The Stewards, having received a report from the Chief Scorer Marni Nagy regarding an error in the published National results have considered the matter and determine the following:

Time: The report was received at 06:30PST on 22 April 2026

Facts: RallySafe identified an issue with the Stage 16 finish time captured for Car 417 (Raftery/McKillop). However, this captured time was inadvertently used in the published Provisional Results.

During a post-event audit of competitor timecards and corresponding Time Control log sheets, it was determined that the Stage 16 finish time of 14:50:09.1 recorded by RallySafe for Car 417 was incorrect. The official records establish the correct finish time as 14:47:09.1.


Rules: GCR 6.3.2 authorizes the Stewards to instruct the Chief Scorer to amend the results of a competition to correct administrative errors.

Decision: The Stewards determine that a RallySafe error resulted in the incorrect Stage 16 finish time being recorded for Car 417. Accordingly, the Chief Scorer is instructed to:

1. Correct the Stage 16 finish time for Car 417 to 14:47:09.1;
2. Recalculate all affected stage times, overall times and classifications impacted by this correction.
3. Reissue amended results as "Provisional Results (Revision 2)", clearly indicating somewhere on these results that the revision is made by order of the Stewards following post-event review as set out in Steward Decision 13.

Rationale:

- The official records (timecard and TC log sheets) are consistent and establish the correct finish time. The originally published time constitutes an administrative error. Correcting this error ensures the results accurately reflect competitor performance in accordance with the applicable regulations and preserves competitive equity.
