12.4 Transportation of rally cars to Athens

Uploading area will be outside of the Service Park Gate A towards to the north round-about. All cars using the organisers transportation, must be loaded up by 14:00 hrs on Thursday, 8 September 2022.

12.5 Ceremonial/Rally Start order and Running of EKO Super Special Stage (add)

- All rally cars must be in the holding area by 18:00 hrs on Thursday, 8 September 2022.
- Use of extra lights is forbidden on SSS1.

12.7 Finish procedure and Prize-Giving

12.7.1 (Clarification) Due to promotion activities, spectator movements in the Service Park, and the Final Podium being held adjacent to the Service Park, teams are forbidden to dismantle any external structures in their service areas until the completion of final podium. There should be no movement of vehicles or dismantling operations outside the boundaries of each team service area until this point.

12.7.2 Competitors must leave from the service park no later than **Monday, September 12 at 20:00**. Any time later than that must be agreed with the organiser in advance.

12.9 Controls**12.9.1 General**

- b. All classified cars (except re-starting cars), must have completed the 45 min service after Section 5 and enter the parc fermé no later than ~~02:30~~ **22:30** and after Section 7 no later than 23:00.

12.11 Running of Flexi-Service**12.11.1 Running of 15- and 30-minute Flexi-Services (replace with the following:)**

Contrary to the prescriptions of FIA WRC, Art. 57.2.2, the 30-minute midday service on Saturday and 15-minute service on Sunday will be run as flexi-services for P1 and P4 crews.

At TC 10A (15A) **all P1 and P4 crews** are shown their due time for TC 10C (15C) - Service Out. After having completed the checks at the Technical Zone, P1 and P4 crews will pass TC 10B (15B) without stopping and immediately drive their cars into their service bays where the start and the end of the allowed service time will be controlled by rally officials. After servicing, the car shall (again) be isolated by ropes until it is driven to TC 10C (15C) by the crew. Any service in excess of the single, uninterrupted 30' (or 15') will be reported to the Stewards, who will apply time penalties even if the crew checks in at TC 10C (15C) on their due time.

At TC 10A (15A) **all other crews** are shown their due time for TC 10B (15B) - Regroup and Technical Zone OUT – Service IN. After having completed the checks at the Technical Zone, they shall leave their car in the Regroup/Flexi Parc Fermé area to be collected for service at their due time. At any time, the car may only be driven by the crew entered. Time entry shown at TC 10B (15B) mark the start of service.

12.17 Media Zones (replace with this:)

All priority drivers (and co-drivers upon request) must be available for media interviews for a minimum of 15 minutes or until they are given permission to leave by the FIA Media Delegate.

The Media Zone will be operational as follows:

TC5A, TC7A, TC10A, TC13A, TCX15A, TC16A

Access to the Media Zone is restricted to working media personnel only who are, in the view of the FIA Media Delegate, performing media duties and holding the correct pass.

The Media Zone will be divided into two separate zones:

- Zone 1: for WRC drivers and co-drivers and team personnel clearly performing media duties (team or driver PRs and team principals) plus members of the WRC+ live production team and their technicians as well as premium broadcasters. With the exception of drivers and co-drivers, all personnel entering Zone 1 must hold a MEDIA ZONE sticker or a red All-Access pass.
- Zone 2: for media personnel (journalists or tabard media) holding a green MEDIA pass or holders of a red All-Access pass.

Team personnel (team and driver PRs, social media managers, team principals) requiring access to the Media Zone to perform media duties are requested to contact the FIA Media Delegate to collect their MEDIA ZONE sticker at the beginning of the event. No other personnel will be allowed in the Media Zone unless authorised by the FIA Media Delegate and holding the correct pass.

Reminder:

- Tabard media are permitted in Zone 2 of the Media Zone (with the exception for those working for WRC manufacturer teams).
- Microphones/recording equipment on extension poles or in fixed positions near the drivers/team principals must be used together with disposable microphone covers or recording equipment that can be sanitized after every single interview.

12.18 On-Board cameras

2. 2022 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations

Following the decision of the WMSC meeting of 29 June 2022, FIA WRC Sporting Regulations have changed as follows:

55.1.1 The car of any FIA priority driver wishing to re-start must be serviced in the rally service park. After retirement, the vehicle must remain where it has retired until permission has been received from the Clerk of the Course to remove it directly to the parc fermé.

Cars of P1/P4 drivers may be brought directly to their service area and wait under Parc Fermé conditions until the FIA Technical Delegate gives authorisation to repair it or not.

Service of retired cars of any FIA priority driver must respect all the relevant conditions of these regulations. The car may be removed once for service at any time from the parc fermé for a maximum of 3 hours, **4 hours for P1 cars**, (including the 45' flexi-servicing and any maximum lateness allowed between two-time controls). However, all cars must be returned to the parc fermé at least 4 hours before the start of the next section after an overnight regroup.

For P1 cars, the 4-hour period can be split in 2 sections of time, the amount of time per section is at the discrepancy of the team.

APPENDIX VIII – 2022 WRC3 JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

3.2.2 In the final round of the **FIA WRC3 Junior Championship**, but only on the condition that the driver (**or the co-driver**) has entered and started within **the FIA WRC3 Junior Championship in** at least 3 of the previous **FIA WRC3 Junior Championship** rounds of 2022, the points for each classified driver (**or co-driver**) will be as follows:

(points table unchanged)

Drivers (**and co-drivers**) who have not entered and started within **the FIA WRC3 Junior Championship in** at least 3 of the previous **FIA WRC3 Junior Championship** WRC rounds of 2022 will receive points according to the normal FIA points scale, i.e. not doubled.

APPENDIX XIV – HIGH VOLTAGE OPERATIONAL SAFETY**9. QUARANTINE AND RECOVERY****9.1 Quarantine**

If a Rally1 car is in an unsafe situation (**red light**, fire or a severe accident) so that the driver is unable to re-join the special stage, the recovery team shall intervene to transport the car to an isolated and safe place to enable technical teams and firefighters to work on the car.

Any Rally1 car in quarantine must not remain unattended and a fire truck must be nearby ~~because the status of a failed, damaged or burnt car can be unstable, even if the fire seems to be totally extinguished.~~

Once the car has been deemed officially “retired” by the Clerk of the Course, the team will be authorised by the FIA E-Safety Delegate to enter the quarantine zone to work on the car.


Once in a quarantine state, the car will be handed over to the team under the supervision of the FIA E-Safety Delegate. The car safety state will be evaluated by the FIA E-Safety Delegate and the teamnominated person (see Article 4.4). Both will sign the FIA “handover form” to officially release the car (form available upon request from the FIA E-Safety Delegate).


The requirements for the quarantine zone are listed in a dedicated FIA document. It is aimed at defining the organisation, setting up and equipment of the quarantine zone for the special stage and remains available upon request to the FIA.

The selection of the zone and the implementation of the quarantine shall be done under the supervision of the FIA E-Safety Delegate and Safety Delegate.

9.2 Recovery supervision

The recovery operations to take an unsafe car, or a car that has sustained a severe impact, to the quarantine zone, shall always be made under the supervision of the FIA E-Safety Delegate. As an exception to the above, the FIA E-Safety Delegate with the support and agreement from the Clerk of the Course may place a car in a temporary quarantine at the location where the car has stopped. The car will be secured by local resources (marshals, TIV, etc.) and the FIA E-Safety Delegate will be able to move to the next stage. Once the HV safety nominated person (Article 4.4) is at the scene, he will sign the FIA handover form and take over responsibility for the car. The team will therefore be in charge of supervising the entire recovery operation from the car loading on to the truck, following the truck on the road, and up to the unloading process of the car. In such cases, the team can decide to bring the car to the quarantine zone or its service bay.
