<b>Date:</b>	23 July 2023
<b>Time:</b>	Heat 2
<b>Location:</b>	Gympie QLD
<b>Fact:</b>	Car 15 was observed at various locations with a rim without an inflated tyre and the various locations could only have been reached by driving on roads open to normal public traffic
<b>Rule:</b>	National Rally Standing Regulations – Event General Clause 4.1 (b) - On a road open to normal traffic a Competition vehicle may only be driven on four freely rotating wheels and tyres.
<b>Decision:</b>	We find the competitor guilty and impose a penalty of disqualification from Heat 2 of the Competition.
<b>Reason:</b>	The rule requires four freely rotating wheels and tyres, ARC Championship Regulations 18 (b) require the observation of the traffic laws of the state and the QLD traffic rules require that a tyre must have a tread depth of 1.5mm on every part of the tyre that touches the road and not have any apparent defect that is likely to make the vehicle to which they are fitted unsafe.
