## 1. UVP's

2023 Accent Benchtops Rally Qld has been granted a Qld Transport & Main Roads "Light Vehicle Standards Safe Movement Permit", and "Authority", to cover those competition vehicles from outside of Qld that are not registered.

The Permits are valid for Friday 21 (for Wheels on Mary), Saturday 22 and Sunday 23 July only, and permit those nominated vehicles to be driven only on the roads specifically identified and contained within the event road book.

This means that any unregistered vehicle covered by the above "Permit and "Authority" must not drive on public roads outside of the Gympie Showgrounds or off the nominated rally route during Friday night, and for Saturday and Sunday competition.

The Permits **DO NOT** include Testing on Thursday 20 July 2023, these rally cars must be moved either by trailer or transporter to the Test site.

**The TMR Authority and Light Vehicle Standards Safe Movement Permit documents must be carried in the relevant vehicle during all on-road movements on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.**

## 2. FRIDAY NIGHT PARKING

- **ARC crews:** On return from "Wheels on Mary", rally cars must be placed into the Friday Night Garage (see attached Overview and Overnight Garage Entry maps). All cars must be refuelled and fully prepared for the Saturday morning start prior to entering the Friday Night Garage. ARC crews are to ensure their rally car is parked in the Friday Night Garage by 2100hrs (21/7/23).
- **QRC crews:** On return from "Wheels on Mary", rally cars may be returned to their respective service bay within the KickAss Rally Village and prepared for the start on Saturday morning. Please note that TCO is located between The Pavilion and the "Bob Henzell Dairy Pavilion". Rally cars are to be refuelled in the KickAss Rally Village Refuel Area prior to making their way to TCO.
