The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course regarding An alleged breach of Rally Standing Regulations regarding a change of competing crew during the event, have reviewed the presented evidence and made the following determination.

Fact At the Leg 1 Lunchtime service the Driver of Car #50 Scott Copleman stepped out of the car and the Co Driver then stepped into the drivers seat and a third person then assumed the Co Drivers position.

Rule **2024 RSR SSR**

2.3 NUMBER IN CAR

(c) The same Crew shall be required to compete throughout the *Event*, save in the case of a three- or four-man Crew when one or two members respectively may retire without replacement.

(d) The only persons permitted to ride in any car shall be those nominated on the *Entry* form, except in cases where personal assistance is being provided for compassionate reasons.

Decision The Stewards after reviewing the presented evidence from both parties and the current Regulations have determined that there was no breach of the regulations as the entry portal has provision for more than one Co -Driver (Licenced to Drive).

Reason There is a discrepancy between the Entry Portal system and the Standing Regulations that allows multiple crew members. All members of the crew were entered in the event and therefore were eligible to compete.
