### **ARC Crews Only - Reconnaissance Schedule Notes**

#### **Thursday 21st August (Sunday stages)**

- It is recommended that all three stages are done consecutively in two loops. To get directly from end of SS 14/18 back to start of SS2/7/12, follow the Google Map link: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/B93fDsXVE8bt7b9h6>
- Latest Start time of SS2 is 1500hrs to enable two passes
- Single loop time for Thursday Reconnaissance is approx. 1hr

#### **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August (Saturday stages)**

- It is recommended that two consecutive passes of SS1/6/11/15 are completed independently of two consecutive passes of SS4/9 and SS5/10. The two loops can be done in any order.
- To get directly from end of SS1/6/11/15 to SS4/9, follow the Google Map link: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/VwuBa8wuZE1YHA2p6>
- To get directly from end of SS5/10 to SS4/9 follow the Google Map link: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/pc8wF7NNETBvdALL8>
- Single loop time for Friday reconnaissance is 2hrs.

### **VRC Crews Only - Reconnaissance Schedule**

- It is recommended that two consecutive passes of SS1/6 are completed independently of two consecutive passes of the SS2/7 to SS5/10. The two loops can be done in any order.

### Competitors Guide for the Restricted Time Zone (RTZ)

The purpose of the RTZ is to remain in the zone for a specified time period. Crews will be advised of the upcoming zone on their Rally Safe Units (Figure A) that will coincide with stage signs.

Once the crew enters the RTZ, the remaining time is shown in the white banner as a countdown. The length of the RTZ is also shown in the banner as a countdown (Figure B).

On completion of the time limit within the zone, ACHIEVED will be displayed (Figure C).

**Please note that the minimum speed at any time within the RTZ shall be 30km/h.**
