1. Service Park Entrance / Exit

Competitors are informed that following the final settlement of all teams in their dedicated service areas, Gate A will be closed for service or auxiliary cars. Gate B will be used as the entrance/exit for all teams' cars with the relevant passes starting from Wednesday 7/9 at 7:00 am.

2. EKO SSS @ Olympic Stadium – Summary of activities / Thursday 8 September

2.1 Transportation

As soon as Shakedown is completed, rally cars can be uploaded on the transporting trucks in the loading area which will be outside the SP facing the north round-about. Exit of rally cars to the loading area will be only from Gate B. All cars using the organisers' transportation, must be loaded on the trucks no later than 14:00 hrs

2.2 Unloading venue Olympic Stadium (Appendix 1 – Layout of SSS)

As soon rally cars are unloaded, they will follow marshals' instructions to enter the parking area. Rally cars will be parked in this area according to the Start List for Section 1. All rally cars must be in the holding area by 18:00 hrs on Thursday, 8 September 2022.

2.3 Reconnaissance over SSS1

Crews will walk to the track following the white/red line of (see Attachment 1), entering the stage from the Start Ramp. To enter the track all crews must wear their passes.

Reconnaissance will be performed according to Art. 9.5 of Bulletin No3.

2.4 After the completion of reconnaissance selected drivers will attend the following activities:

18:00 - WRC Broadcasters – Meet & Greet – 15 mins

69 – Rovaniemi, 8 – Tanak, 19 – Loeb

18:00 - Acropolis Rally Greece VIP Meet & Greet – 10 mins

18:15 - VIP Autograph Session – 10 mins

18 – Katsuta, 4 – Lappi, 6 – Sordo, 7 – Loubet

- 2.5** A drivers' waiting zone with tents, chairs and refreshments will be organized up to their due time to the TC1.
- 2.6** While in the waiting zone, all P1 and selected priority crews will sign autographs for the public in a special venue for this session, in the Rally Village adjacent to the holding area. The list of drivers is the following:
- All P1 drivers, 20 – Mikkelsen, 21 – Rossel, 22 – Suninen, 25 – Lindholm, 26 – Ingram, 32 – Prokop, 47 – Kechagias, 48 – Roustemis, 49 – Athanasoulas and 50 – Tsouloftas

3. EKO SSS @ Olympic Stadium – TC1 – Start / Finish

- 3.1** At 19:58 the first pair will check in at TC1 at the same time according to the Start List for Section 1
- 3.2** Both cars will follow the same white/red line as for the reconnaissance and they will take their positions in parallel on the start ramp and on the side (left or right) that the marshal before the ramp directs them.
- 3.3** After the presentation, both rally cars will enter the circuit on the same lane (lane 2) and drive to the start (see **Attachment 2**).
- 3.4** Just after the right corner the first car entered will change to lane 1 following the marshal's instructions. Both rally cars will take their start positions as in any normal special stage.
- 3.5** All crews will run two full laps and will cross the flying finish at the same point where it started.
- 3.6** After the finish, each car passing over or under the bridge will be flagged out from the track at the relevant opening spot of its lane.
- 3.7** Upon immediately exiting the track and just before the entrance under the grandstand selected drivers will be interviewed for TV and stadium big screens. Crews must only leave this point once directed.

4. Refuel

Competitors are reminded that next refuelling venue following the refuel after the Shakedown, is on Friday 9 September in Loutraki
