ARTICLE 8: Competitor & Crew Eligibility - QRC competitors

(Refer 2024 Queensland Rally Championship Series Regulations, 7.2 DRIVER / CO-DRIVER ELIGIBILITY)

This item is to inform and to provide clarity regarding Clubman competitors.

As per the 2024 QRC Series Regulations, Clubman competitors can upgrade to compete as a QRC points scoring competitor when nominated on the event entry form, however all points accumulated as a Clubman competitor prior to the upgrade are forfeited once the upgrade has occurred.

A QRC competitor may return to a Clubman status at any event nominated on the official event entry form, so long as the compliance of 7.2.3 is met. Points will then be accrued from this entry to the event only as a clubman competitor.

ARTICLE 21: QUEENSLAND UNREGISTERED VEHICLE PERMIT (UVP)

Those vehicles subject to a QLD UVP must be driven only on roads included as instructions in the 2024 ABRQ Testing Road Book (Thursday 27th June), Instructions to Wheels on Mary (Friday 28th June) and instructions contained in the Event Road Book (Saturday 29th June & Sunday 30th June). The Safe Movement Permit (SMP) covers only those roads specifically listed on the Event Permit.

Additionally, the crew of these vehicles must carry in their vehicle, a copy of the SMP and a copy of Appendix A (as provided by the Event), and a copy of their **Class 22 CTP Certificate**, as issued by Suncorp, to be produced (if requested) by a member Qld Police Service and/or Transport & Main Roads authorised persons.

2024 ARC SPORTING AND TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

<u>All</u> crews entered in the ARC event are remined of the requirements of 2024 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations Version 4, Attachment A, 1. Advertising Requirements and 2024 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations Addendum V4. Advertising Requirements. Crew who are found not displaying the required advertising at any time during the rally may be referred to the Steward for a breach of the 2024 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.







SPEED LIMITS

Crews are reminded to comply with the Quiet Zone (and public road) speed limits during Reconnaissance (Thursday & Friday), and during competition (Saturday & Sunday). Speed limits, specifically in Quiet Zones, will be closely monitored with penalties being issued to those who ignore them.
