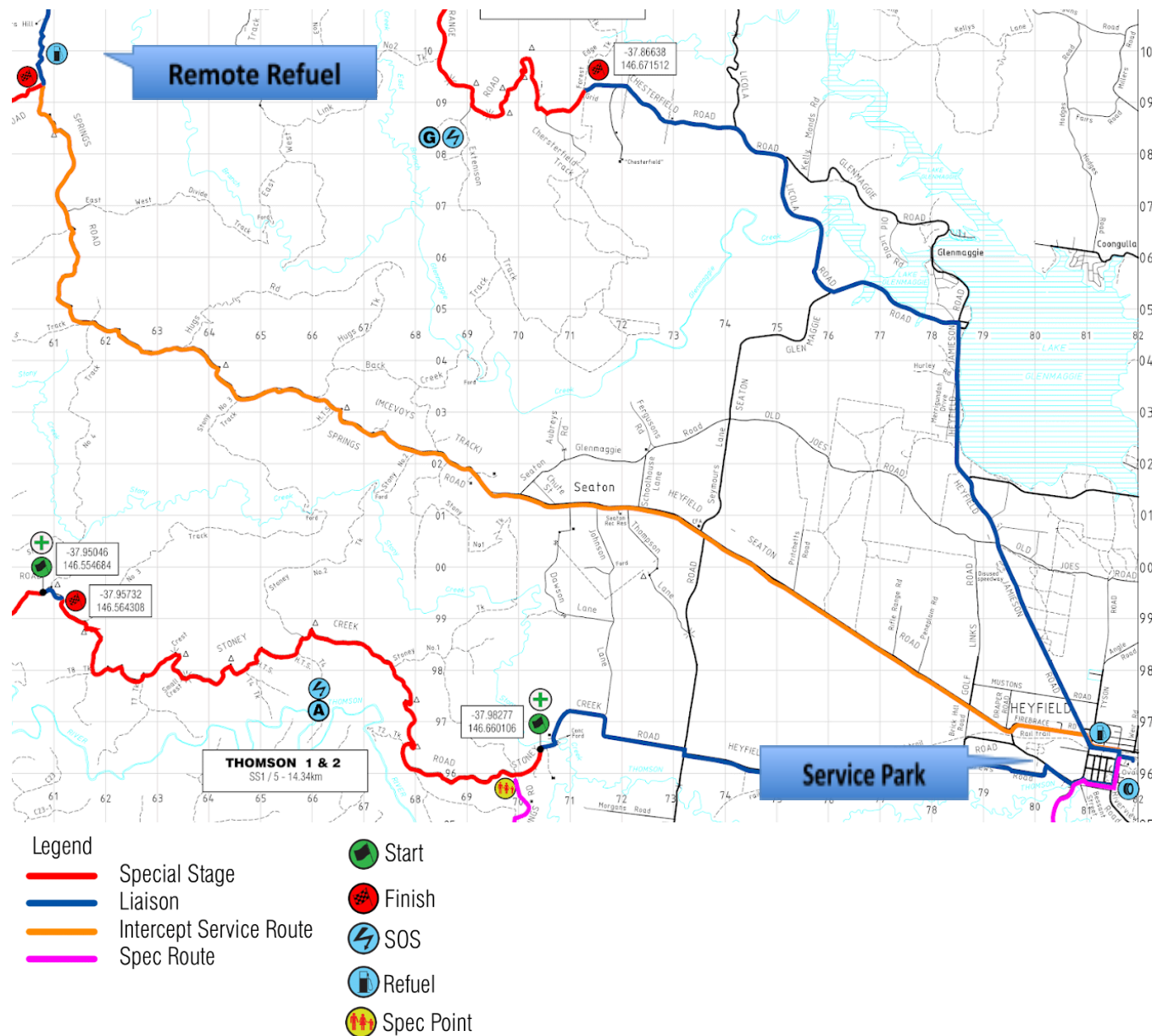

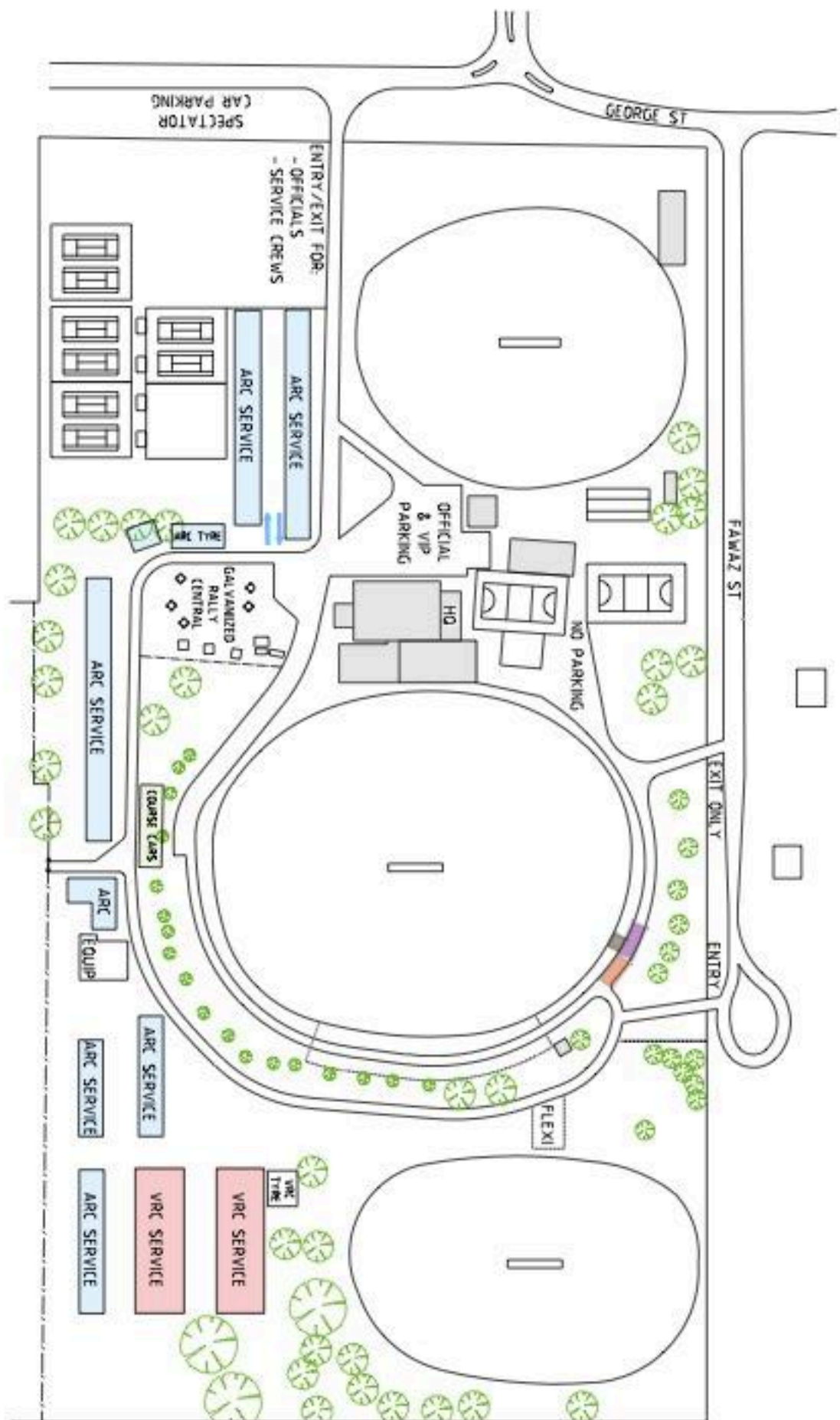

Please Park on Left side of road only
Ensure enough room is left for 2-way traffic on the road

Directions to Remote Refuel (Saturday)

Crews traveling to the refuel need to allow 35 minutes one way travel time

The road to the remote refuel has 16km of gravel road to travel. Please allow plenty of time and watch for other oncoming service and public traffic on the road.

This is a Refuel only there is NO servicing of the vehicles, and the area is only able to take a single service CAR only (no trailers please).

DIST	INSTRUCTION
0.00	Turn Right into Gordon St, at exit of Recreation Reserve
0.04	Turn Left into George St, continue past shop,s 40km/h
0.6	Give Way then Turn Right into Davis St
0.8	Straight On through roundabout (sign post C488 Licola Jamison)
1.0	Turn Left into Firebrace St
2.5	Give way then Turn Right onto Heyfield Seaton Rd
2.8	Start 100km/h
9.6	Straight On then 50m Straight On Sign post Cowwar/Seaton Rd
13.4	Start Gravel Road Sign post McEvoy's Track, 40km/h
14.9	Keep Right on Main Road
20.0	Keep Right on Main Road
23.5	Straight On Follow Main Road (SP Stoney Track No 5)
29.5	Straight On (SP Stoney Creek Rd) Ignore control on left
29.7	Refuel area on the left-hand side of road, for next 350m

DIST	INSTRUCTION
0.0	U Turn, then back along Springs Rd, ignore control on right, FMR, 40km/h
16.1	Straight On, start bitumen road, end speed restriction
19.8	Straight On follow Heyfield/Seaton Rd
26.9	Turn Left into Firebrace Rd.
27.9	Give Way then Turn Right onto Licola Rd
28.2	Keep Left through roundabout, take 2 nd exit, sign post Maffra C105
29.0	Turn Right into Gordon St
29.2	Keep Left on Gordon St, (do not Turn Left into Fawaz St) Then 100m Turn Left into Service Park.
