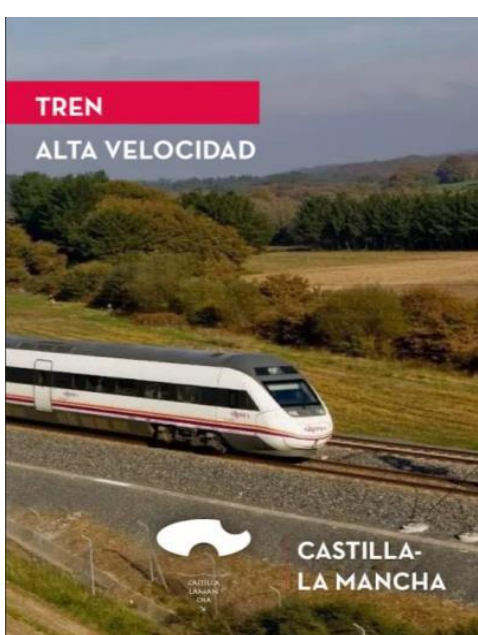
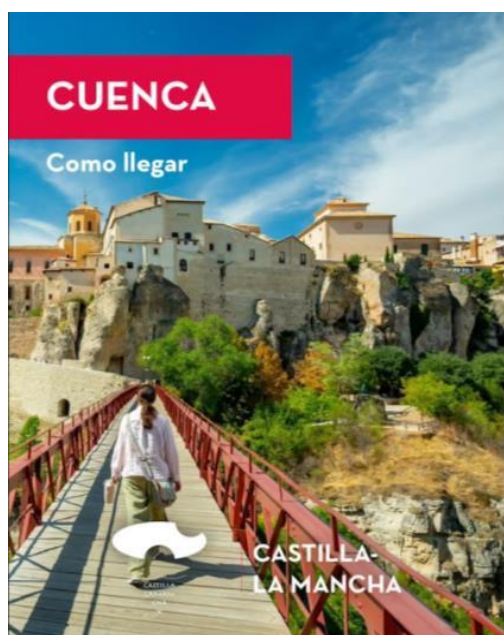
How to get to Cuenca?

The city has direct connections that make it easy to visit during these days:

High-speed train Cuenca is connected by AVE with Madrid and Valencia, arriving at Fernando Zóbel station, a few minutes from the center.

By car Direct access via the A-3 (Madrid–Valencia) and connection to the A-40, allowing you to get there comfortably from different points or public transport.

An accessible destination to explore its historic center, its natural environment and its heritage. Organize your getaway to Cuenca and its province.



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Where to eat in Cuenca?

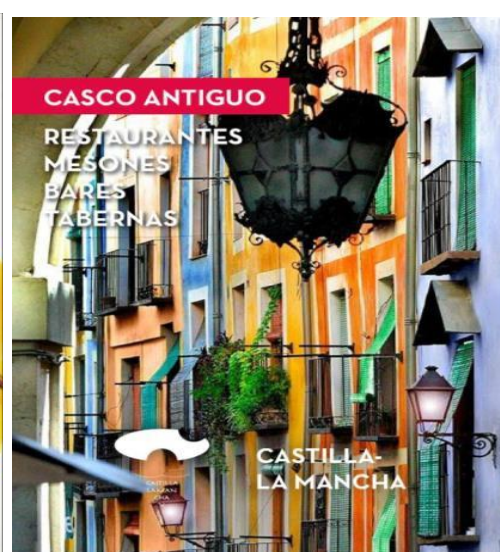
The city offers a varied gastronomic offer during your visit:

High-quality restaurants and cuisine recognized under the regional gastronomic brand **CULINARY ROOTS**, where local produce and tradition are worked with technique and gastronomic level, positioning Cuenca as a relevant destination within the culinary scene.

Historic center Streets and squares with bars, taverns and restaurants where you can combine gastronomy and heritage environment.

Centre and new neighborhood Area with a greater presence of modern cuisine, signature restaurants and places that reinterpret traditional gastronomy from a contemporary approach.

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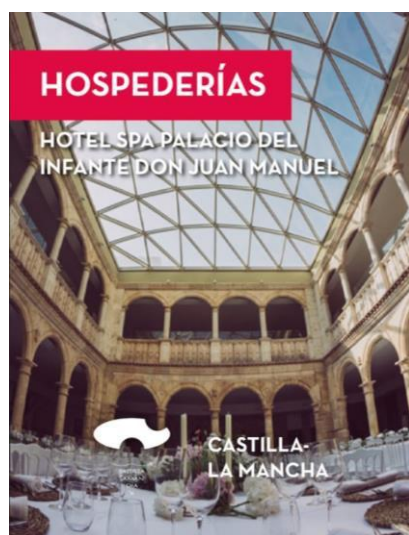
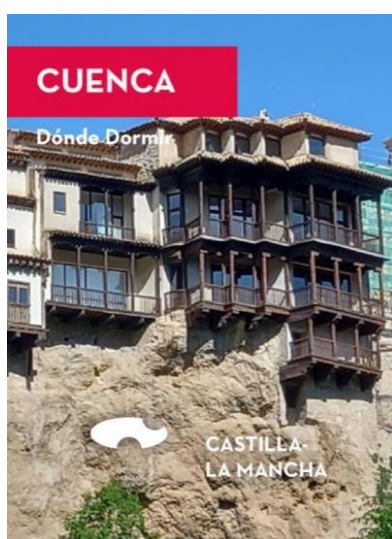
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Where to stay in Cuenca and its province?

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What to see in Cuenca?

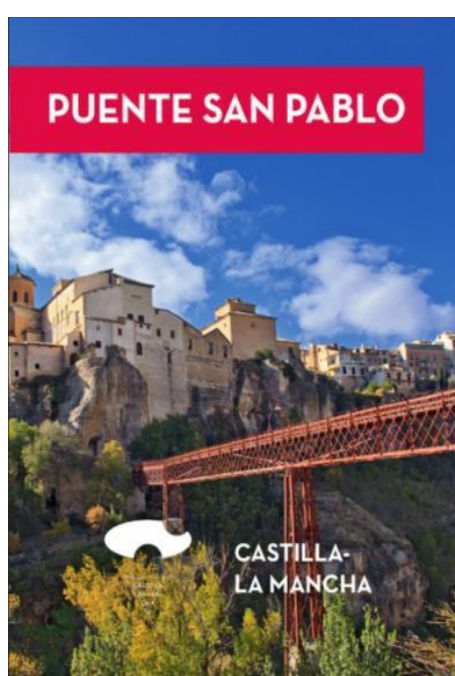
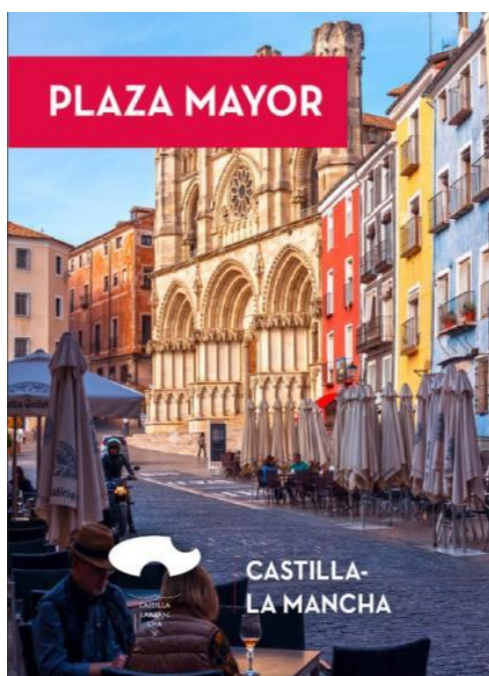
We show you some of the most representative spaces of the historic center of the city: **Plaza Mayor**, a reference urban center, surrounded by historic buildings and presided over by the Cathedral of Santa María and San Julián.

Puente de San Pablo, pedestrian walkway that connects the old town with the surroundings of the old convent of San Pablo, with direct views of the gorge of the Huécar River.

Hanging Houses, emblematic constructions located on the rocky wall, adapted to the topography of the city and converted into one of its main symbols.

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What to see in the province of Cuenca?

Five proposals to complete the visit beyond the city.

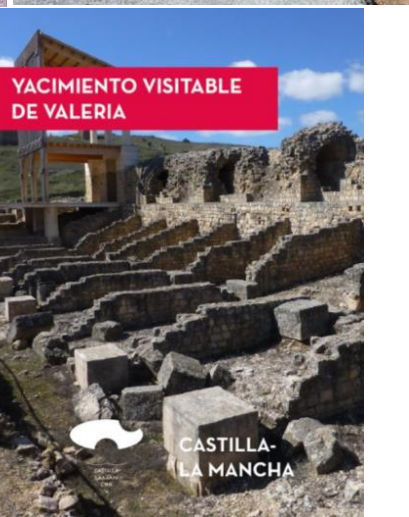
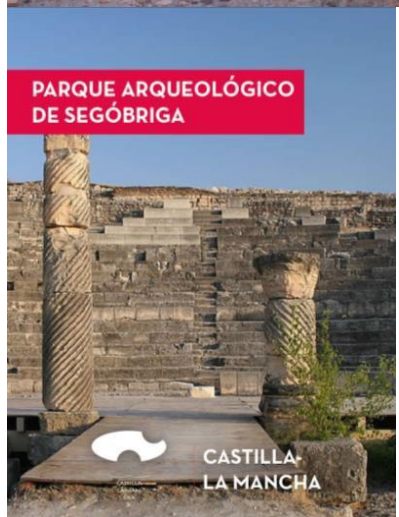
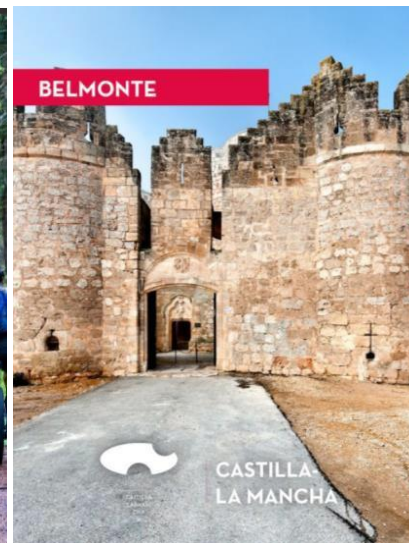
A few kilometers from the city, the province brings together nature, history and heritage that can be visited. **Serranía de Cuenca Natural Park**. Protected area with the possibility of active tourism activities hiking, cycling and nature activities, among rock formations, pine forests and viewpoints.

Valeria site, remains of the ancient Roman city with an urban layout, forum and structures that allow us to interpret its historical development.

Monastery of Uclés, a monumental complex linked to the Order of Santiago, with renaissance architecture and an outstanding location on the landscape.

Segóbriga Archaeological Park, one of the most important archaeological sites on the Meseta that has urban remains that show the importance of the city in Roman times.

Belmonte, a historic town with its fifteenth-century castle and an urban complex linked to its medieval past.



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
