



Recce Warning

First, we want to acknowledge the impact the recent high winds have had on the rally area. We are working tirelessly alongside local forestry crews to ensure the stages are safe and ready for competition. Their teams are making fantastic progress clearing debris.

This essential clean-up work, which involves heavy machinery, has a direct impact on the recce schedule. Please read the following advisory carefully.

Thursday Recce - **STRONGLY DISCOURAGED**

Due to the ongoing clean-up operations, many of the rally stages will have intermittent or full closures throughout the day on Thursday.

We **cannot guarantee** that you will be able to complete a full, uninterrupted run of any stage. Attempting to do so will likely lead to significant delays and, most importantly, incomplete pace notes.

For safety and planning purposes, we strongly advise all competitors to postpone their recce until Friday. The safety of our competitors is our number one priority, and running on partial notes poses an unacceptable risk.

Friday Recce - **PROCEEDING AS PLANNED**

We have received confirmation from our forestry partners that all major clean-up work will be completed by Thursday evening, or at least we will be able to get through the affected areas on Friday.

The recce schedule for Friday will proceed as planned, and we anticipate all stages will be fully open. We are confident you will be able to get a full and complete recce done on Friday.

We sincerely appreciate your understanding and cooperation as we work to deliver a safe, challenging, and enjoyable event for everyone.
