1. Rally Plates

2. Sound Test & Scrutineering Arrangements

There will be five sessions of Sound Test & Scrutineering

* Wednesday 12th Oct 16.00 – 19.00 @ Tobermory Harbourfront

* Thursday 13th Oct 08.00 – 09.00 & 10.30 – 12.00 @ Isle of Mull Rugby Club, Garmony

For crews taking part in the shakedown.

* Thursday 13th Oct 16.00 – 19.00 @ Tobermory Harbourfront

* Friday 14th Oct 09.00 – 14.00 @ Tobermory Harbourfront

For all other crews.

The process for the shakedown sessions is:

Cars should report to Scrutineering at Tobermory Harbourfront Wednesday, or Isle of Mull Rugby Club Thursday morning, at their allocated time on the scrutineering schedule in Bulletin No1.

Sound Test for crews taking part in Shakedown, will be undertaken at Duart Castle at the exit of the shakedown service area, in advance of their first run.

The process for the non-shakedown sessions is:

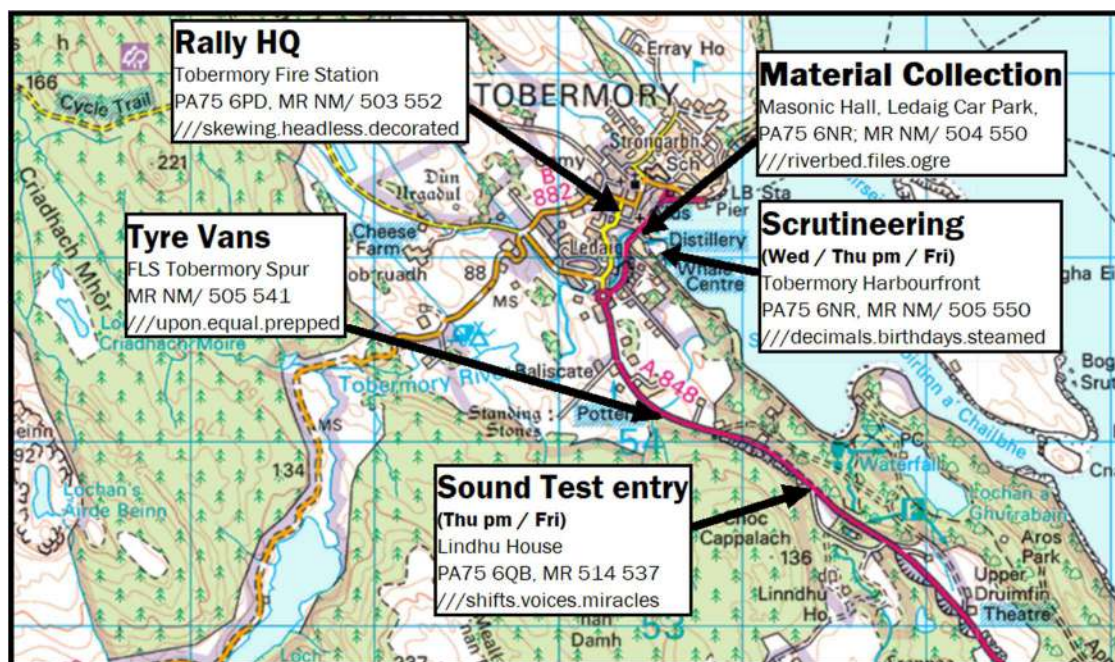
Cars should report to the Sound Test Location at Lindhu House Road at their allocated time on the scrutineering schedule in Bulletin No1. Enter the Lindhu House Road at the north end at MR 514 537. Following Sound Test, cars will be held before rejoining the main road by marshals, and sent in batches to scrutineering.

Once at Tobermory Harbourfront, follow marshals' instructions for scrutineering.

4. Tyre Vans

Tyre vans will be located in the Forestry & Land Scotland 'Tobermory Spur' from Thursday Morning to Saturday. Tyres South Shore & Wheels Around have advised they may relocate to Craignure (likely CalMac bus lanes and/or Craignure Village Hall) for Services A & D; Andrew Wood Motorsport will remain in Tobermory.

Owing to space constraints, customers at Tobermory Spur are requested to park neatly on the hard shoulder of the A848 between the 'Tobermory' sign and Aros Park, and walk in to the venue – any changes to this will be advised in a subsequent Competitor Information notice.

Competitors should contact their individual suppliers for arrangements.

5. Ledaig Car Park

Ledaig Car Park in Tobermory, including the area in front of the distillery, is out of bounds for all service vehicles from 12.00 noon on Wednesday 12th Oct until 09.00 Saturday 15th Oct.

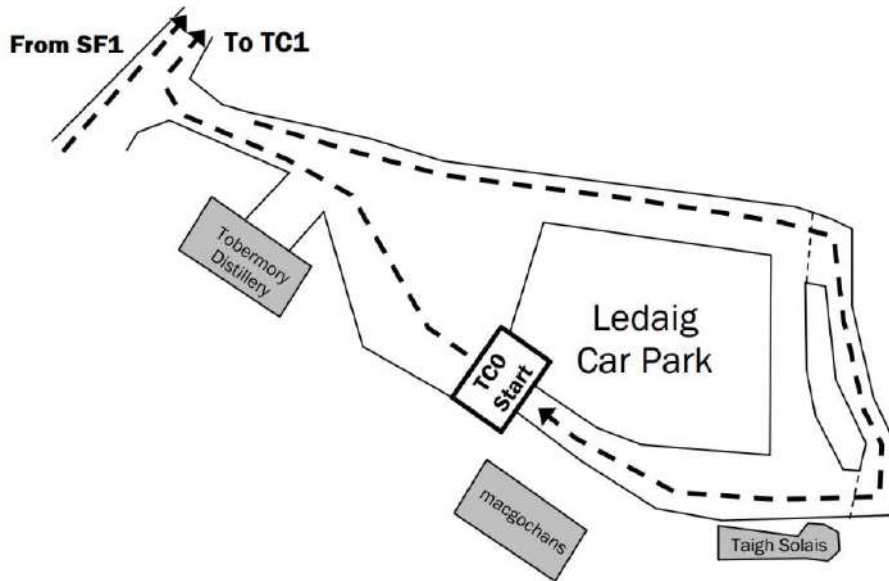
6. Rally Start

When you arrive at Ledaig for the start of the rally, follow the marshals' instructions to the holding area on the gravel at the shore side. Please don't arrive too early for the start as there isn't enough room for everybody, but please do allow a few minutes for your Safety Tracking System to be installed by Sporttraxx. The top fifteen cars on the start list must be at the start by 18.45.

Please be aware as you arrive, of traffic further up the running order who will be proceeding from SF1 to TC2, and turning right out of TC0. Likewise as you depart TC0 and turn right towards TC1, please be courteous towards others further down the order turning in to Ledaig.

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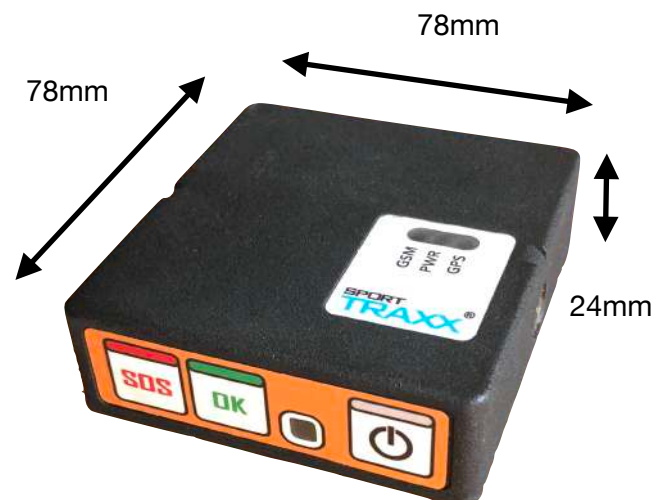
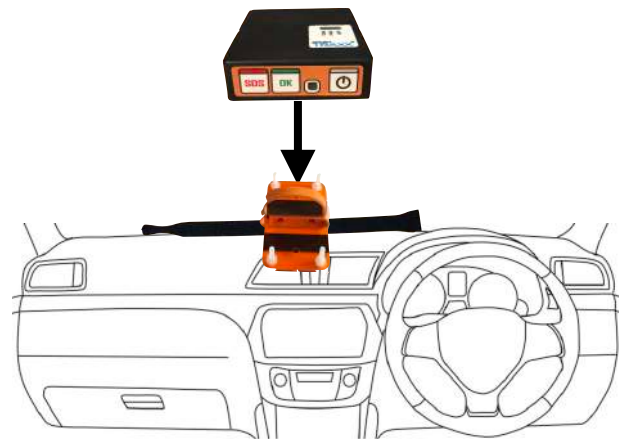
How and where to fit the Cradle

- Place the cradle in the centre of the dashboard making sure it is fixed securely.
- Make sure the velcro strap is placed under the bracket before fixing it in place.
- The Tracking unit must have free view of the sky through the windscreen.
- The OK & SOS buttons must be visible to both crew.
- We encourage that the cradle remains in place for future events.



Tracker Instructions

- The tracker will be handed to the crew before the first TC switched ON ready to go.
- Under the supervision of a sporttraxx representative the crew will fit the tracker to the cradle.
- The unit must remain ON at all times even if you have retired from the event.
- If you require medical assistance press the **SOS button for 3seconds and repeat again after 5 seconds.**
- A blue LED light will show on the tracker to notify the crew their SOS request has been received.
- If you have stopped in the stage for any other reason you must press the OK button within 1 minute for 3 seconds this will notify us that you are OK and don't need assistance.
- Failure to press the OK/SOS button within the time will be reported to the organisers and penalties maybe applied.
- At the final control Sporttraxx personnel will collect the tracker
- Should you retire please hand the tracker to the sweep car or return to Rally HQ with your damage declaration.
- Failure to return the tracker or any damage caused to the unit will result in a £300 penalty to replace the unit. If the tracker isn't returned or payment hasn't been made for loss or damage to the unit you will be reported to MSUK (regulation C.1.1.13) and your licenses suspended until payment is made or tracker has been returned.
- If returning by post send recorded delivery only or you will be responsible for the replacement cost of the tracker should it go missing.



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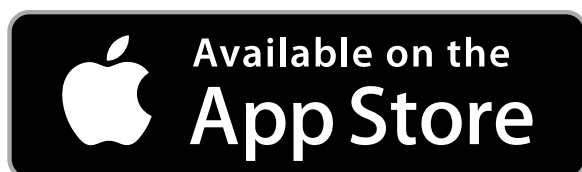

COVID-19

At the time of writing there were no statutory obligations in place for the management of COVID-19, from Motorsport UK or the Scottish Government. Should this situation change then the organisers will of course issue relevant updates.

However, we must all be mindful that COVID-19 is still present, and the risk of transmission is still very real. For some this can lead to severe illness in some cases even death.

It is important to recognise that island communities are particularly at risk when large numbers of people visit the island for major events like the Beatson's Building Supplies Mull Rally.

With so many competitors, support crew and spectators attending the risk increases significantly.
