Welcome to the 2024 Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland based in Gympie, SE Qld. This year's Accent Benchtops Rally Qld will be a Sprint Event for ARC competitors, featuring some 192km of competitive stages. The 2024 ABRQ again uses HQP forest and Shire roads to the south and west of Gympie – most of these roads were to be used in the 2023 event but we have two totally brand-new stages on Saturday and have blended two stages from 2023 into a new stage for Sunday. On Saturday, ARC crews will have 4 stages (run twice), with Sunday having 3 stages (run twice), and which includes the ever-popular "Gympie Gold" Power Stage.

The event will also incorporate a round of the KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship, KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland 2WD Rally Championship, KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Junior Championship, Acworth Recruitment Motorsport Australia Queensland Clubman Rally Series and WSC Subaru Experts Motorsport Australia Queensland Novice Rally Series.

On behalf of the 2024 Accent Benchtops Rally Qld Team, I look forward to welcoming you to Gympie.





ARTICLE 5 EVENT DESCRIPTION

- A) The Event will be a **SPRINT** event as defined in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The Event will consist of two heats over two days consisting of 4 sections. The Event will start on Saturday 29 June 2024 and will be approximately 460 km long, including 14 special stages totalling approximately 192 km. See Itinerary – Attachment 1a.
- C) All special stages will be on gravel surfaces with 2 stages each containing approx.1km of bitumen surface.
- D) The QLD Rally Championship **and** QLD Clubman Series will commence on the 29 June 2024 and will consist of 3 heats over 2 days. The event will be approximately 420 km in total, including 12 special stages totalling approximately 163 km. See Itinerary – Attachment 1b.
- E) The QLD Novice Series will consist of the first 4 stages of Section 1 (Saturday). See Itinerary – Attachment 1b.

ARTICLE 6 EVENT ELIGIBILITY

As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations with the addition of:

- 2024 Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship & Series Sporting Regulations.

ARTICLE 7 VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the 2024 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) As per the 2024 Queensland Rally Championship & Series Sporting Regulations.

ARTICLE 8 COMPETITOR AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) All Qld crews and automobiles will be eligible to score points in the Queensland Championships available.

Note: Any Driver or Co-Driver not residing in Queensland and wishing to compete in the Queensland Championship(s) must comply with 2024 Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship & Series Sporting Regulations if they wish to score points in the 2024 KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship.

- C) A compulsory crew briefing will be held at 16:00hrs on Friday 28th June 2024 in the Pavilion Building, Gympie Showgrounds

ARTICLE 9 ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE & REFUND POLICY

- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available from the [Motorsport Australia Members Portal https://portal.motorsport.org.au/octozy/login](https://portal.motorsport.org.au/octozy/login). Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is to be made as directed on the Entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.
- B) All entries **MUST** include a copy of all required documentation i.e. licences (Motorsport Australia and civil), automobile registration papers and club memberships.
- C) Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- D) Entries close as per the EVENT PROGRAMS.
- E) The number of entries will be limited to 70. If this limit is exceeded, preference will be given to higher seeded drivers and/or those who have competed in other ARC events in 2024, and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry forms.
- F) An Entry Fee may be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) to the following bank:

G) The entry fees for the Event are fixed as follows:

- H) **A refund of \$100.00 will be made to any Entrant that provides a volunteer official for the duration of the event. For a Novice entry, the refund will be \$50.00 for the Half Day entry.**
- I) Entries withdrawn after close of entry but prior to publication of the Entry List for the event will have their Entry Fee refunded less \$100 (Administration fee). Should the Competitor subsequently volunteer as an Official of the event this will be reduced to \$75, (or \$50 if the Competitor supplies additional Officials who also assist in the Event),
- J) Any entry withdrawn after the Entry List has been published and prior to **24th June 2024**, may be refunded up to 30% of their entry fee. For withdrawals after this date there will be **NO REFUND**,
- K) If the Event is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition for reasons of Force Majeure, the Organisers may retain up to 25% of the Entry fee (as per NCR 11).

ARTICLE 10 INSURANCE

- A) Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia.
 Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia National Insurance Program Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au
- B) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

ARTICLE 11 RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- A) All competitors and their rally cars are to attend the “Wheels on Mary” festival on Friday Night.
- B) The event will start from TC 0 located within the Gympie Showgrounds, at 0815hrs hrs on Saturday 29 June 2024,
- C) The starting system for the special stages will be in accordance with the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- D) The official time for the event shall be set to Australian Eastern Standard Time.
- E) Competition in a Heat will only be available to an automobile:
 - o Having finished the previous Heat; or
 - o Having started, but not necessarily finished, the previous Heat and being placed in the overnight Parc Fermé, as detailed in the event itinerary.
- Any crew wishing to re-join in the next Heat must advise the Competitor Relations Officer of the intention to restart no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled publication of the start list for the next heat.
- Heat 2 is scheduled to commence at 0800hrs on Sunday 30 June 2024, from TC 8D.

- Heat 2 for the QLD Rally Championship and Clubman Series, is scheduled to commence at 0900hrs (approx.) on Saturday 29 June 2024, from TC 8D

ARTICLE 12 SCRUTINEERING

- A) Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutineering in accordance with the requirements of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Scrutineering, apparel checks, turbo sealing and automobile weighing for all automobiles will be held on Friday 28 June 2024 in the *Bob Henzell Dairy Shed* (opposite the Pavilion), between 0900hrs and 1600hrs. A member of the service crew may present the automobile and apparel for inspection. Pre-Event Scrutiny location map is shown in Appendix 3. A scrutineering schedule will be advised by Bulletin.
- C) All signage required by the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations must be in place for scrutineering, at which time, scrutineers will check the signage placement.
- D) Post-event scrutineering will be held at Gympie Motor Group Workshop. Information regarding post event scrutineering, e.g. route to travel, will be advised by communication to affected teams.

Qld State competitors

- E) Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutiny in accordance with the requirements of the 2024 QLD Rally Championship and Series - Sporting Regulations.
- F) Pre-Event Scrutiny will be available on **Sunday 23 June 2024 at Tyres & More, 4 Dixon St. Strathpine between 0900hrs and 1500hrs**. If unable to attend Scrutiny, you may apply to the Chief Scrutineer to receive regional Scrutiny. Scrutiny may also be available at the KickAss Rally Village on Friday 28 June 2024 by appointment with the Chief Scrutineer (refer Appendix 3 for location).

ARTICLE 13 TESTING

- A) Testing will be available to ALL crews on Thursday 27th June 2024 from 08:30hrs until 12:30hrs.
- B) Reconnaissance of the test roads will be available 30 minutes prior to the Testing start times.
- C) Testing costs are \$500 per car. Full details of the testing locations will be emailed direct to the crews, on payment of this fee.
- D) Applications for test sessions can be made using the online application form only. No hard copy forms will be available.

ARTICLE 14 RECONNAISSANCE

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Recce will be available on Thursday, from 0630hrs till 1700hrs for all crews. Recce will recommence on Friday from 0630hrs till 1500hrs for all crews.
- C) Reconnaissance will be monitored by the RallySafe Lite (RSLITE) app, including speed and number of passes through stages.
- D) The use of the RSLITE app is mandatory for all crews doing reconnaissance, even if sharing a vehicle with another competitor.
- E) Crews are reminded to have the latest version of RSLITE loaded to their phone.
- F) The RSLite App must be switched on during reconnaissance. Any crew found on a Special Stage without the RSLite App switched on and operating, will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation for exclusion.
- G) A reconnaissance schedule is shown at Attachment 2.

ARTICLE 15 SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The Service Park (KickAss Rally Village) is situated within the Gympie Showgrounds and utilises bitumen roads surrounded by solid (grassed) ground.
- C) There is 240v power and town water available from a small number of power outlets and taps located within the Rally Village area. Power extension cords used are to display a current test certificate.
- D) There will be a Refuel Zone located within the KickAss Rally Village. All refuelling and/or decanting of fuels is to take place inside this Zone. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- E) There will be two Remote Refuelling Zones on Saturday 29 June. This location will be advised by Bulletin.
- F) The entire KickAss Rally Village is a designated “Non-smoking” area (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”).
- G) Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

NOTE - Within the KickAss Rally Village, cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from contacting the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.

ARTICLE 16 APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS – CONTROLS AND PARC FERMÉ

- A) For consistency, the penalties and other sporting regulations in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations shall apply to all crews entered in the 2024 Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland (ARC), those entered in the 2024 Queensland Rally Championship and any other associated events, e.g. time controls and parc fermé.
- B) Power Stage Media Activities – At the Power Stage Stop Point crews may be required to participate in media activities that will require the crew to remain in the Stop Point control area or close to it. The time that crews remain in this area will be deemed a neutralisation period. The crew will have a Stop Point official note the time of the neutralisation period on their Time Card. This time will be added to the Target Time for that Road Section.

ARTICLE 17 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RED FLAGS

Crews must make themselves familiar with these emergency procedures, as outlined in the Supplementary Regulations and in front of the road book. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.

A) Emergency Procedure

- I. In the case of an accident where urgent medical or fire attention is required, where possible the red “SOS” sign should be immediately displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. The Crew, if possible, where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) should press the “SOS” button, if available. The system will ask “Medical” or “Fire”? The Crew must press one of the buttons to confirm the situation which will advise Rally Command so the correct emergency service can be dispatched. This can be done at any time following an accident, even if the “OK” message has been activated. If possible, the Crew should call the Rally Command emergency number and advise of their status.
- II. Any crew which has, the RallySafe red SOS screen displayed, the red “SOS” sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has sustained an accident but is not displaying the green “OK” sign shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance.

- a. All following cars shall also stop.
 - b. The first car on the scene shall remain to render assistance.
 - c. The second car at the scene, if necessary, shall proceed to inform the next SOS radio point.
 - d. Notwithstanding the above, any person with appropriate training should remain on the scene if the situation demands
 - e. Subsequent cars shall leave a clear route for emergency vehicles and proceed at a reduced speed, to a maximum of 60kp/h, until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers.
 - f. Crews affected by this procedure will be allocated a time according to Article 22 of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations
- III. In the event of a car stopping on the stage or an accident where immediate medical or fire intervention is not required, the “OK” sign must be clearly and actively shown by a Crew member to at least the three following vehicles and to any helicopter attempting to assist.
- a. Where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) the Crew **MUST** press the “OK” button within 1 minute of the vehicle stopping, for any reason.
 - b. Failure to comply to these rules will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.

B) Red Flag

In the event of a special stage needing to be stopped, for any reason, SOS point officials will wave a red flag and the screen of the RallySafe console will turn red and show the message “RED FLAG”. On seeing any of these indications the crew **MUST**:

- I. reduce speed to less than 60km/h for the remainder of the special stage; and
- II. Crews must immediately confirm receipt of the electronic red flag by pressing the “ACKNOWLEDGE” button.
- III. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

C) Interruption of a Special Stage (including Super Special Stages) – Notional Time

When a special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, the Clerk of the Course will allocate, to each affected crew, a time which is judged to be reasonable and fair. A corresponding notification will be published by the Clerk of the Course, however, no crew which is solely or jointly responsible for stopping a stage may benefit from this measure. RSR-Special Stage Rally Articles 5.4 (e), (f) and (g) re Piggyback events do not apply to this event, as ARC and State crews may cross enter in the various competitions.

ARTICLE 18 RESULTS AND PROTESTS

- A)** Provisional results will be published on Sportity. These provisional results will become final 30 minutes after publication, subject to no protests being received, no issues are raised out of post event scrutineering and have been approved by the Stewards.
- B)** Protests must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules.
- C)** The events listed in Article 5D will be scored and results issued by <https://rallyresults.au/>

ARTICLE 19 AWARDS

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The following awards may be presented:

Driver and Co-Driver: 1st, 2nd & 3rd Outright
 - **KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland 2WD Rally Championship**
Driver and Co-Driver: 1st

Driver and Co-Driver: 1st
 - **Acworth Recruitment Motorsport Australia Queensland Clubman Rally Series**
Driver and Co-Driver: 1st
 - **WSC Subaru Experts Motorsport Australia Queensland Novice Rally Series**
Driver and Co-Driver: 1st

The organisers reserve the right to combine trophies where crews win more than one award and add to the awards up to the start of the rally.

ARTICLE 20 ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- A) Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- B) Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- C) **Consumption of alcohol in the Service Park or any section of the competition venue under the control of rally officials is forbidden until ALL competition is concluded each day.**

ARTICLE 21 EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Gympie Showgrounds & KickAss Rally Village

As part of the Event's Agreement to use the Gympie Showgrounds, there is a stipulation that **NO VEHICLES** are permitted to cross the horse training track surrounding the KickAss Rally Village at any point between **2am and 9am on the mornings of Thursday 27 and Friday 28 June, and between 2am and 8:00am on Saturday 29 June.**

Pedestrian access will be available only via a controlled pedestrian crossing between the KickAss Rally Village and the Car Park area from **6am to 9am** on Thursday and Friday, and from **6am and 8am** on Saturday. This is strictly for pedestrian use only. Please ensure you comply with this requirement as there will be absolutely no excuses or exemptions.

This means that any vehicles and/or equipment required for Testing prior to 9am on Thursday, 9am on Friday (for Recce and Scrutiny) and prior to 8am on Saturday, are to be placed in the overnight Car Park area outside the training track ring (refer KickAss Rally Village Overview map – **Appendix 3**).

The access gates to the Showgrounds perimeter will be closed at 10pm on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. They will re-open at 6am each morning.

There will be a dedicated roving Security Service in operation in the Rally Village between 6pm and 6am on Friday 28 June and Saturday 29 June.

“Wheels on Mary” Street Party - Friday 28 June

The Gympie Regional Council are planning a public activity in Mary Street (Gympie's main street) on Friday 28 June.

Competing cars and their crews are to make their way to the KickAss Rally Village Regroup Area where they will be placed in numerical order (beginning with car 1) to facilitate parking on arrival at the street venue. Departure from the Gympie Showgrounds will begin at 1720hrs via the Exhibition Rd exit gate for arrival into Mary Street from 1730hrs. Travel instructions will be issued by Communiqué.

Competing cars are then required to be on display at “Wheels on Mary” between 1730hrs and 1930hrs, whilst competing crews are to be in attendance in driving suits or team apparel between 1745hrs and 1915hrs.

Following the “Wheels on Mary” Street Party, all **ARC crews** are to return their rally car to the Friday Night Overnight Garage (refer map – Schedule 3). **Note** - there will be no vehicular access to the KickAss Rally Village Refuel Zone prior to the start on Saturday morning. ARC crews should refuel their car before entering the Friday night overnight garage. All other items required for competition (e.g., driving suits, helmets), should also be on hand to ensure unnecessary pedestrian crossing of the horse training track. Security will be in attendance during Friday night.

QRC crews are to return their cars to the KickAss Rally Village after Wheels on Mary Street Party has concluded. Refueling will be available in the Refuel Zone for these crews on Saturday morning prior to departure from the Service Park.

For all competitors, TC 0 is located beside the “*Bob Henzell Dairy Stand*” opposite the Pavilion. Crews are reminded to be at TC 0 10 minutes before their allocated start time.
