The Stewards, having received an Inquiry submitted via Sportity requesting a change to the entered driver and co-driver for Car No. 267, have considered the matter and determine the following:

**Time:** The inquiry was received at 5:31 on 14 April 2026

**Session:** The period after the close of Registration (23:59 on 7 April 2026) and prior to the scheduled first meeting of the Stewards (20:00 on 16 April 2026)

**Facts:** Following the close of entries, David Quillen, the entered Co-Driver of Car No. 267, submitted a request to amend the driver and co-driver designations. He advised that due to a last-minute professional obligation, the registered Driver, Cristian Perocarpi, is unable to attend the rally. Accordingly, he requests to be reassigned from Co-Driver to Driver, and for Michael Myers to be entered as the substitute Co-Driver.

Supporting documentation was provided to the Senior Steward regarding the unforeseen work obligation of Cristian Perocarpi.


**Rules:** GCR 4.11 and 4.15 governing entries and GCR 6.2.3.I empowering Stewards to authorize a change in crew.

**Decision:** The Organizers are authorized to amend the entry for Car No. 267 by reassigning David Quillen from Co-Driver to Driver and by replacing the originally entered Co-Driver with the nominated substitute, Michael Myers, provided that Mr. Myers satisfies all applicable licensing and co-driver eligibility requirements.

**Reasons:**

- GCR 4.11.a and 4.15 allows change of entry after the close of entries and prior to the first Stewards Meeting for reasons of hardship or Force Majeure.
- The Senior Steward requested and received from Mr. Quillen clear evidence that the employment circumstances of Mr. Perocarpi precluding him from attending Olympus Rally arose suddenly, could not reasonably have been anticipated, and was mandatory and unavoidable.
- The Senior Steward determines that the documented circumstances meet the threshold for hardship and that approving the requested changes does not confer an unfair sporting advantage nor prejudice the orderly conduct of the event.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 9 of the ARA General Competition Rules.
