#### Use of "RSLITE" Recce Phone Application

The organisers of the Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland will be using RSLITE phone application for Reconnaissance. As such, ALL competitors undertaking Reconnaissance are to download the app from their respective App Store during Reconnaissance.

Any Breach of Reconnaissance Rules will be referred to the stewards for application of penalties.

**ALL Crews**: RSLITE invite codes will be available on Sportity when available.

NOTE: RSLITE must be active on a phone in the recce vehicle during reconnaissance. If there are more than one crew in the recce vehicle, both crew phones must be switched on and have RSLITE active <u>and visible</u> to the crews.







## Occupant Extraction SAFETY TRIAL Round 3 – Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland

Motorsport Australia will be undertaking a SAFETY TRIAL, testing Occupant Self Extraction at Bosch Motorsport Australia Rally Championships and other events during 2023.

This TRIAL is to evaluate the capabilities of competitors to self-extract themselves from their automobiles. This TRIAL is in preparation for the introduction of regulations regarding occupant self-extraction in motorsport.

Occupant Self Extraction TRIAL - 2023 Bosch Motorsport Australia Rally Championships – Round 3 Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland

The following National Championship/Series have been selected to undertake this trial:

The TRIAL schedule will have competitors in each Championship/Series undertaking during the Regroup between TC4C and TC4D, on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2023.

Drivers and Co-Drivers will be selected from each Championship/Series to undertake the TRIAL.

Driver and Co-Driver selection is at the discretion of Motorsport Australia and will be actioned by the Risk & Safety Manger.

Refer to the below **Safety Trial** - Occupant Self Extraction Trial document attached to this Bulletin (refer attachment 4) as to the methods and requirements for those undertaking this.

NOTE: As this is only a TRIAL, competitors who fail this test will not be excluded from continuing at the event.





### **Occupant Self Extraction Trial**



#### Occupant Self Extraction.

Occupant self-extraction is the ability of an occupant of a vehicle to get out of the vehicle under their own power when required to do so. In some vehicles, getting out can be as simple as it is in a road car. In other vehicles self-extraction can be quite complex. Most of the time there is no time pressure to get in and out of a vehicle, but at times it can be critical.

#### The Trial

In preparation for the expected introduction of this new requirement, Motorsport Australia will be conducting a trial of the self-extraction test at several events during 2023. The trial will be performed in conjunction with the event organisers, and individual categories.

Using an agreed method of selecting and testing vehicle occupants, nominated officials will perform the self-extraction test using the testing method described below. The results of each test will be recorded and submitted to Motorsport Australia in the week following the event.

As this is only a trial, vehicle occupants who fail this test will not be excluded from continuing at the event, unless that event already has regulations that require this test to be passed.







#### **Proposed Regulations**

All occupants competing in an *Automobile* must be able to demonstrate they are able to self-extract themselves from their *Automobile*. The following details the self-extraction test and the requirements for passing that test.

#### Prior to the commencement of any test:

- The occupant must be fully attired, with all safety gear in place, as they would be when competing.
- The Automobile must be Stationary, on the ground and with all wheels, panels, and windows in place as they would be when competing.
- The steering wheel and all other parts of the interior must be fully in place as they would be when competing.
- The window net and/or Racing net must be in place as it would be when competing.
- All doors must be in the closed position and latched as they would be when competing.
- All windows must be in the closed position where it is possible to open and close an Automobiles windows
- The engine must not be running.
- The electrical system of the *Automobile* must be isolated such that there is no electrical power to any part of the *Automobile*.

#### The Test:

- The test must be timed by an event official using electronic timing (a stopwatch for example)
- The occupant must not remove any of the safety equipment mounted on their person during the test (For example, an occupants Helmet, Frontal Head restraint, gloves etc must all stay on the occupant whilst performing a timed extraction test).
- The test must start under the instruction of the event official timing the test, with an occupant on the
  driver's side of the Automobile having their hands on the steering wheel, and an occupant on the
  passenger's side of the Automobile having their hands in their lap.
- Each occupant must perform the extraction test alone without any assistance from any other party during the test.
- For an automobile with more than one occupant, each occupant must perform the test individually and without assistance.

#### Successful completion of the test

The test is successfully completed if:

- The occupant is fully clear of the external perimeter of the automobile, when viewed from above, in less than 10 seconds.
- The occupant may exit the automobile via any method, which may be through closest door, another door, a hatch, through a window or any other opening in the *Automobile*.

#### The test is failed if:

- If any part of the occupant is still within the perimeter of the *Automobile* after 10 seconds have elapsed from the commencement of the test.
- If the occupant removes any safety equipment mounted on their person to extract themselves from the Automobile.
- If the occupant turns the power to the vehicle on at any time once the test has commenced.







#### **Conditions:**

- An occupant may attempt the test no more than 3 times at one Event. If after 3 attempts the
  occupant is unable to pass the test, then the occupant is not permitted to continue to or begin to
  compete in that Automobile at that Event.
- If successful, an occupant will not be required to perform the test again at that Event unless the
  vehicle has been modified in a way that may reduce the ability of the occupant to self-extract, or
  the occupant's fitness has changed since the initial test was performed (for example an occupant
  that has been injured during and Event may be retested)
- This test applies to all Automobile occupants.
- An event official may request that this test be performed by a vehicle occupant at any point during an event.
- If an occupant has failed to successfully complete the test more than 3 times at an *Event*, and the *Automobile* has subsequently been modified in a way that may improve the ability of an occupant to self-extract, then that occupant may request a retest. No modifications to improve access are permitted that will make the *Automobile* ineligible for any reason.
