### Reconnaissance Notes

#### Saturday

While it is possible to recce stages SS1 & SS2 twice before moving to stages SS3 & SS4, for least time and distance travelled, it is recommended that all stages are done consecutively in two loops.

To get directly from end of SS 4/8 back to start of SS1/5 follow road section after end of SS4/8 up to and including Tulip 17 on Page 33, and use the following instructions to get to start SS1/5:

Odometer	Instruction
21.48	KR then 50m TR SP Seaton Glenmaggie Rd
25.43	SO FMR (SP Old Joes Rd)
27.83	TL then 80m TR SP Cowwarr-Seaton Rd
32.03	TR Start Gravel SP Stoney Creek Rd

*Then follow the Road Book from Tulip 13 on Page 11 to start SS1/5*

### **Sunday**

Due to the configuration of SS9 and SS16, reconnaissance must be carried out separately with two passes of the stage taking place within a single session. Reconnaissance will not be permitted outside the nominated session times.

Crews will be held at the start line of SS9 by an Event Official until the preceding crew has passed Tulip 2, after which the next car will be allowed to commence reconnaissance of the stage.

Once the session for SS9 concludes, crews are to assemble at the start of SS16 and may commence at normal intervals. However, it is to be noted that an Event Official will be positioned at Tulip 7 and will hold crews until the preceding crew has completed reconnaissance of the Hillclimb track component of the stage and has passed the flying finish. It is recommended that reconnaissance of SS10 – SS12 is to be completed consecutively in two loops.

To get directly from the end of SS12/15 back to the start of SS10/13 follow road section after end of SS12/15 up to and including Tulip 23 on Page 31, and use the following instruction to get to the start of SS10/13.

Odometer	Instruction
37.22	Give Way then TR SP Freestone Creek Rd

*Then follow the Road Book from Tulip 18 on Page 16 to start SS10/13*

### **Use of “RSLITE” Recce Phone Application**

The organisers of The Middle of Everywhere Gippsland Rally will be using RSLITE phone application for Reconnaissance at this year’s event. As such, ALL competitors (ARC & VRC) undertaking Reconnaissance are to download the app from their respective App Store before commencing Reconnaissance.

Any Breach of Reconnaissance Rules will be referred to the stewards for application of penalties.

RSLITE invite codes will be sent via SMS to the mobile phone number provided for the co-driver. For RSLITE download and usage instructions see Attachment 2.

**NOTE:** It is compulsory for each crew to have RSLITE active on a phone in their recce vehicle for the entire time of conducting reconnaissance. The phone must be **visible** to both crew members during recce. Failure to activate the RSLITE app or have the phone visible will be referred to the Stewards for the application of a penalty.

## Article 14                  Running of the Rally

- G)** Articles 5.4 (e), (f) and (g) of the Rally Standing Regulation-Special Stage Rally, re Piggyback events do not apply to this event, as ARC and State crews may cross enter in the various competitions.




When you arrive and check in at the event, each car number will be given a unique code to enter into the app.




Main Screen when app is opened. Click "add event".

When logged into the event with your code, the main screen will display your current speed and two odometers. Both odometers can be reset by pressing and holding the mileage.

As you arrive to a stage, the screen will display the maximum KPH allowed, along with the odometers and your current speed. If you exceed the allowed speed limit, a red bar speeding message will be displayed at the top of the screen.



80kph is the speed limit.



Note the speeding message.

When you begin recce, the application must be active on your phone and stay active during transits and while on stages. The phone can be used for other uses such as texting, navigation, etc. but should stay on the RS Lite app as much as possible during transits and at all times on stages. Your position, speed, and direction of travel will be monitored during the recce period

Additionally, if the app is forcefully disabled on stage, a report is generated and may result in an infraction being applied. With privacy concerns in mind, the app does not track or send data if it is not active on the screen. Because of this, competitors must make sure the app is active during recce. If the app doesn't report for an extended period of time during recce, an alert is sent in the monitoring system.
