The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Deputy Technical Delegate, summoned the above competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Facts Car No. 69's FIA technical passport was not presented at pre-event scrutineering.

Offence Breach of Article 251-2.1.8 of Appendix J of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code.

Decision A Fine of €500 on the Competitor of Car no. 69 (JORGE MARTÍNEZ)

In accordance with Art. 12.8 of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.

Reason The Stewards summoned and heard from Ms. ISABEL ORTIZ, Team Manager of the Competitor of Car No. 69, on Thursday, 12 February 2026 at 10:45 hrs.

The Stewards reviewed and shared the report of the FIA Deputy Technical Delegate, which stated that during the mandatory pre-event scrutineering the car and its FIA markings were inspected, however the FIA technical passport was missing.

The Team Manager stated that, while preparing the documentation for presentation of the car at pre-event scrutineering, the team was unable to locate the FIA technical passport of Car No. 69. She explained that the car had recently travelled across multiple countries and that the passport had been present at its previous competitions. Upon realising this, the Team Manager contacted the FIA Technical Delegate to inform him that the FIA technical passport was missing.


Article 251-2.1.8 of Appendix J of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code requires that the FIA technical passport be presented at scrutineering prior to the Competition.

The FIA Deputy Technical Delegate confirmed that the car and its markings were inspected and that they were satisfied that the car conformed to the applicable Technical Regulations.

The Stewards note that, notwithstanding the conformity of the car with the Technical Regulations, the FIA Technical Passport was not presented as required. The Stewards therefore find that the Competitor was in breach of the aforementioned regulation.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determine that the imposition of a fine is appropriate and proportionate and in line with previous precedents.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2026 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the 2026 FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
