Since the inaugural Forest Rally in 1983 and its designation as the WA round of the ARC in 1985 with the exception of the COVID affected years in 2020 and 2021 the club has consistently run the event for 45 years, marking 40 of those as part of the ARC. This year also commemorates an impressive 51 years of the ARC in Western Australia, solidifying its unique position as the only state with such a proud history in rallying.

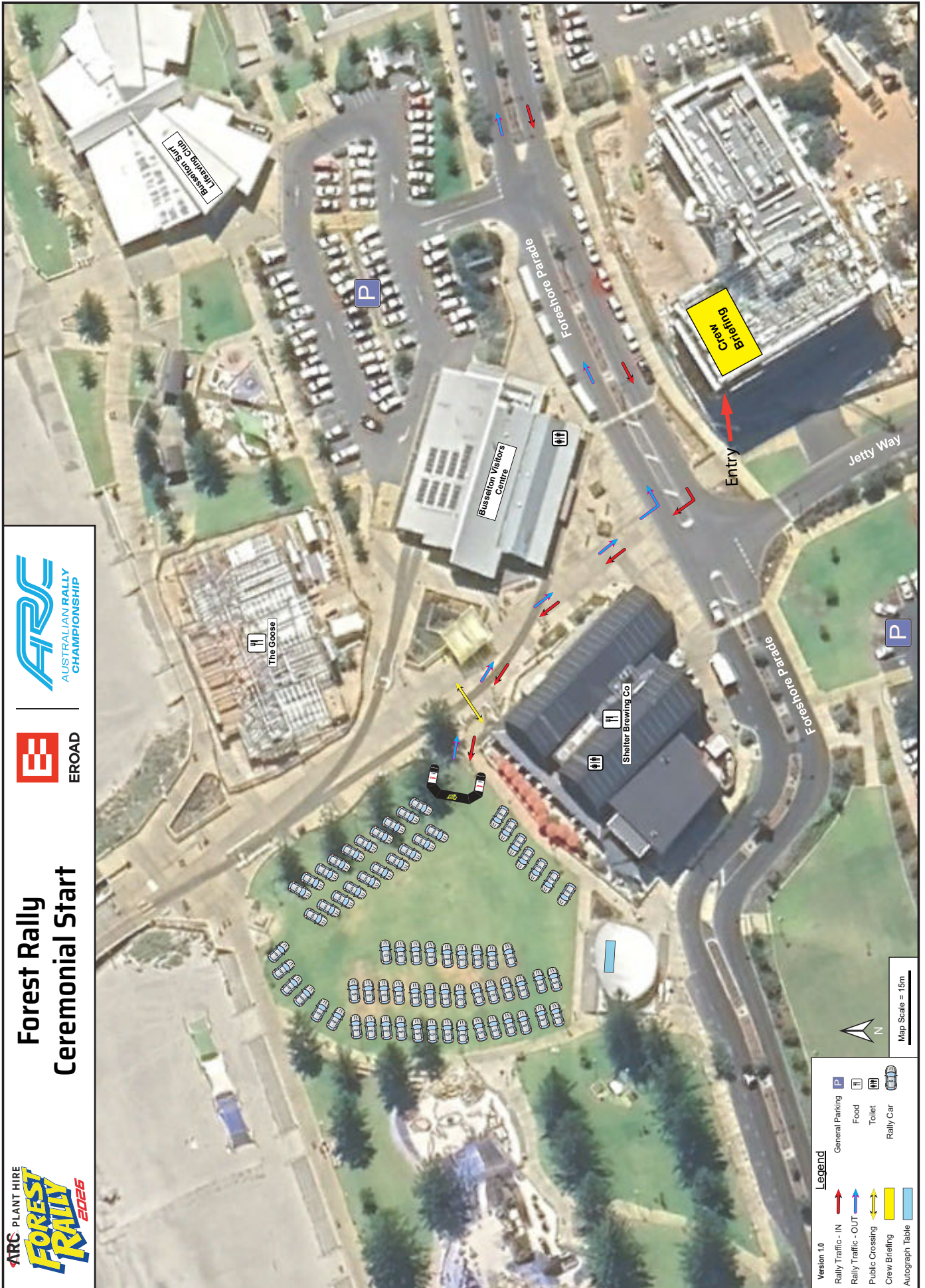
