3 Parc Exposé

Parking area of the "Whistlestop" per the event schedule Immediately following Shakedown

10. Rally Operations

10.1 Publication Times of Starting Order

At or about 18:00 (6pm) April 26th, 2024.

10.2 Official Time

Official time will be synchronized to the atomic clock broadcast as displayed on a scoring tablet. This will be available at registration. For Android users you may also find official time on the NASA Rally Sport Clock app in the google play store.

10.3 Ceremonial Start

There will be no Ceremonial Start

10.4 Parc Exposé

Competitors are expected to showcase our sport by being present in competition attire. Attendance is mandatory for the duration of the event.

10.5 Official Start Location

Service out, In front of the Stearns General Store in Stearns, Kentucky (Rt 1651) Adjacent to Service and Event HQ

10.6 Official Start Time

Per Schedule

10.7 Control and Check-In

The rally will be scored in hours, minutes and seconds.

10.8 Maximum Permitted Lateness

The MPL for competition vehicles is 15 minutes or as determined by the Clerk of the Course for special cases.

10.9 Notification of Traffic Violations

Any competitor who receives a traffic violation or discovers that their Team has received a traffic violation, must notify the Clerk of the Course as soon as possible. Penalties will be awarded as per NASA Rally Sport GRR's or as determined by event officials. Any crew or team failing to take documented action to notify the Clerk of the Course or Co-Organizer at the next service or time control immediately following the receipt of the traffic violation may be subject to the additional penalties up to exclusion from the event.

10.10 Retirement

Competitors retiring from the rally must report such retirement to the organizers/stewards or CRO (if there is one) as soon as possible (text message, Facebook message, email is acceptable) and by using the electronic inquiry process in your account online. Any crew failing to comply will be liable to a sanction at the Stewards' discretion.

10.11 Re-Starting

There are limited opportunities for returning a vehicle to the field. The only point at which any reentry will be considered is following a service. The vehicle must be re-inspected by the Chief Scrutineer and approved by the Stewards and the Clerk of the Course. The vehicle will be scored as a DNF. Competitors will be re-inserted as close to their previous position as possible.

11. Service Area

11.1 Location

Lower parking lot adjacent the rally HQ in Stearns, KY

11.2 Tarping

A tarp must be used under the vehicle when being serviced. Refueling is service. Any spills of liquids must be immediately contained, cleaned up and properly disposed of.

11.3 Access Times for Service Vehicles

Service team members may enter and begin set-up in the service area on April 26th, 2024 Starting at 4:30pm

Vehicles not registered for service may not enter the service area. Service MAY be tight. Be considerate. **Chief Scrutineer may assign service location.**

RallyMoto Service will be in an area congruent to the Rally HQ complex A bulletin will be issued with details if they are not available at the time of the publication of these Supplemental Regulations.

Overflow service areas to be assigned by Chief Scrutineer only. All individuals, including team members, crew, and any spectator, must sign the event waiver and wear a bracelet demonstrating that the waiver has been signed.

Currently NO open vehicle trailers will be allowed in Service. At the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer trailers used for servicing of the vehicle may be allowed and will be assigned a location. Alternate parking for open vehicle trailers is being sought, and the location will be published as a bulletin when available.

11.4 Trash Disposal

All trash must be removed. Pick up your trash and the trash of others. Trash left behind will be removed and teams responsible will be fined to pay for cleanup. Never mind the online shaming that will happen. Remember, we are guests.

12. Trophies and Prizes

Event and Atlantic Rally Cup trophies will be awarded.

13. Final Checks

After clearing the final control, the Chief Scrutineer will notify any competitors who need to move their vehicle into Parc Fermé for scrutineering. Please read the NASA Rally Sport GRR's regarding who can and cannot move a vehicle during Parc Fermé.

14. Results

Provisional and Final results will be posted on the NASA Rally Sport website in accordance with the NRS GRRs.

15. Stage & Event Maps

An event map will be published online by April 1st 2024. It may be updated prior to the start of the event. If it is updated competitors will be notified electronically. GPX, KMZ, and KML files will be available online to fully paid entrants.
